QUALIFICATIONS

To apply for a Student Staff Leader position, you **must**:

- be a full-time Virginia Tech undergraduate, or graduate student.
- have completed one full semester at Virginia Tech

- GPA 2.75 minimum, preference will be given to students with a 3.0 or higher
- be in good standing with Virginia Tech (have no active judicial/honor sanctions).
- have/be willing to learn general knowledge about Virginia Tech.
- be an actively engaged student in student organizations, and/or academic and co-curricular experiences on VT's campus.
- should not be taking summer classes during the time of the programs.
- must be available to move in June 10, 2020 (if hired, SSLs that have issues with this date can be worked with around this issue on an individual basis).
- must be available for spring training (dates TBD)
- have a positive and energetic attitude.
