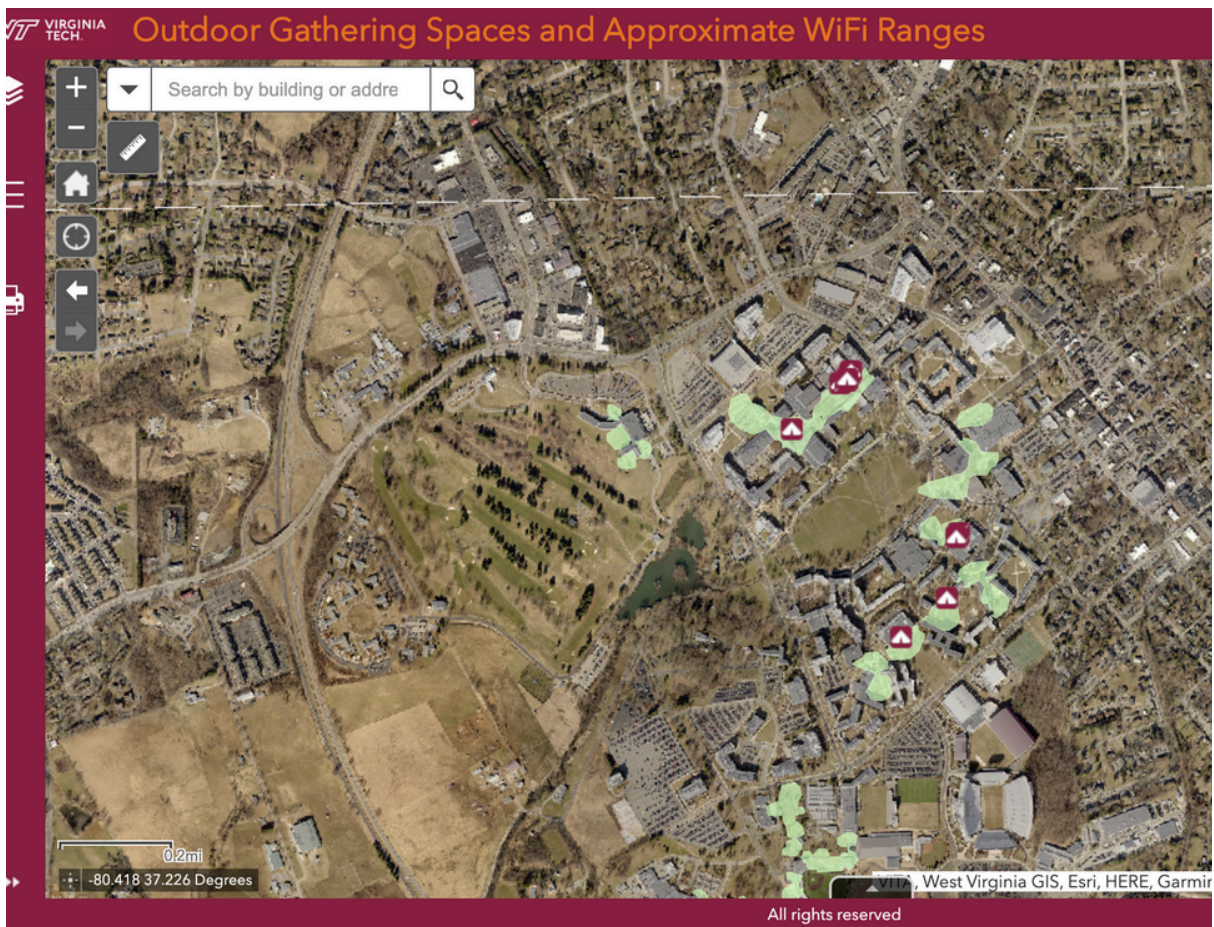

# Calling students to join the academy for Experiential Learning

## **Goal of the Student Advisory Committee:**

Members of the Student Advisory Committee for the Academy for Experiential Learning will assist the Director by providing the student perspective on experiential learning opportunities offered as well as ensure that all students are provided with and made aware of the experiential learning opportunities at Virginia Tech.

## **Responsibilities of the Student Advisory Committee:**

- Be willing to attend monthly or bi-monthly meetings throughout the 2020-21 academic year. The time estimate will be approximately 3 - 5 hours monthly.
- Engage in informed, creative problem-solving as different issues develop regarding experiential learning

Training will also be provided to prepare members of the Student Advisory Committee to:

- Serve as ambassadors for experiential learning by presenting to classes and/or other groups about experiential learning opportunities.
- Work with faculty to explore sites for internships, service-learning, and/or study away programs.
- Assist other students with putting together their plans for experiential learning
- Provide consultation on issues that come up related to students and experiential learning

## **Preferred Qualifications**

- Students who have participated in some form of experiential learning in one or more of the following areas: living-learning community, undergraduate research, service-learning, an internship, or study abroad
- Students who are out-going and would like to work more closely with faculty

- Students who are innovative, can think outside the box, and are looking to create experiential learning opportunities that are accessible for ALL students at Virginia Tech.
