



CS1604 Quizzes & Tests

Warning!

These quizzes are "Negative-Marked" Tests, (e.g., SAT, GRE, etc.). Students should NOT guess at answers. Be forewarned that penalties are incurred for each incorrect answer! If you do not know the correct answer, you risk a negative score for a question if you are wrong. In order to avoid cancelling out a right answer, one should leave questions for which they do not know answers blank.

Each correct answer is worth 5 points and each incorrect answer receives a -5 penalty.

Step 1: Obtaining a Quiz/Test Password

Before taking an online quiz for the first time students must submit information and obtain a quiz/test password for the QUIZIT test system. The form for obtaining a quiz password can be reached by clicking on the 'password' button below. The password will be sent to you by email.

After submitting a password request, you will need to receive your email to find out what password you have been assigned. Please do NOT forget your password. Do NOT allow others to know your quiz password, to do so is an honor code violation.
