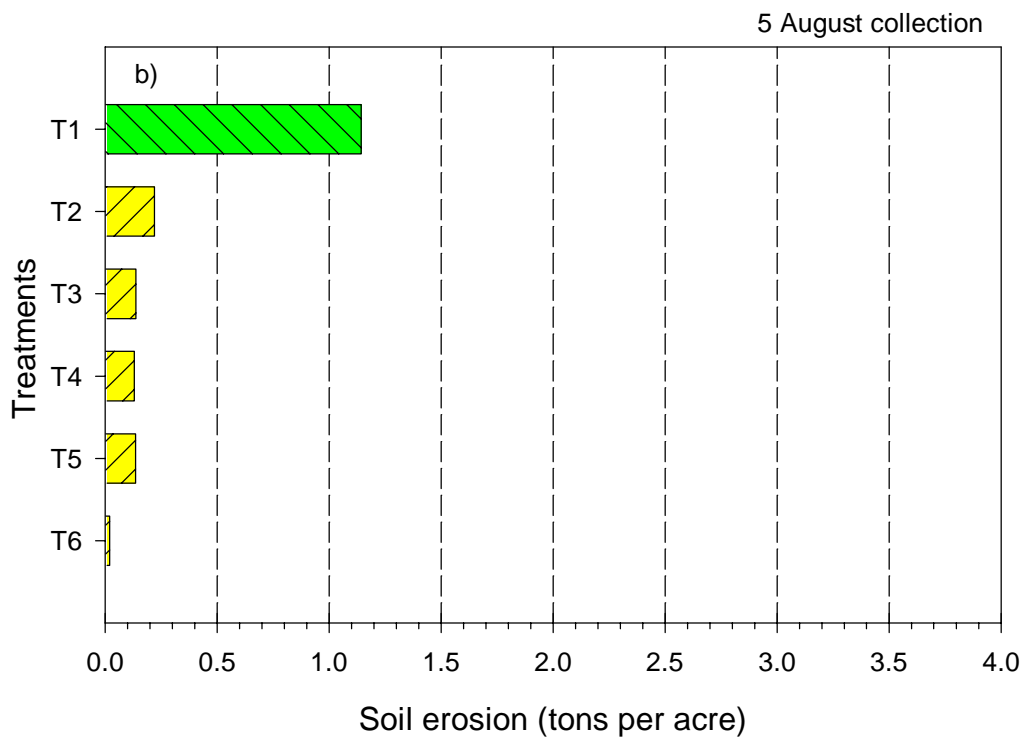
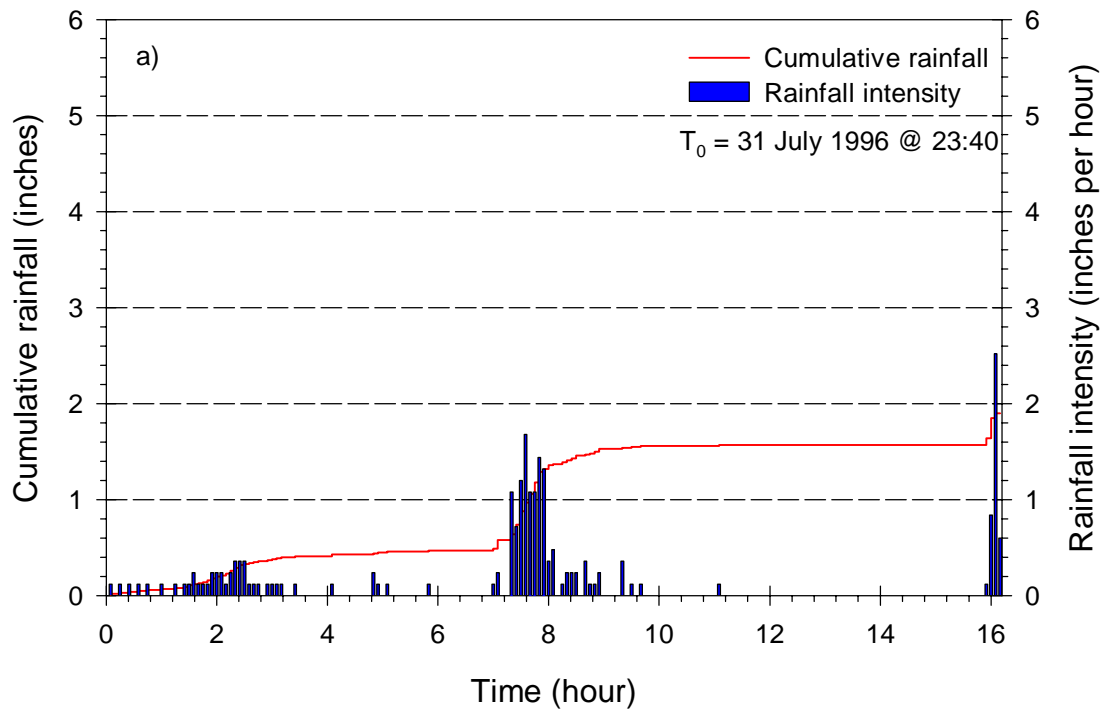


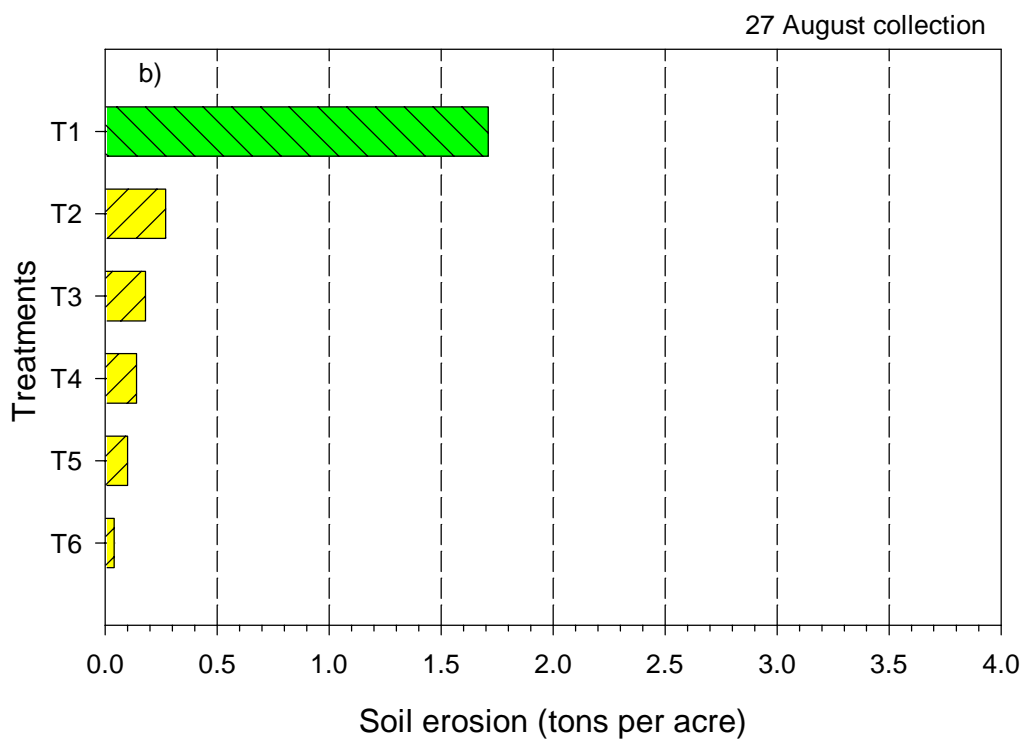
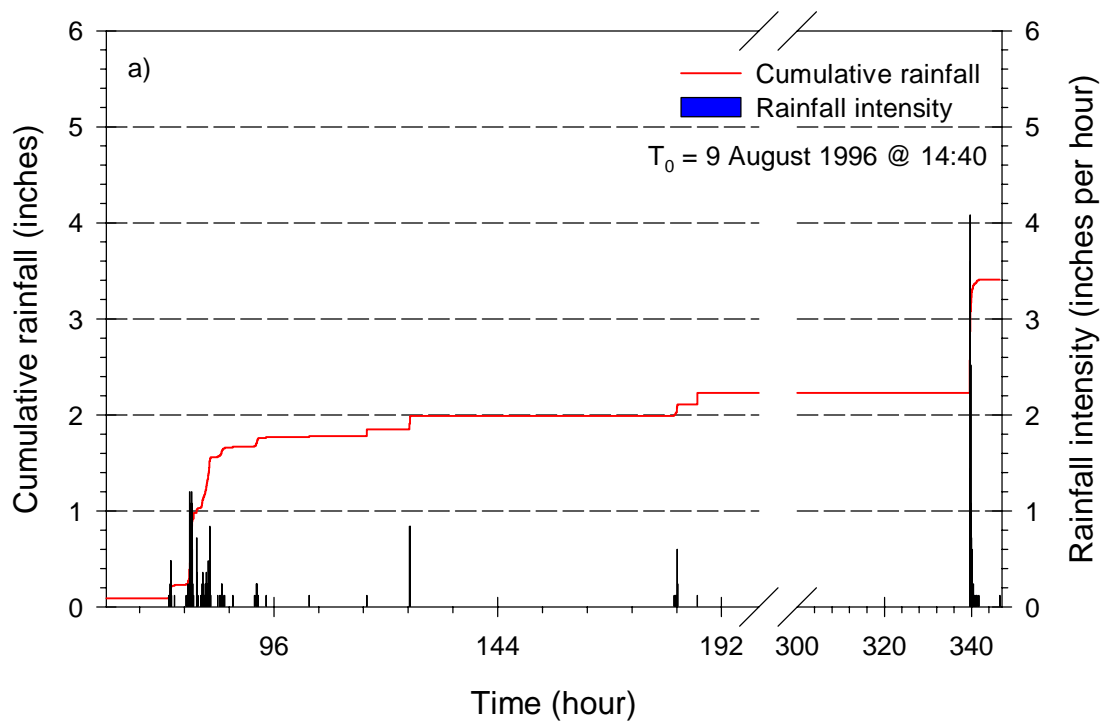




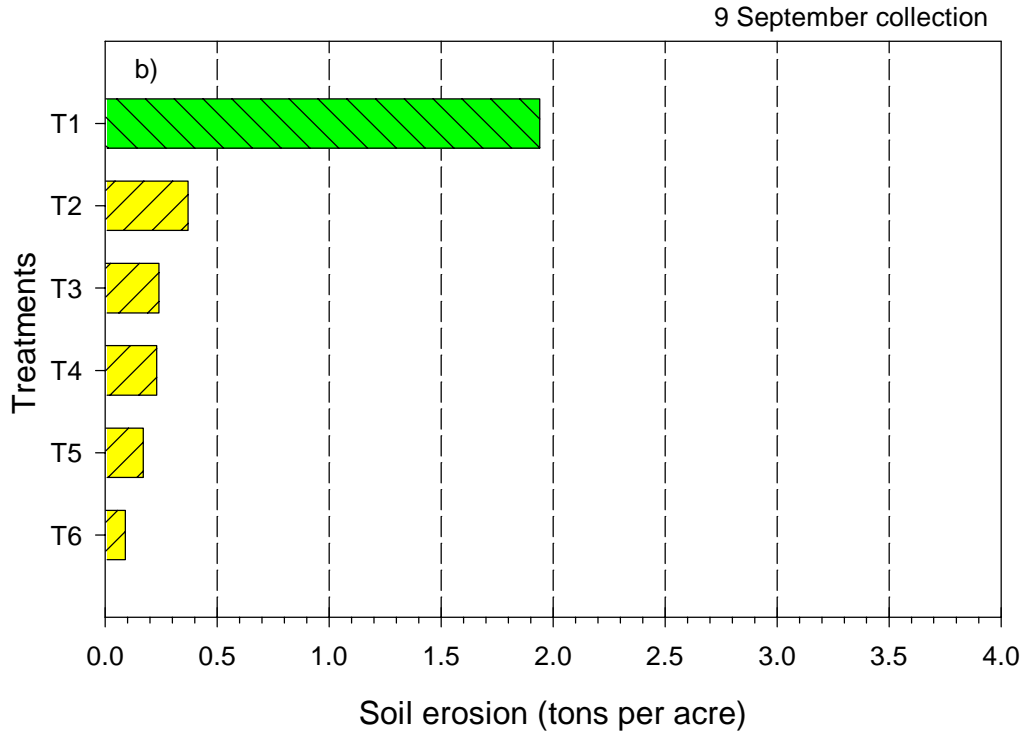
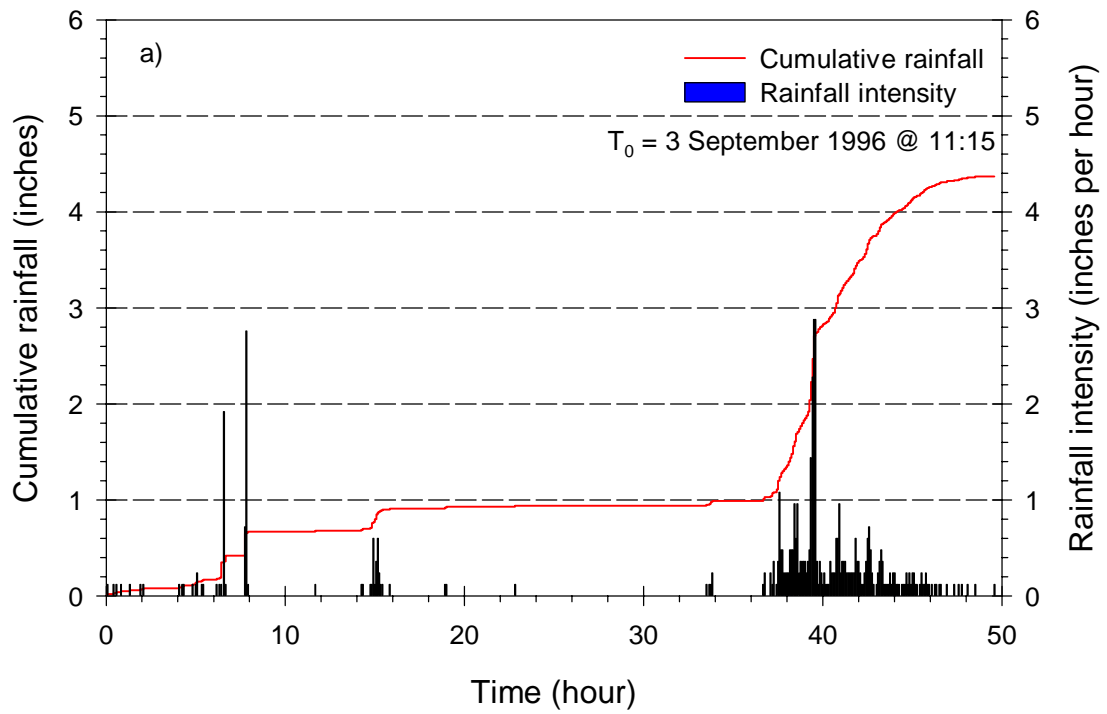


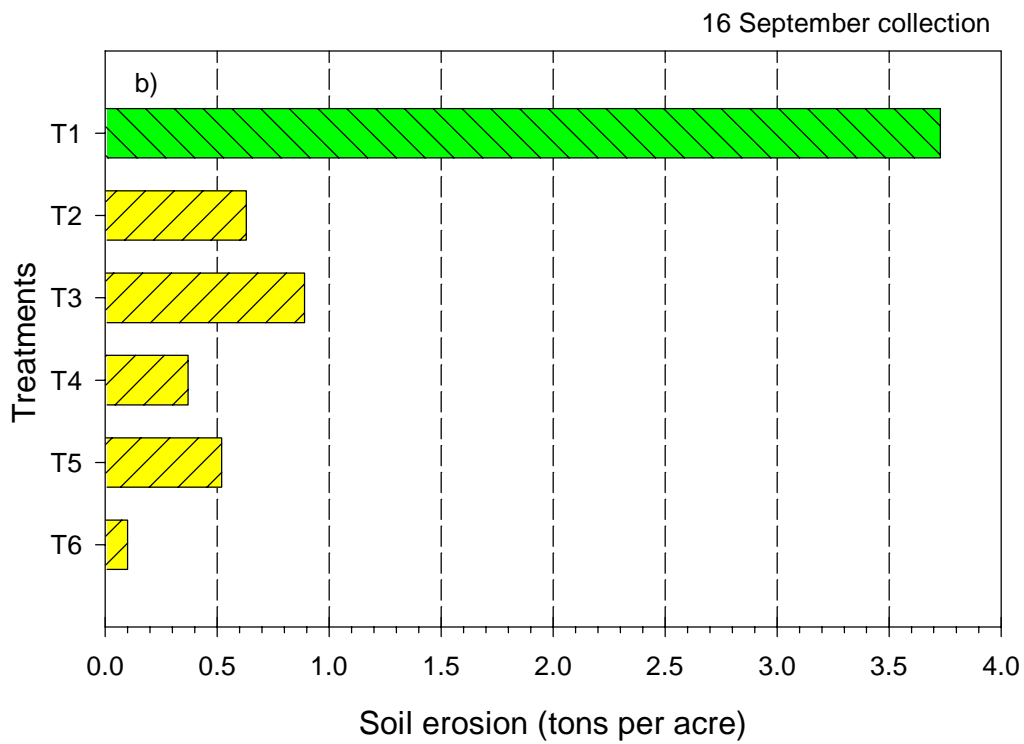
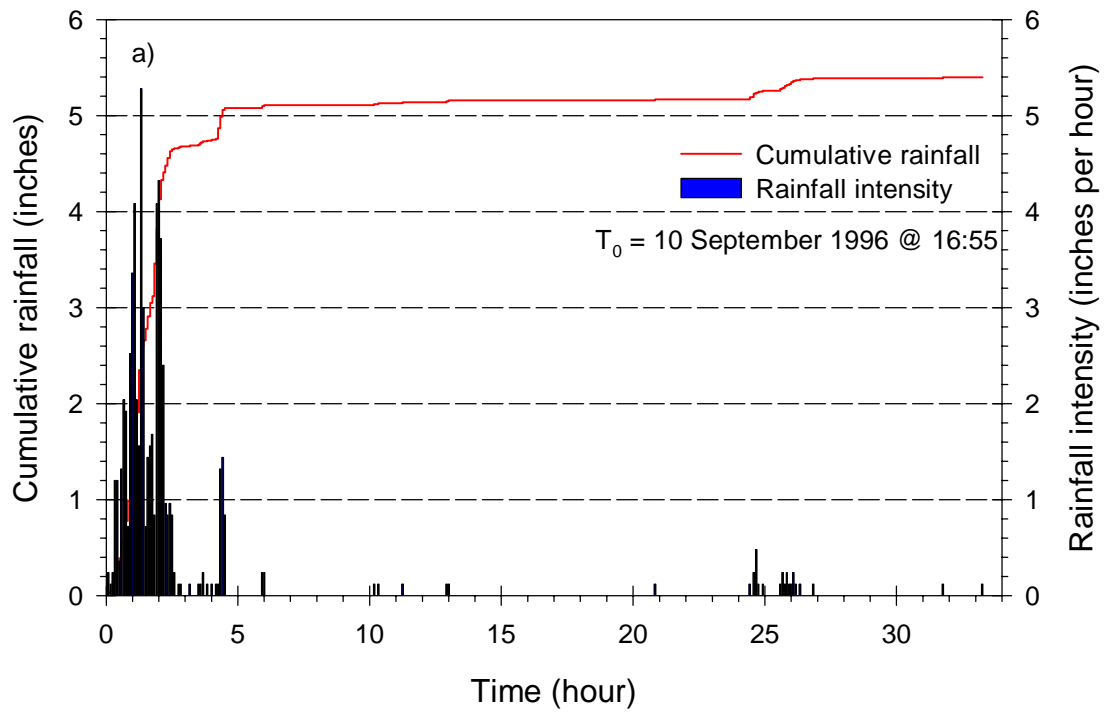


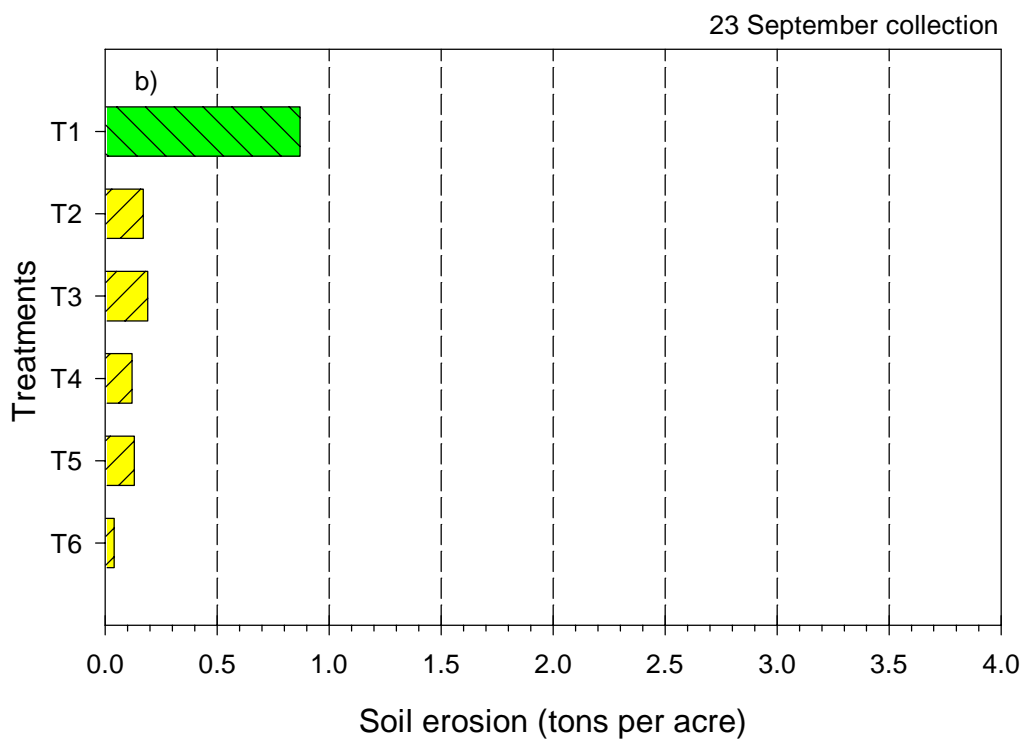
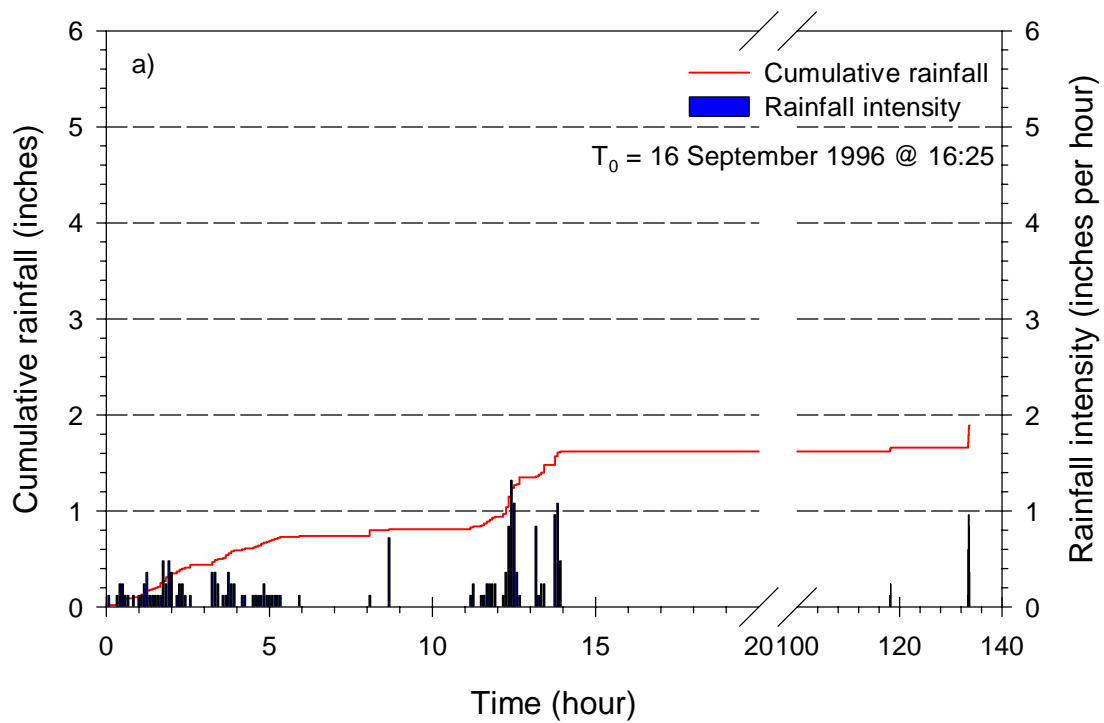


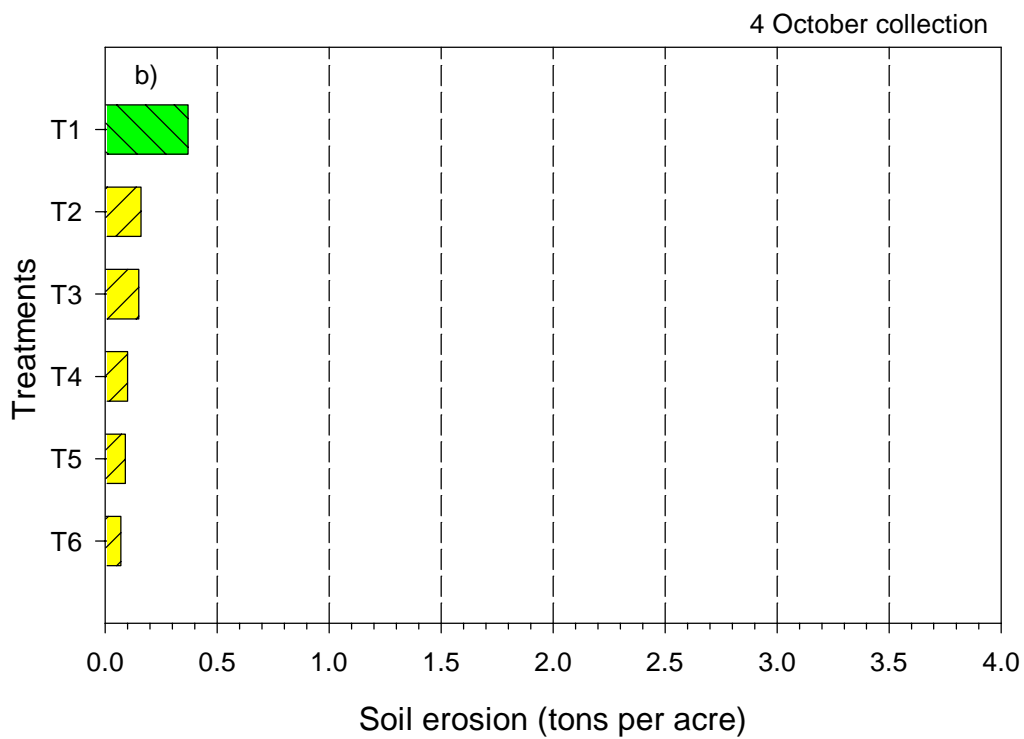
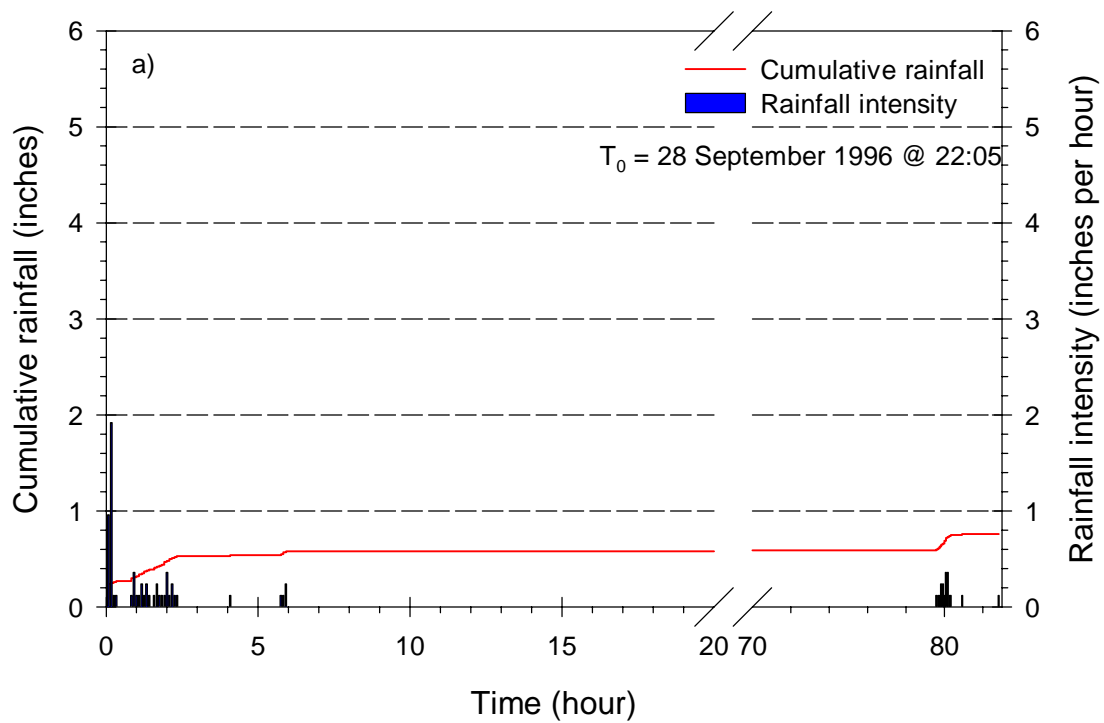


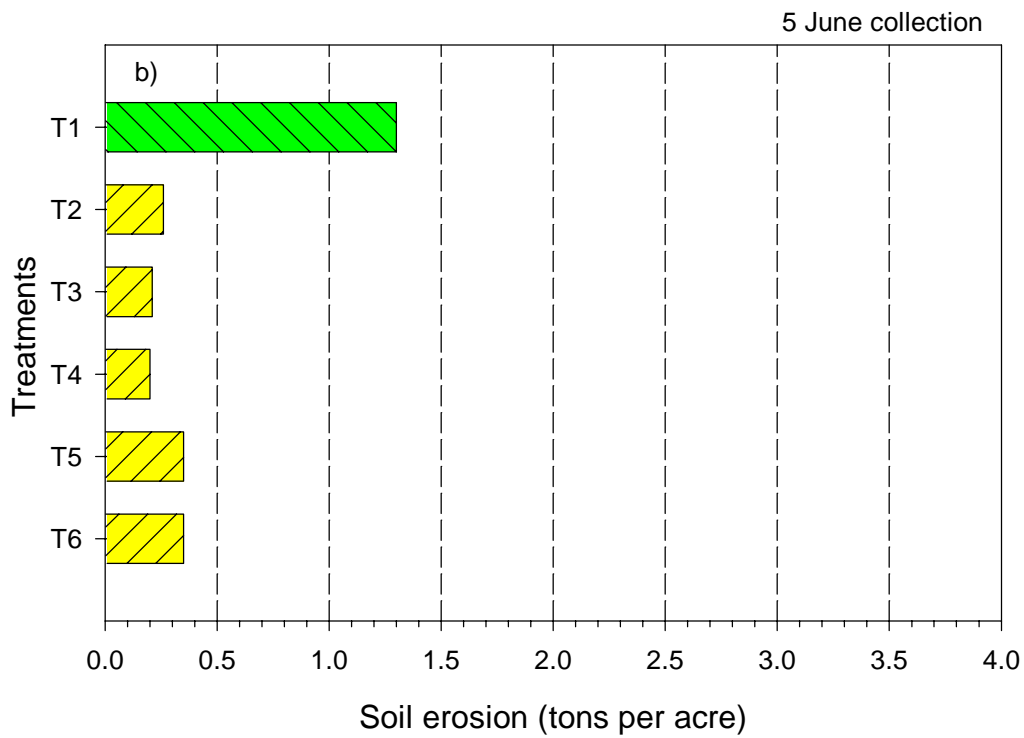
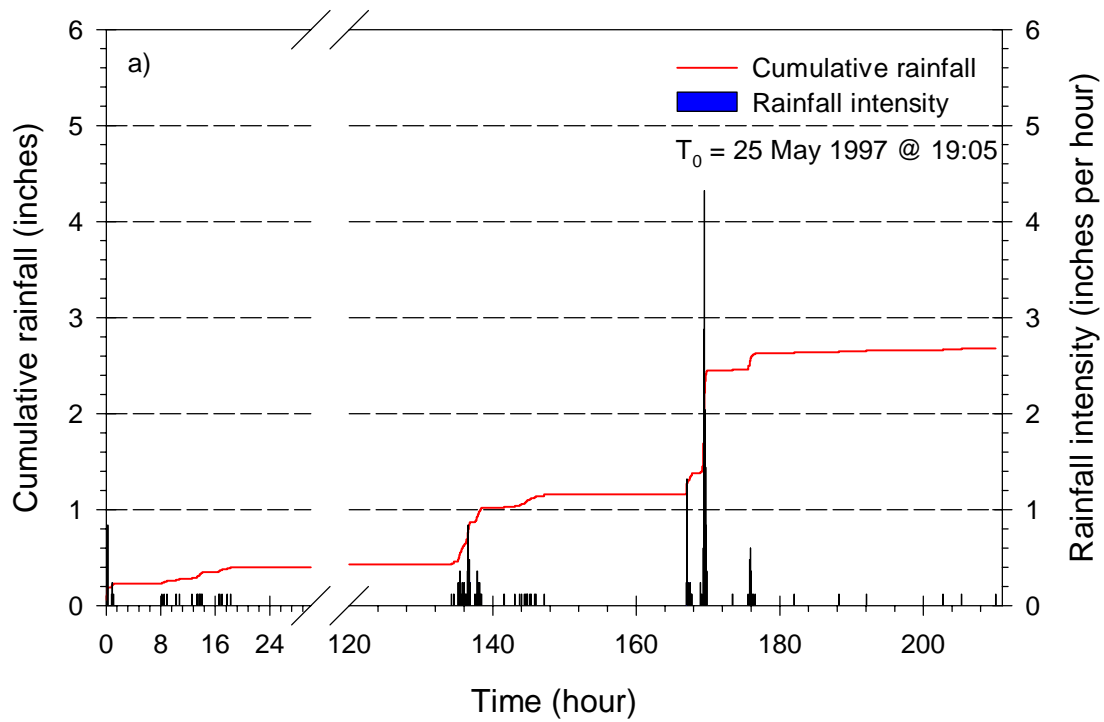


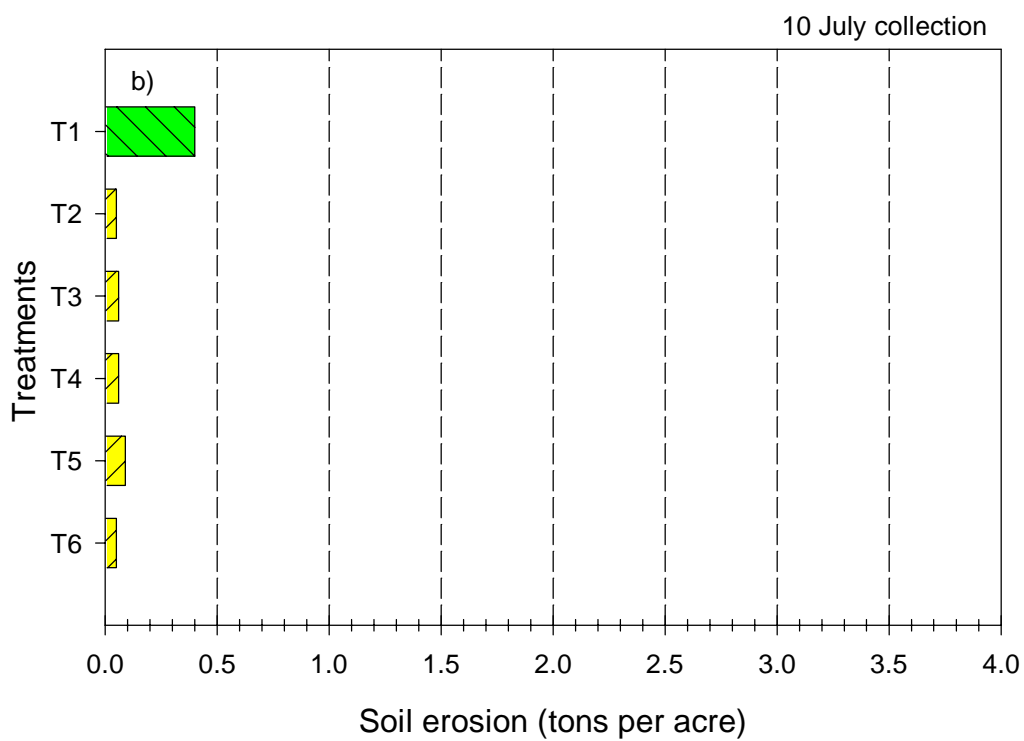
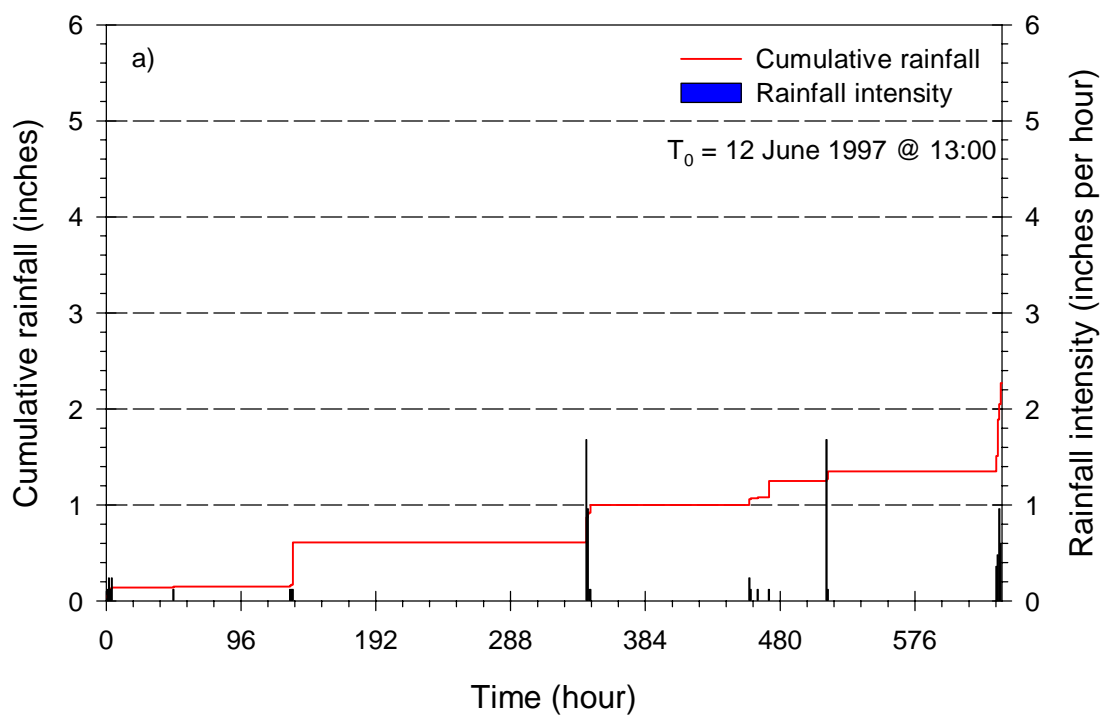












- a) A four hour irrigation was applied at an approximate water output of 1/2 inch per hour. Recording raingauge inoperative during irrigation event.
