## Volunteer Roles

### **Instructional**

Teaches food and nutrition and related subject matter to EFNEP Homemakers or youth; gives demonstrations; helps program families make most use of food stamps or other resources; assists experienced volunteer, EFNEP Technician or professional with food demonstration or in-service training for volunteers or EFNEP Technicians; helps homemakers with language barriers; visits graduated participants to encourage them to continue learning about food and nutrition, and to become involved in other Extension programs.

### **Advisory Committee**

Serves on EFNEP Advisory Committee or Home Economics or 4-H Program Committee.

### **Educational Service**

Provides clerical help (including preparation of teaching materials, visuals, etc.); recruits; organizes; provides publicity and public relations.

### **Support Service**

Provides baby-sitting, transportation, meeting place, refreshments, equipment, clothing, housekeeping arrangements, emergency food, or financial help.

### **Middle Manager**

Unpaid service to or leadership of other volunteers by a youth or Homemaker.
