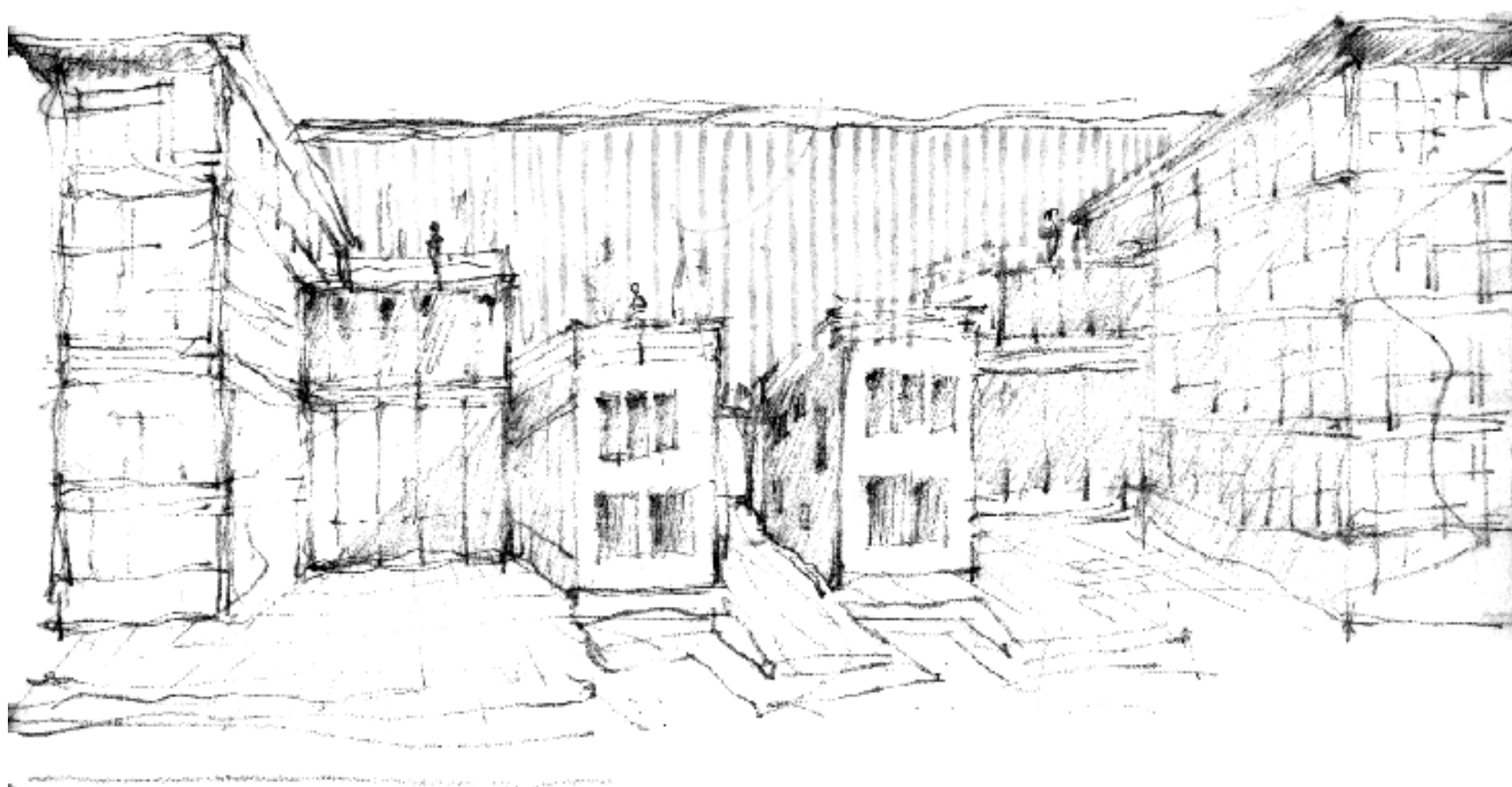
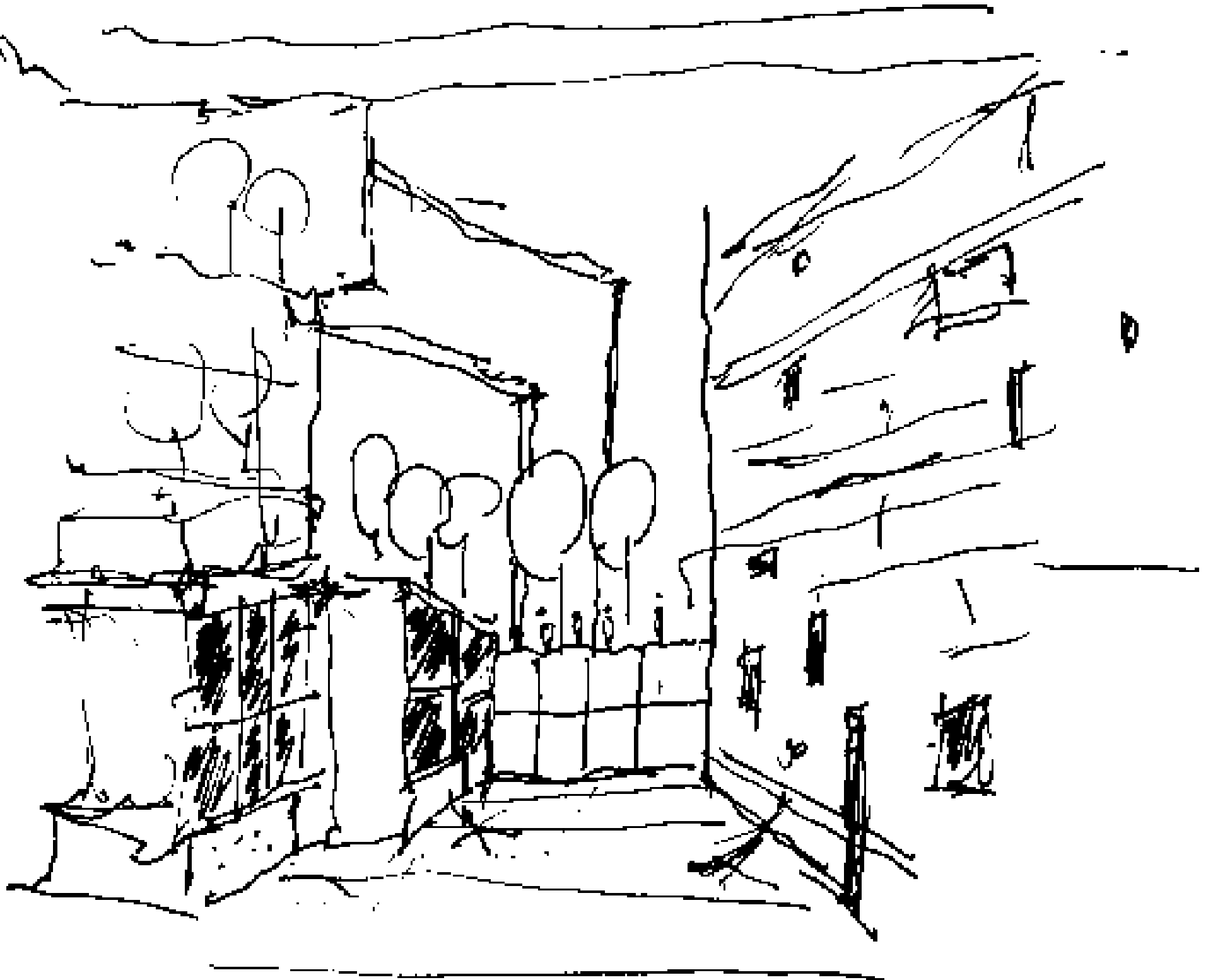


Preliminary sketch showing the plaza where outdoor dining takes place as an atrium space for weather protection.
