

Student Activity Fee Allocation Report 2010-2011

The Student Activity Fee for 2010-11 was \$373 and used to support the operation, maintenance and debt service expenditures for Student Centers and for support of various student activities as determined by the Student Budget Board. For 2010-11, \$1,124,286 was allocated to support various student organizations, which included a base allocation of \$1,010,000 for fiscal year 2010-11, and \$114,286 of unspent and/or unallocated funds carried forward from the prior fiscal year.

Student organizations applying for student activity fee funding must submit budget requests to one of two budget boards. Only organizations that have registered with the Department of Student Activities are eligible to submit a budget request. All organizations may be asked to appear before the appropriate board to present their requests and to answer questions of the board members. Both boards are governed by funding policies approved by the Commission on Student Affairs.

The Student Budget Board, a committee of the Commission on Student Affairs, is responsible for reviewing budget requests and making annual funding and contingency decisions for University Chartered Student Organizations (UCSO) and University Student Life Programs (USLP) organizations. The Student Budget Board is accountable to the Commission for its funding decisions and for approval of its policies. Its membership is composed of students, staff, and faculty. The Student Budget Board is chaired and advised by the Associate Director of Student Centers and Activities, a full time administrative professional staff person in the Department.

The Student Budget Board has an auxiliary board that is responsible to it for funding undergraduate and graduate Registered Student Organizations (RSO). The Registered Student Organization Budget Board is chaired by Assistant Director of Student Organizations. This board makes funding decisions for all programs of funding for Registered Organizations.
