

APPENDIX 7A

Frequency Tables for Stops on the Way to Work and the Way Home from Work

Tables 7A.1 and 7A.2 illustrate the prevalence of joined trips among commuters in the D.C. metropolitan area. Eighteen percent of commuters surveyed stopped at least once on the way home from work. More than fourteen percent of commuters stopped at least once on the way to work.
