Call for Proposals for Interdisciplinary Faculty Seed Grant Program

The Global Change Center (GCC), in collaboration with ISCE, is **accepting notifications of intent from GCC faculty to support interdisciplinary research on Emerging Social Aspects of Global Change that will lead to collaborative proposals submitted to extramural funding sources.** A single award will be made for approximately \$20-25K. At least two PIs must be members of GCC, and at least one social scientist on the project must be from Virginia Tech; additional faculty from Virginia Tech or outside entities can also be part of the collaborative team.
