

- Salary of S & E faculty by gender (controlling for department, rank, years in rank)
- Space allocation of S & E faculty by gender (with additional controls such as dept., etc.)
- 12. Start-up packages of newly hired S & E faculty by gender (with additional controls such as field/department, rank, etc.)


Faculty at Virginia Tech by College and Gender, 2003







New Full-Time, Tenure-Track Faculty, 2005-2015






*women as percent of new hires



Tenured and Tenure-Track Women Faculty by Rank, 2005-2015






Women are currently 19% of professors, 35% of associates, and 36% of assistant professors university wide




Faculty at Virginia Tech by College and Gender, 2015








Women Faculty at Virginia Tech by Rank and College, Fall 2015








Women as % of Total Full-Time Tenured & Tenure-Track Faculty



Women Full Professors at Virginia Tech, 2005-2015








Women Engineering Faculty Fall 2015
