





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The editors of this publication were assisted greatly by the 1950 publication of Professors R. A. Marr, Jr. and J. M. Morgan, Jr. of Virginia Military Institute, <u>Bibliography of Water Resources of Virginia and Related Topics</u>, prepared for the Committee on Water Resources which was part of an Advisory Council on the Virginia Economy established by Governor William M. Tuck. This very fine publication provided a good foundation on which the present publication was built. From this beginning help was solicited from various state agencies, federal agencies, private citizens, industrial representatives, consulting engineers, and members of the Virginia Polytechnic Institute staff for suggestions and leads to printed material which might be of assistance to others working in the field. The cooperation received was excellent and without such assistance there was little chance of success.

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FOREWORD

On July 17, 1964, President Lyndon B. Johnson signed into law the Water Resources Research Act of 1964 (P. L. 88-379) providing for the establishment of a Water Resources Research Institute or Center in each of the 50 states and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. These Centers are enlisting the intellectual powers of universities and research institutes in a nationwide research effort to conserve and utilize our water resources "in order to assist in assuring the Nation at all times of a supply of water sufficient in quantity and quality to meet the requirements of its expanding population." In early 1965 the Water Resources Re-search Center began to take form at Virginia Polytechnic Institute. Administrative responsibility for the Center is vested in a Director with policy being set by an administrative committee consisting of the Vice President, Dean of Agriculture, and Dean of Engineering. Faculty members from disciplines concerned with various phases of water resources make up the Technical Advisory Committee which assists in planning, developing, and evaluating projects and proposals concerned with water resources and conservation.

It was recognized from the beginning that the Center could not reach its potential and be of greatest service to the state of Virginia unless a forum were provided which enabled state and federal agencies concerned with water resources development, local governments, concerned citizens, and the industrial community to have direct communication with the Center. In recognition of this need, a Statewide Advisory Committee was established with membership from these various groups. At the first meeting of the Committee, many members expressed a basic and urgent need for an inventory of published information and data on the general subject of water resources in Virginia. This publication is in response to the need expressed at that meeting. It is also hoped that the report will be of material aid to investigators preparing proposals or initiating research endeavors in water resources problems pertinent to Virginia needs.

The publication is divided into two basic indexes: an author index and a subject and geographic index. Publications prepared for an agency but listing individual authors have been listed under the author index. Papers prepared for agencies which do not identify the author are indexed according to agency name. Listing of authors and subjects is alphabetical. Where one author has several listings, these are chronologically ordered with a few exceptions, e.g. U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, wherein ordering is alphabetical by the name of the body of water concerned. An appendix enumerates the addresses of state and federal government organizations concerned with research, planning, development, and use of water or water related resources in Virginia.

Although much outstanding work by Virginians active in water resources has been published, the principal coverage herein has been limited largely to materials dealing wholly or in part with aspects of water resources with specific reference, geographical or otherwise, to Virginia. Some listings from related fields are also included. All mistakes, deletions or omissions, and improper notations are the sole responsibility of the editors.
