## Plots of Volumetric Direct Transpiration versus Tree Diameter which yield $k$ -values from Observation Points: MW6, P4, P25

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## E Appendix

Using the Groundwater Recession Comparison method and White's Equation, 22 direct transpiration rates were calculated from data observed at observation points MW6, P4, and P25. These rates were multiplied by representative areas (900 ft<sup>2</sup> and 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>) to yield volumetric direct transpiration rates for those areas. The trees within each representative area were counted and their diameters measured. The example shown in Table E-1 was performed 44 times, utilizing 22 values for direct transpiration and two representative areas. Each calculation yielded a value for volumetric direct transpiration for each tree within each representative area. When per tree volumetric direct transpiration ( $Q_{DT}^T$ ) was plotted against tree diameter, a power equation was formed:

$$Q_{DT}^T = kx^2 \quad \text{where:} \quad Q_{DT}^T = \text{gal/day-tree}$$

$k$  = per tree volumetric direct transpiration coefficient, gal-ft/ft<sup>3</sup>

$x$  = Diameter at breast height, DBH

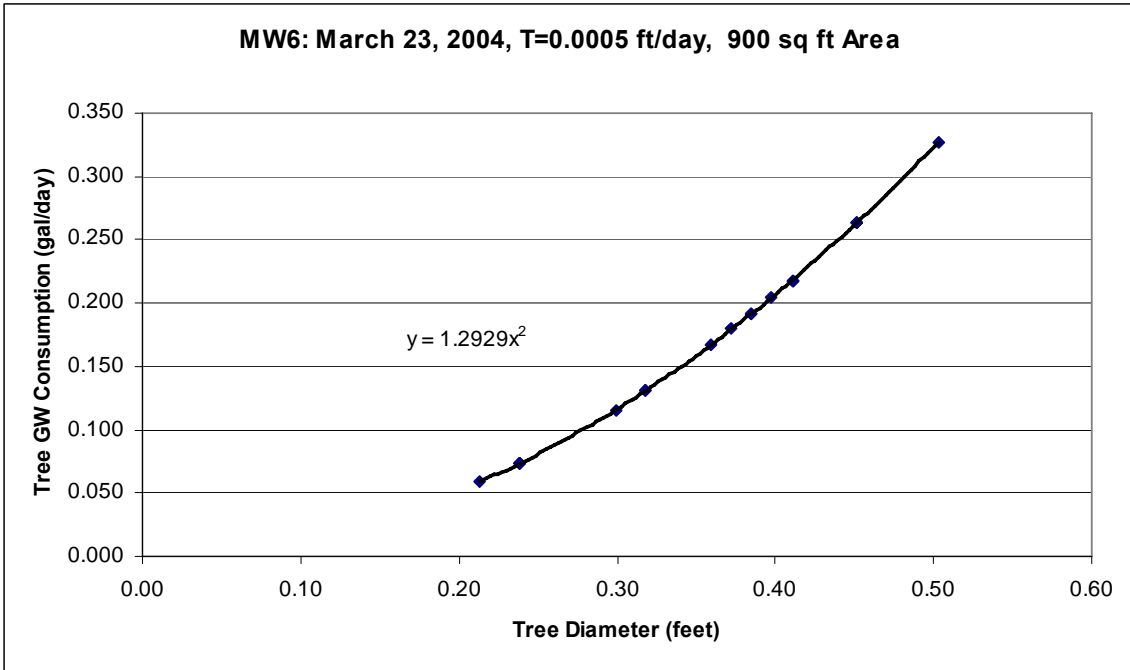


Figure E 1 MW6, March 23, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

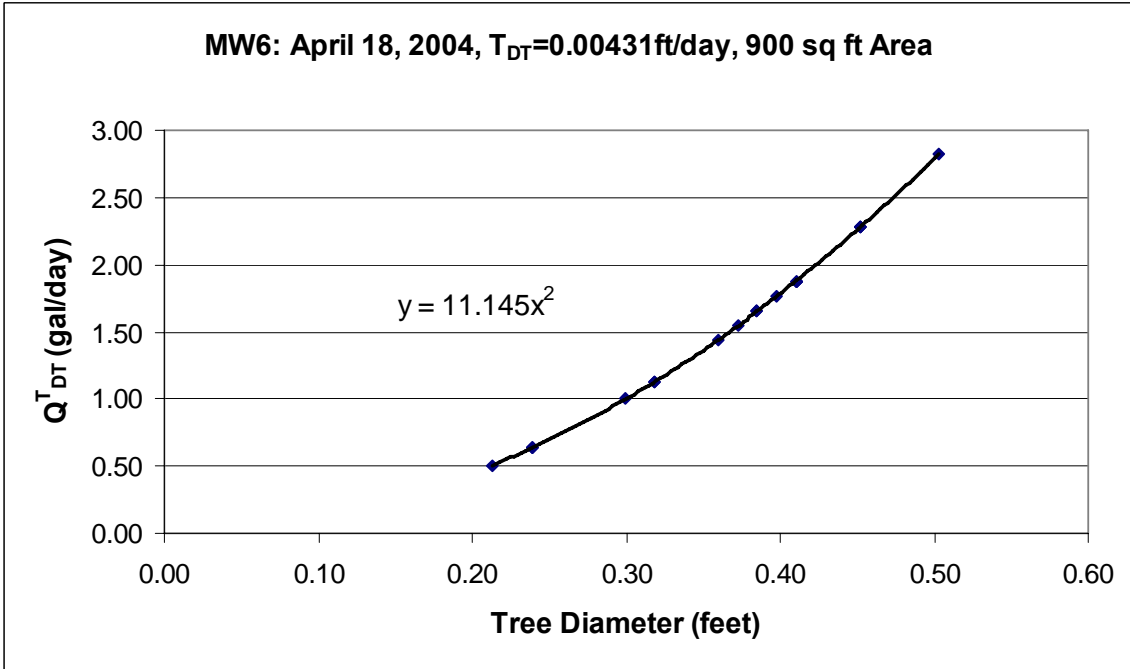
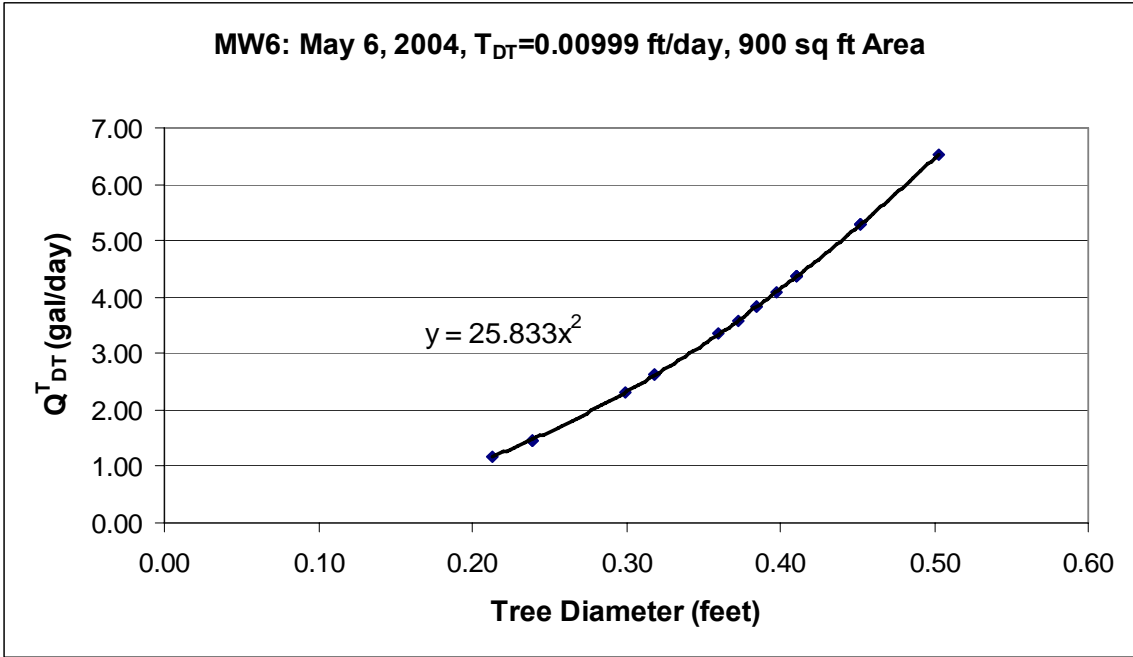
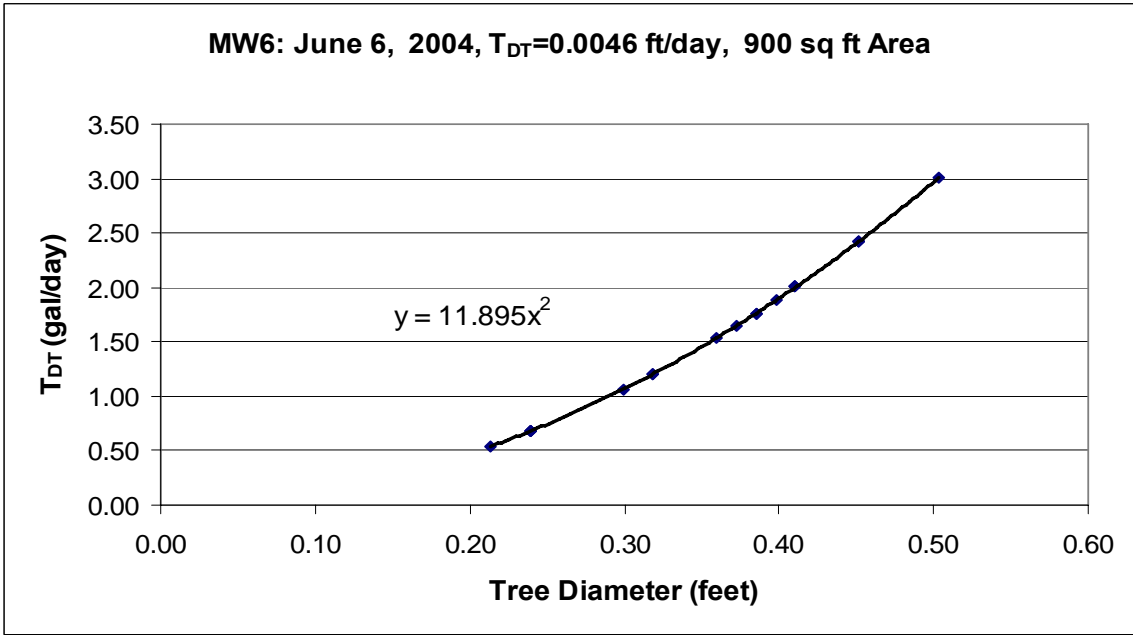


Figure E 2 MW6, April 18, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

**Figure E 4 MW6, June 6, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>**

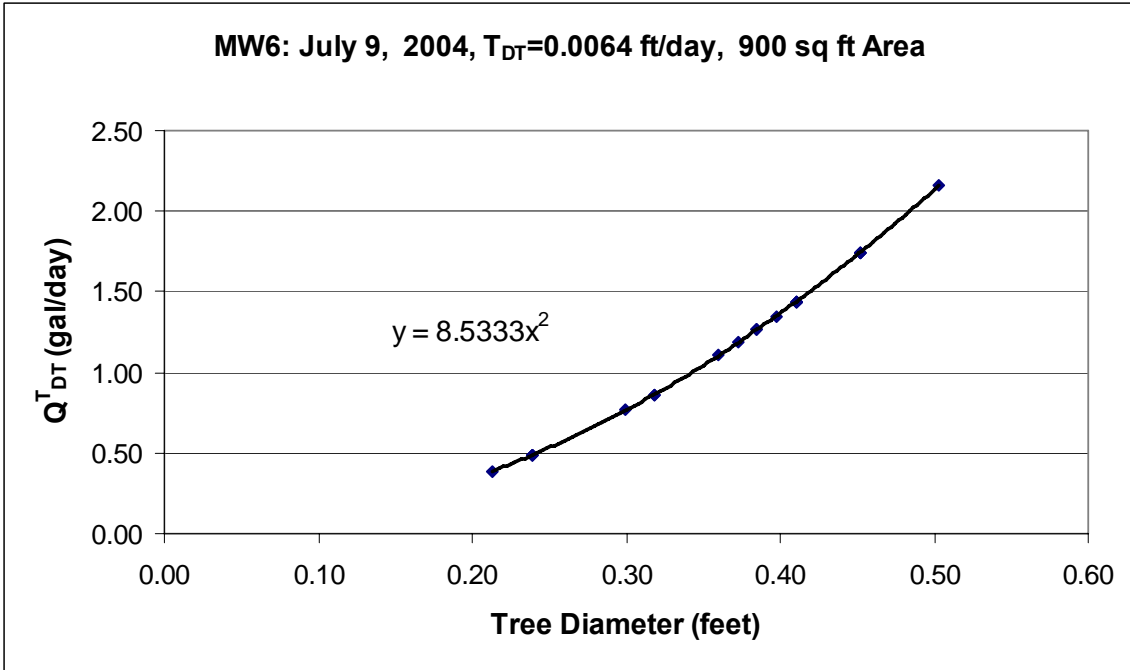


Figure E 5 MW6, July 9, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

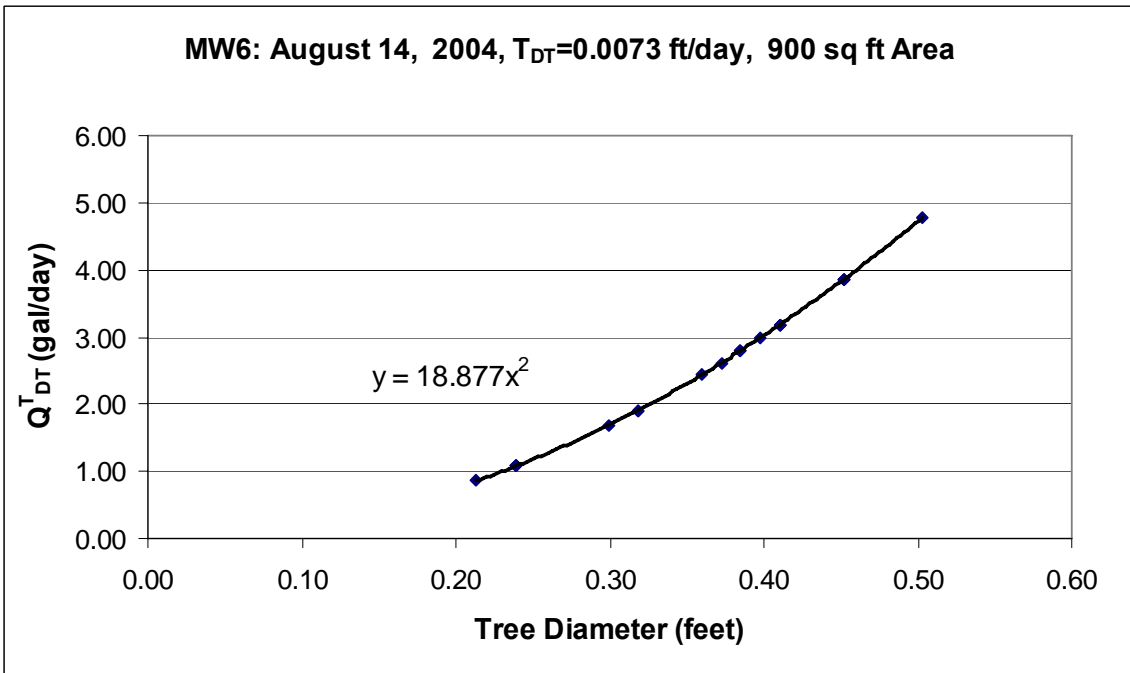


Figure E 6 MW6, August 14, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

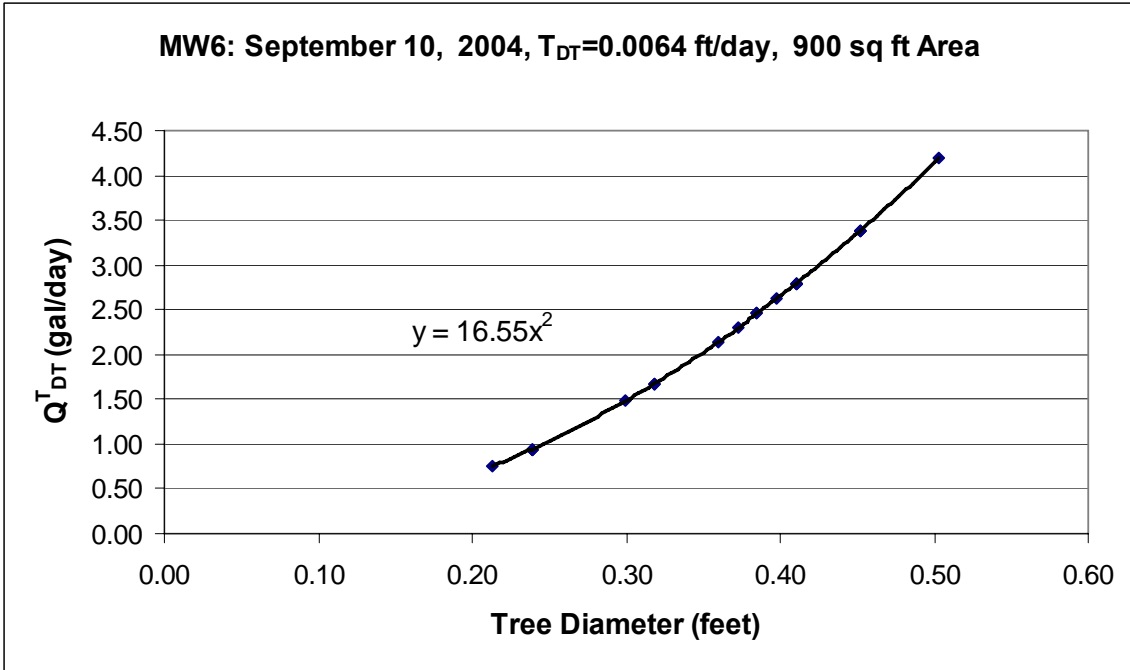


Figure E 7 MW6, September 10, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

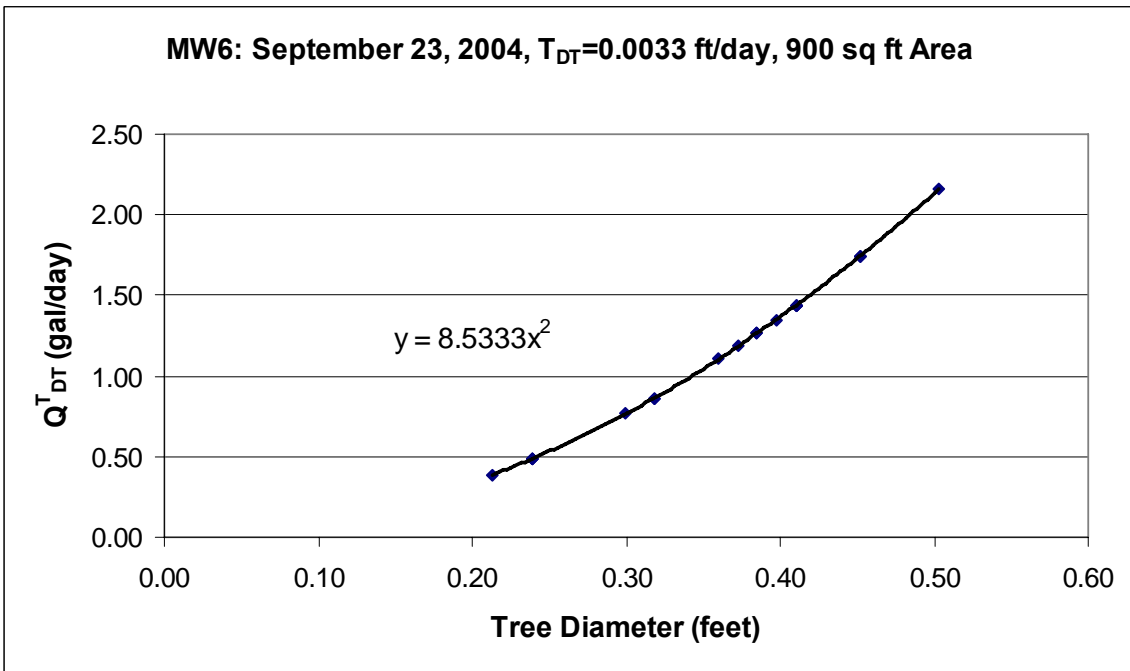
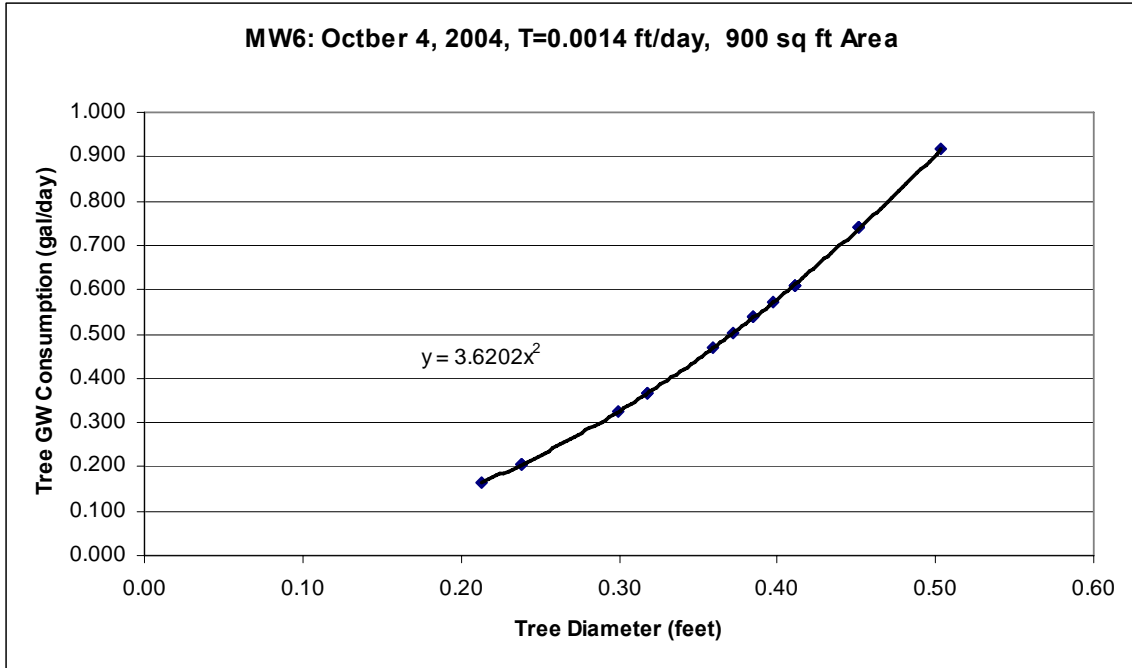
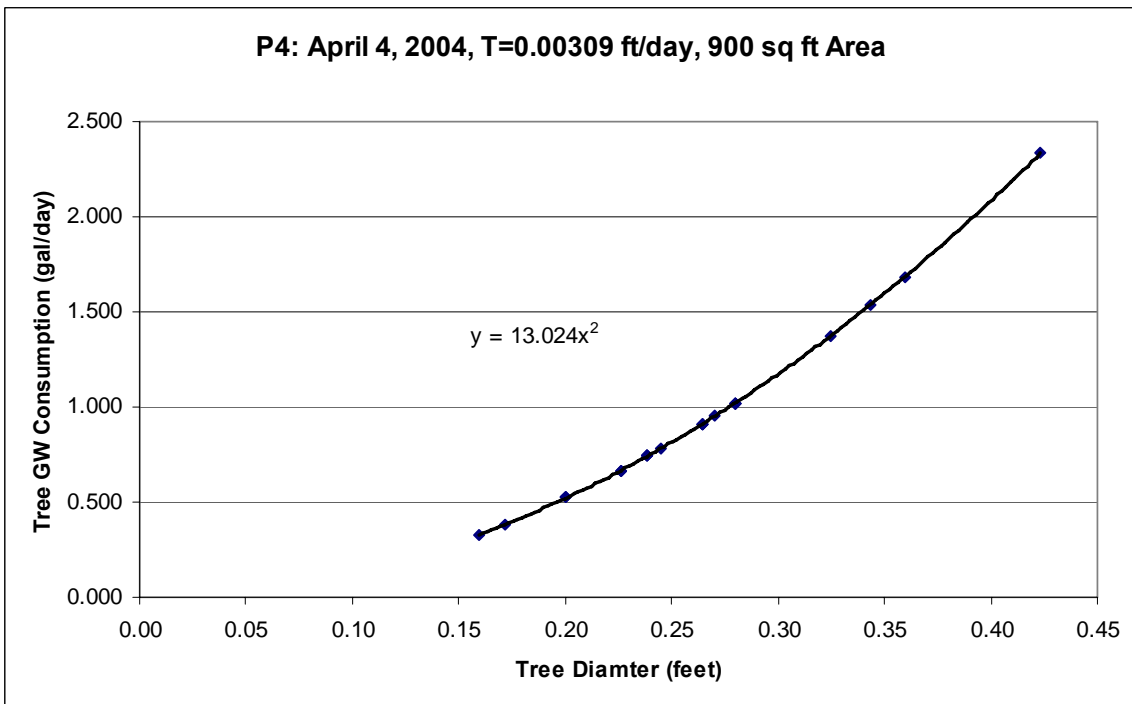


Figure E 8 MW6, September 23, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

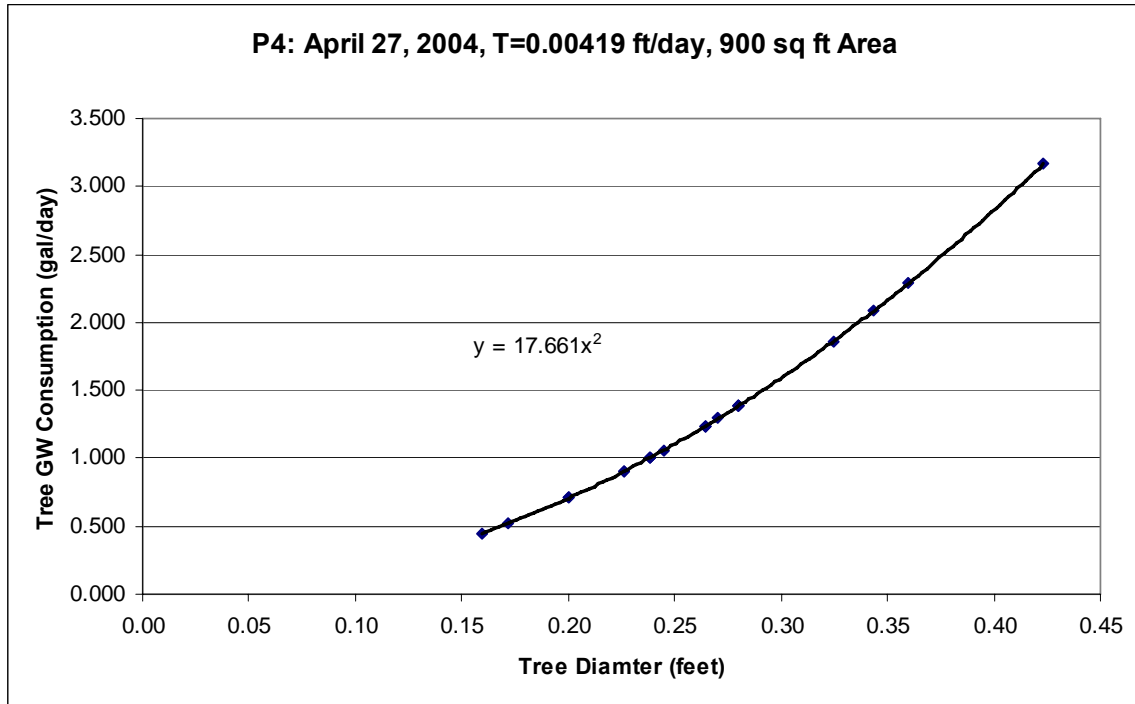




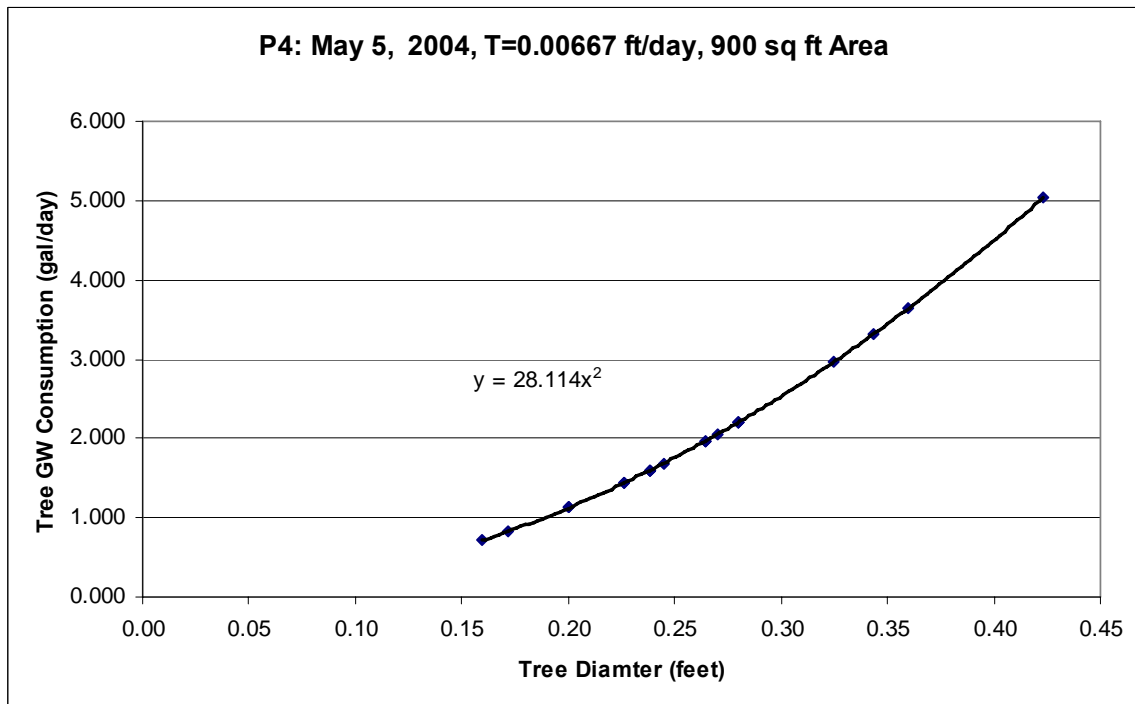
**Figure E 9 MW6, October 4, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>**

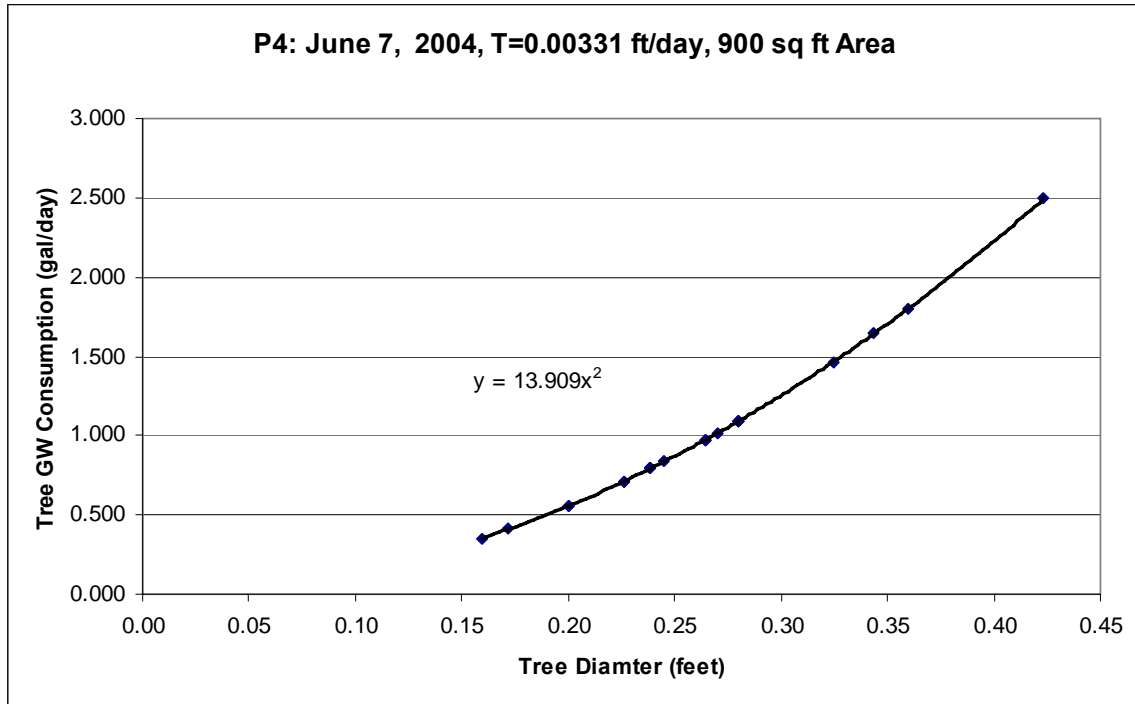


Figure E 13 P4, June 7, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

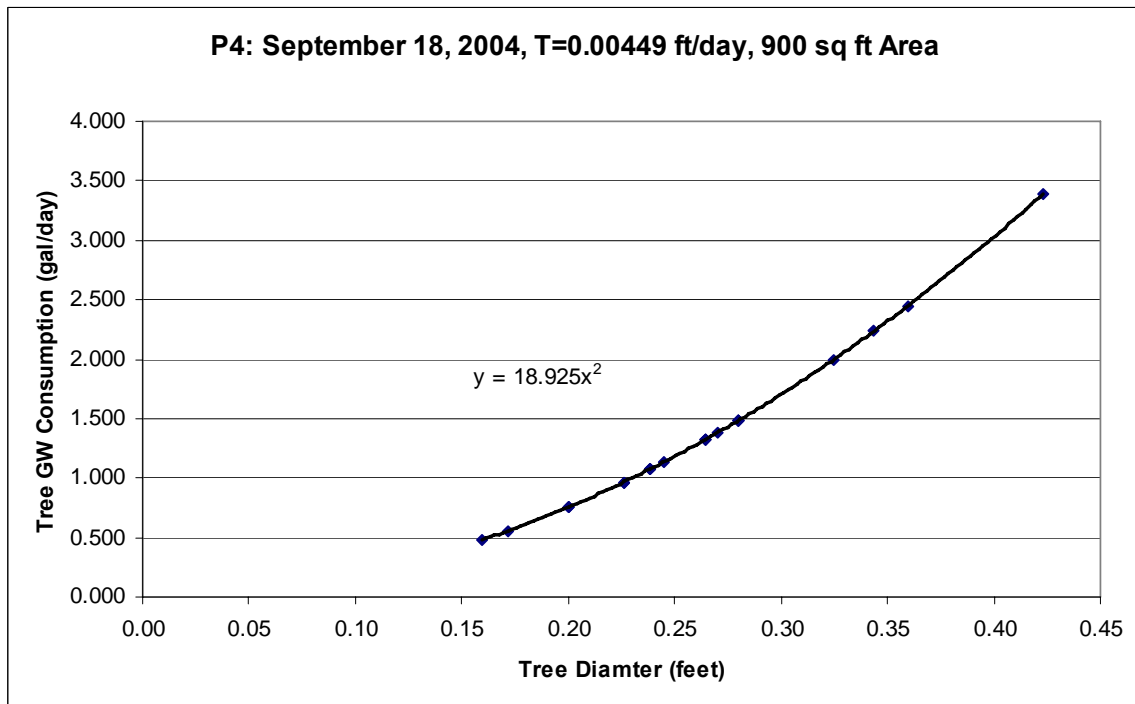
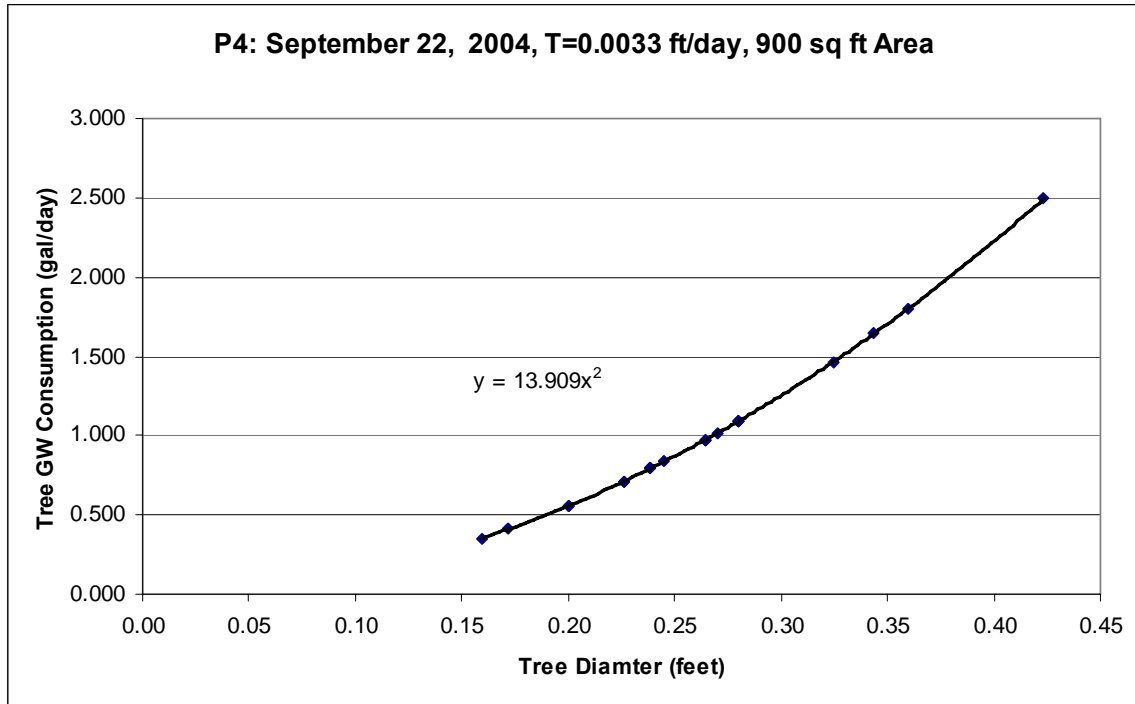
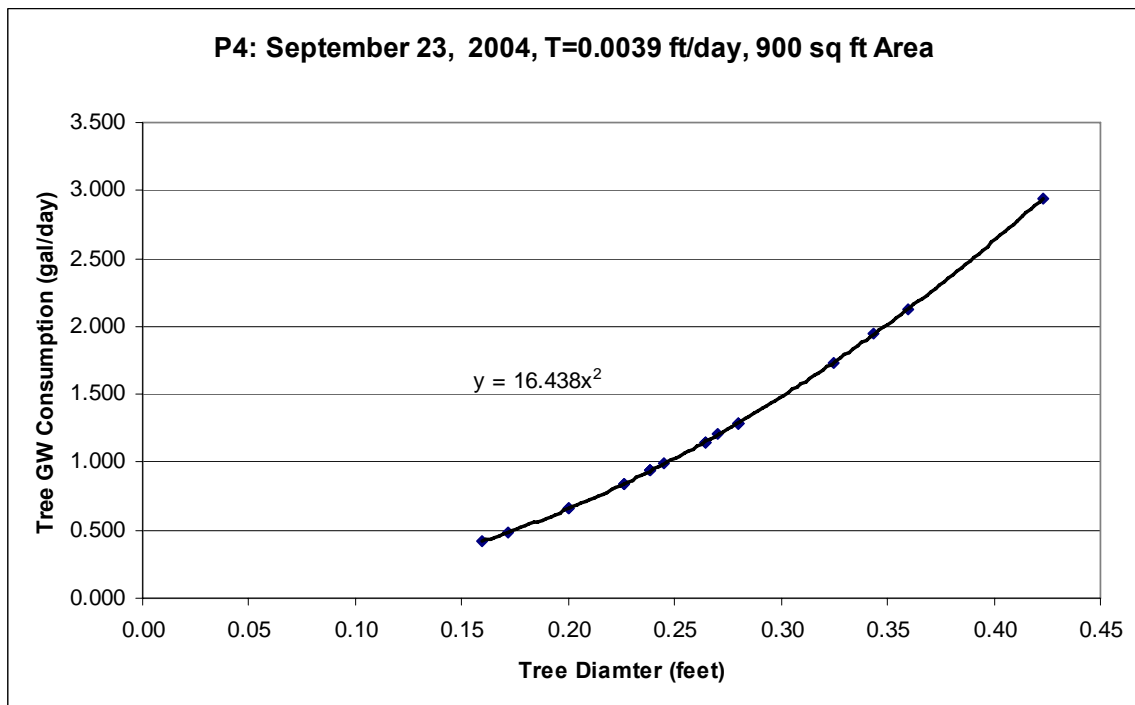


Figure E 14 P4, September 18, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

**Figure E 16 P4, September 23, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>**

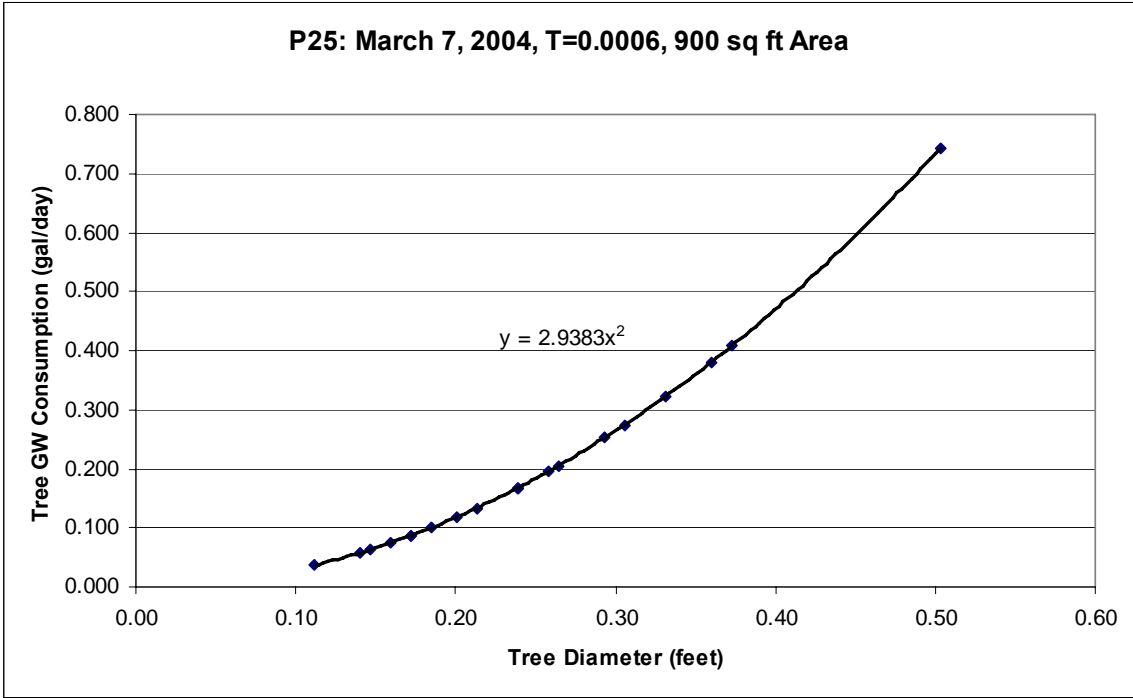


Figure E 17 P25, March 7, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

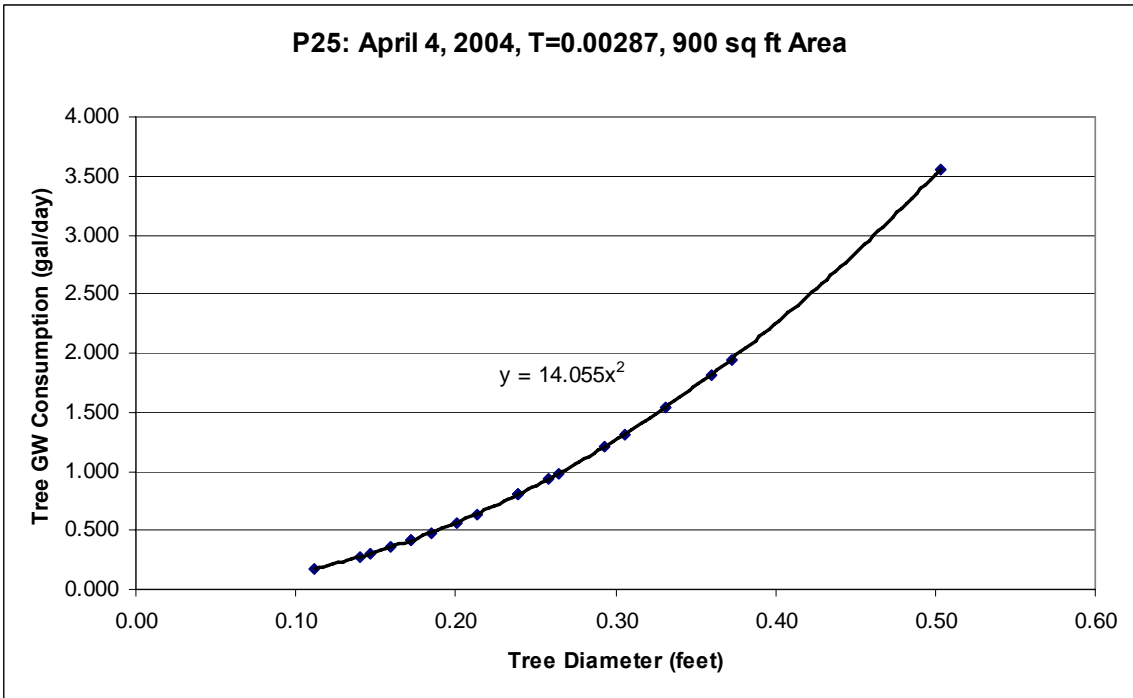


Figure E 18 P25, April 4, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

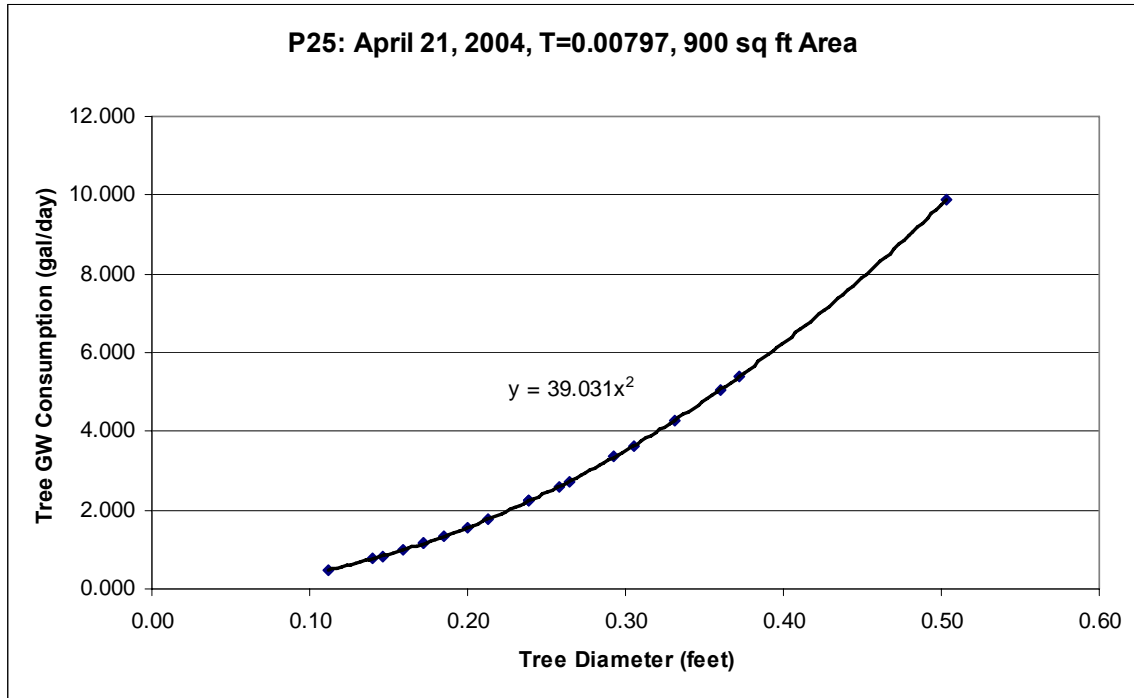


Figure E 19 P25, April 21, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

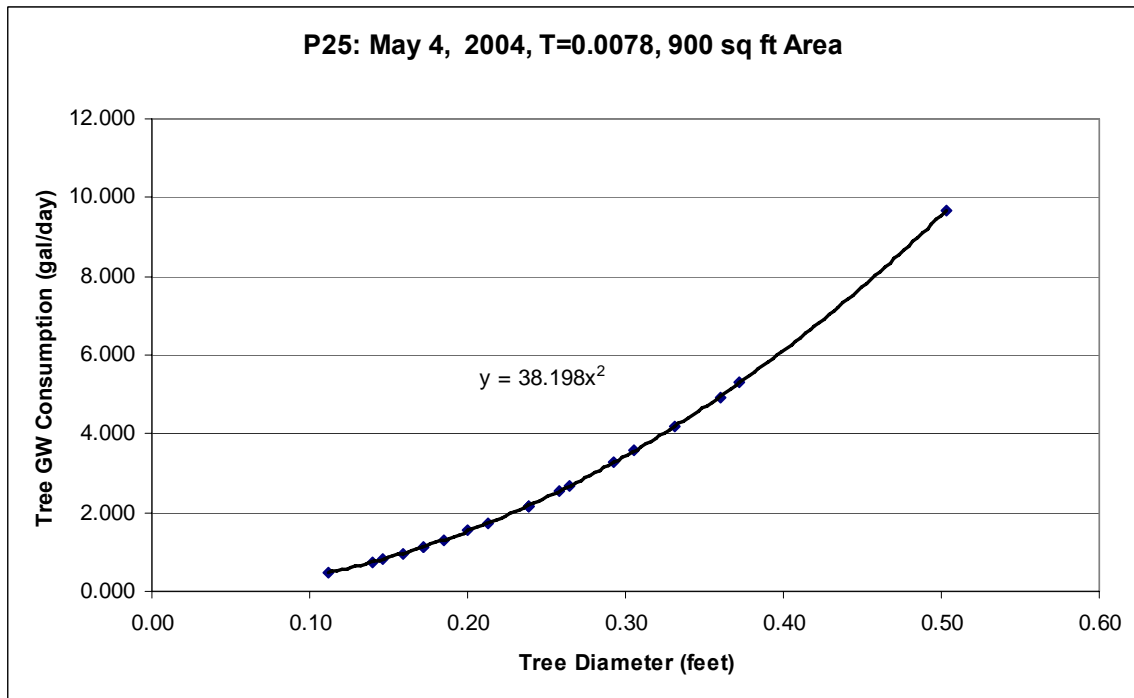


Figure E 20 P25, May 4, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

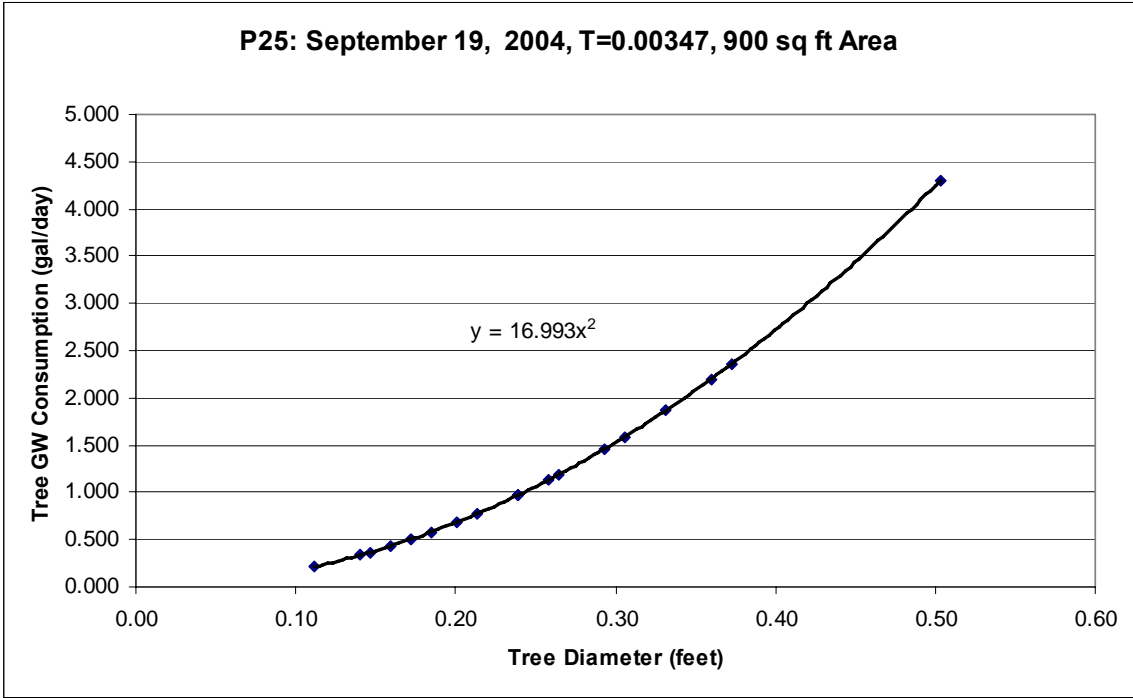


Figure E 21 P25, September, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

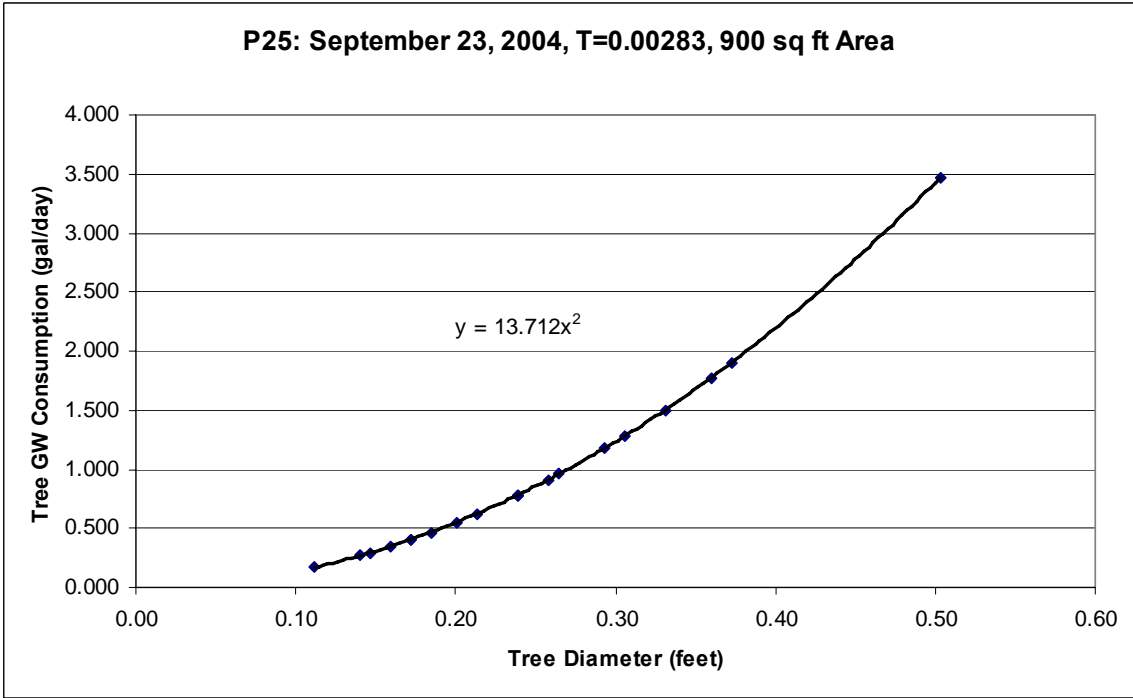
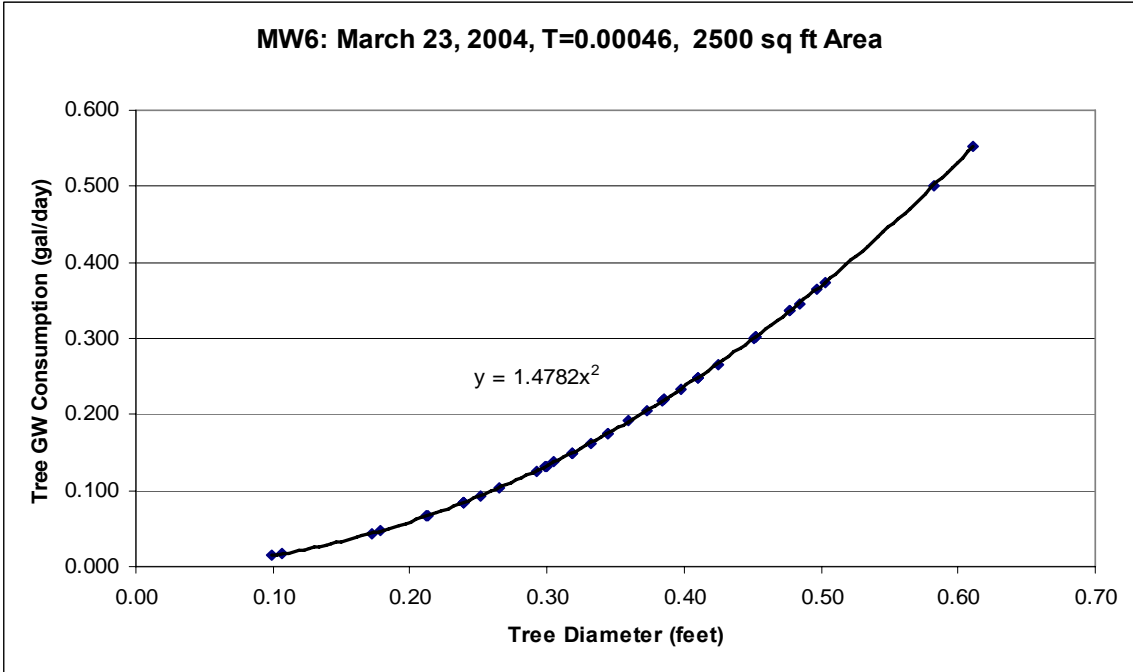
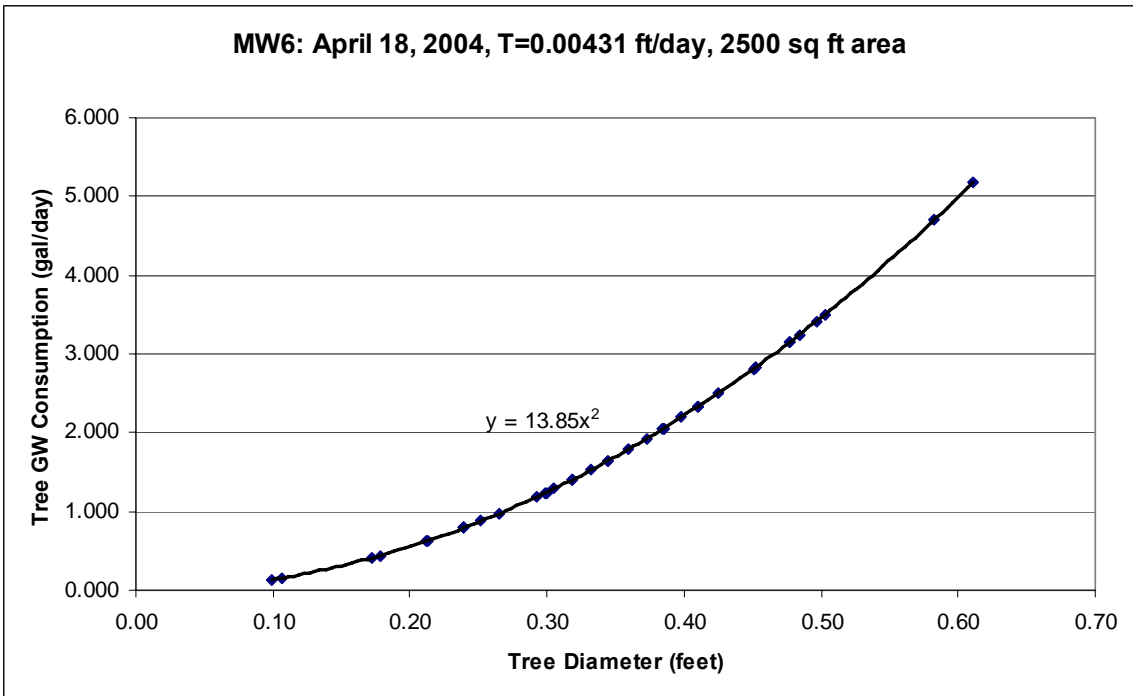


Figure E 22 P25, September 23, 2004, 900 ft<sup>2</sup>

**Figure E 24 MW6, April 18, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>**



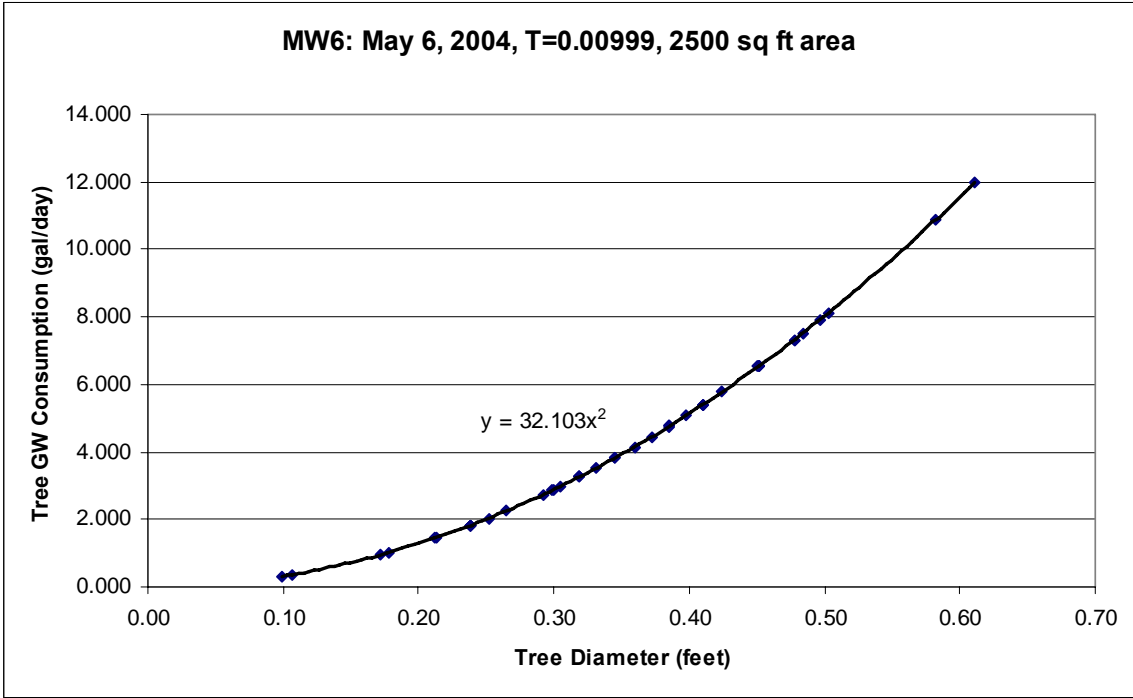


Figure E 25 MW6, May 6, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>

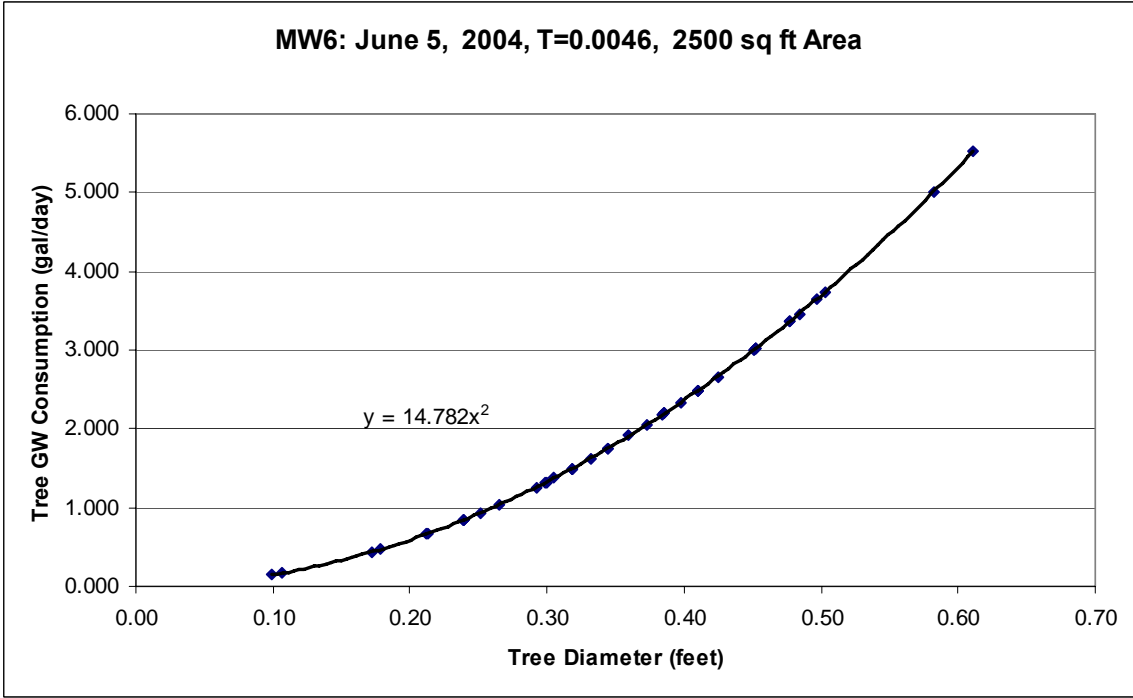
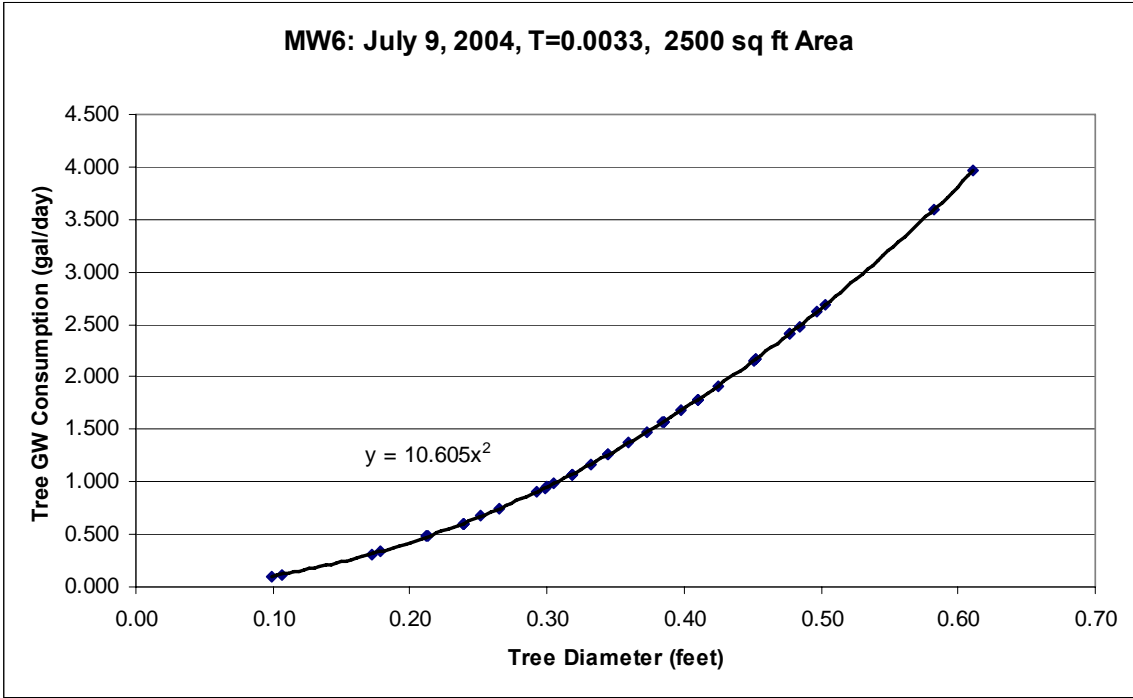
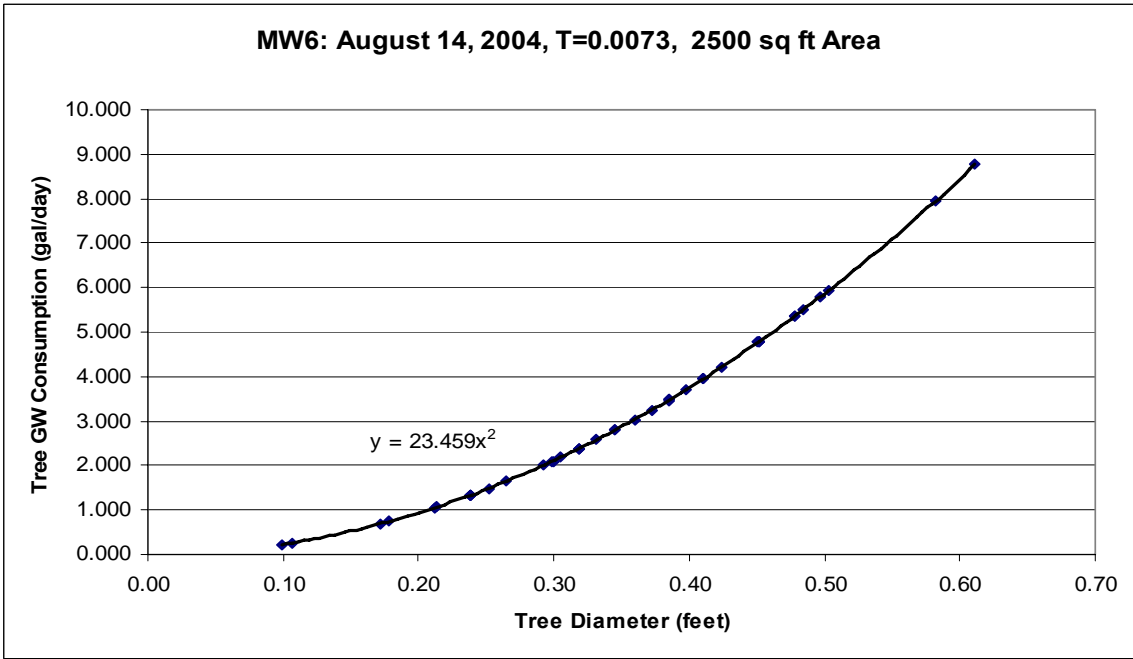


Figure E 26 MW6, June 5, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>

**Figure E 28 MW6, August 14, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>**

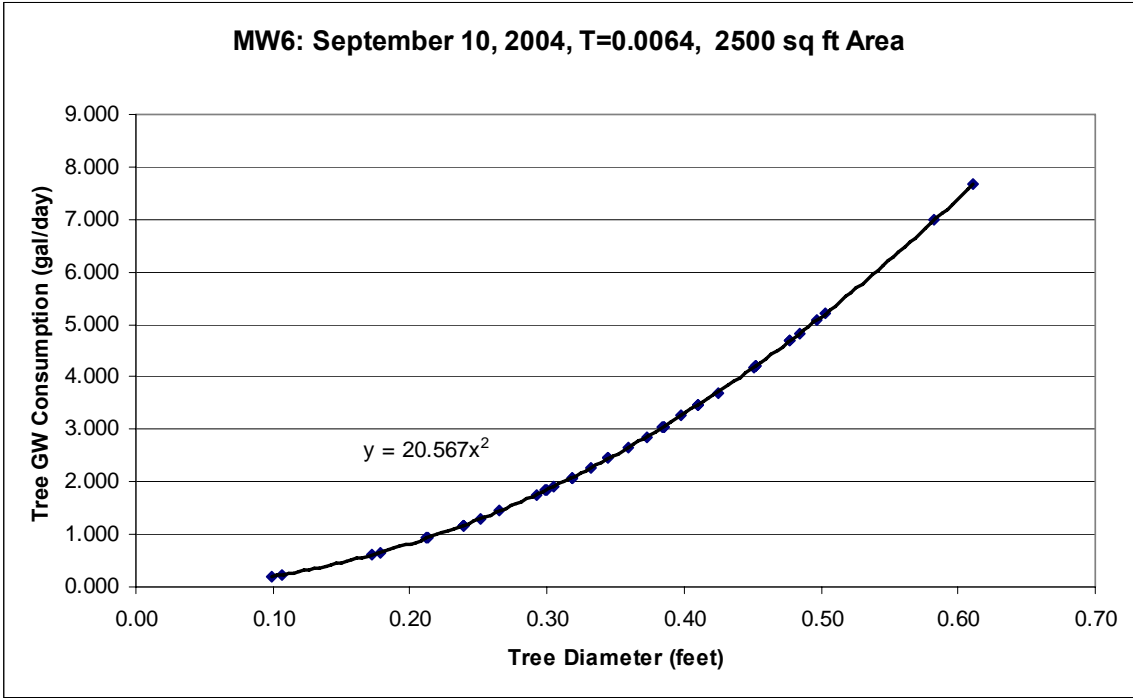


Figure E 29 MW6, September 10, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>

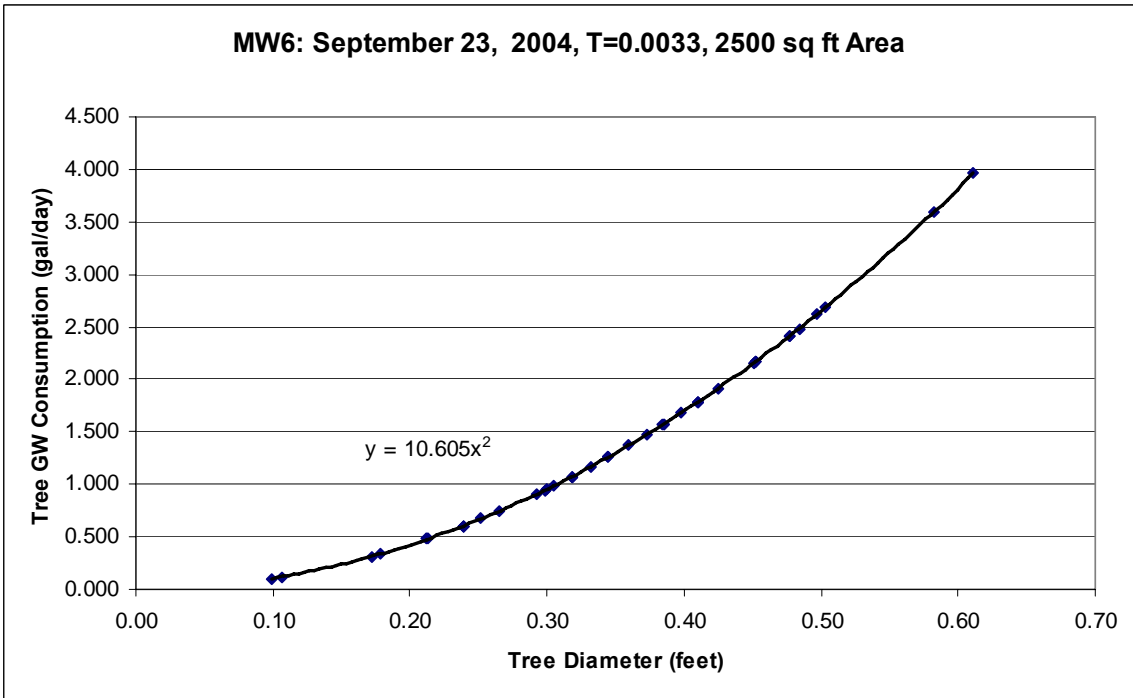
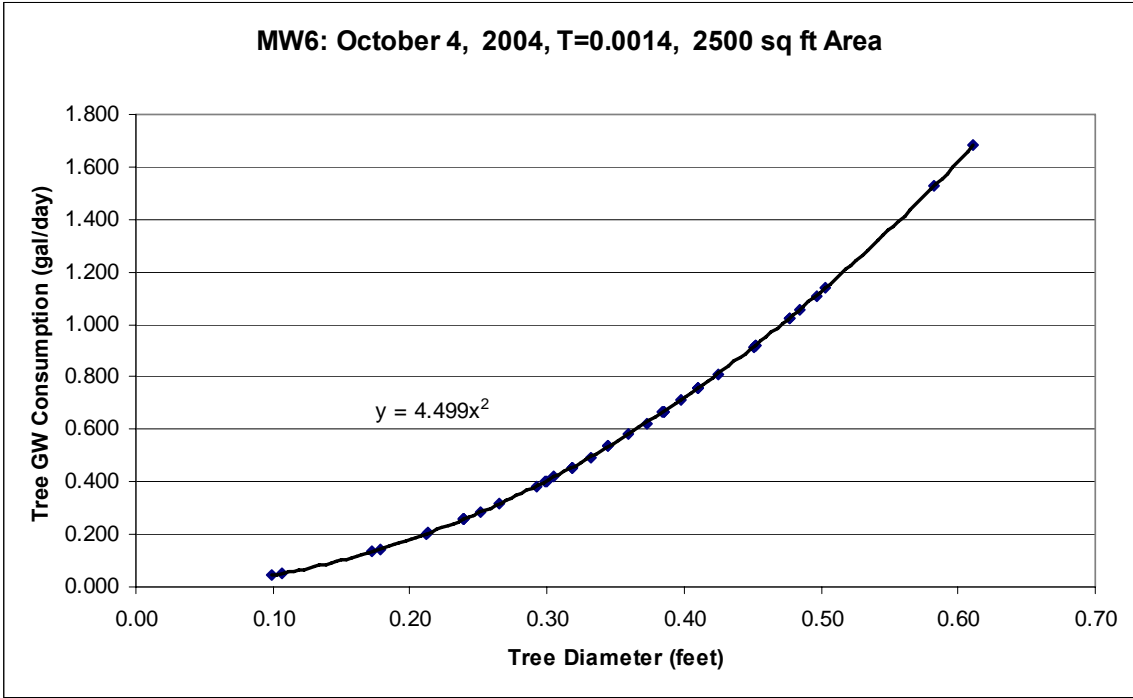
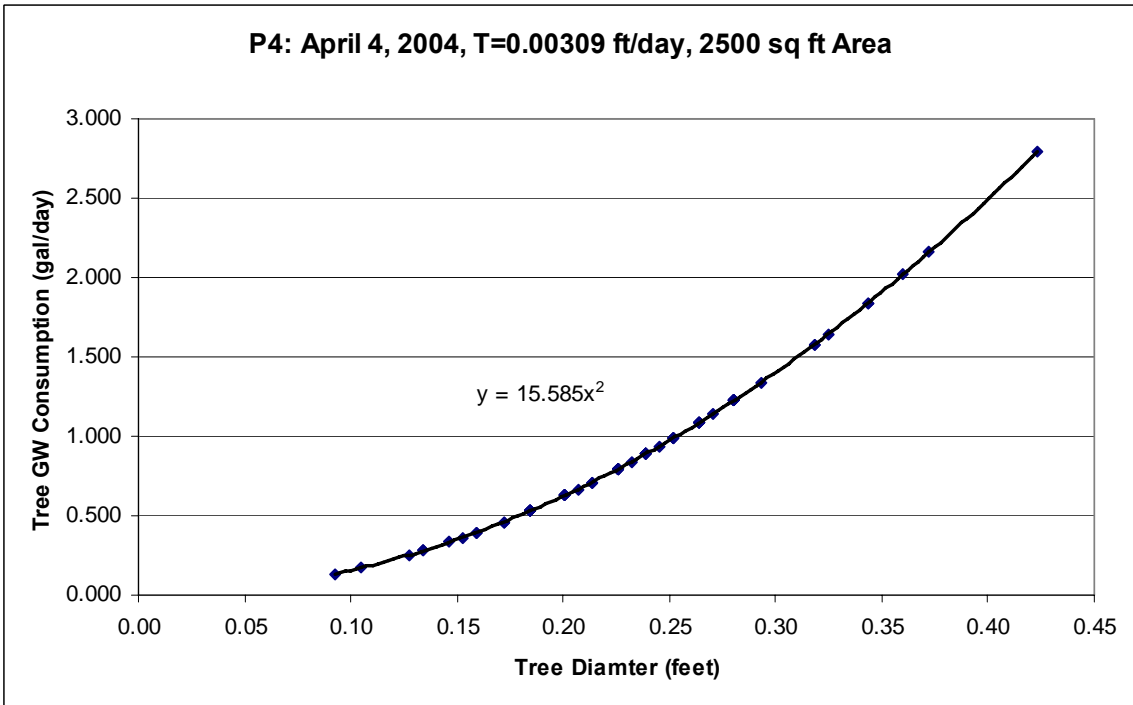


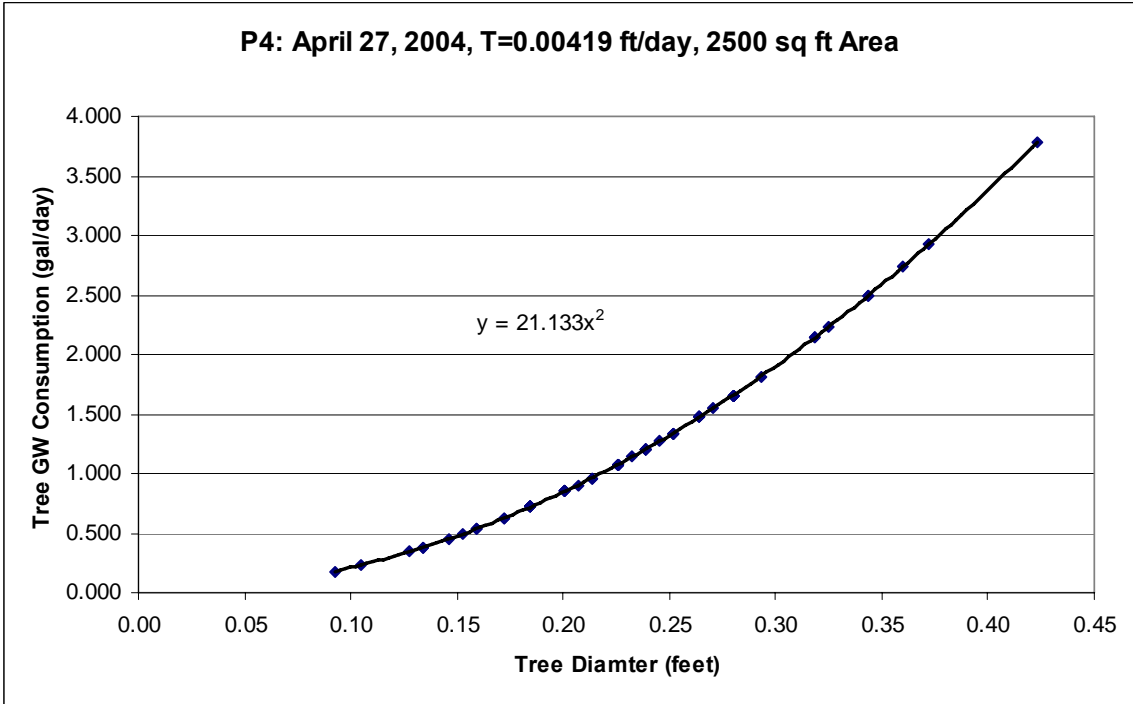
Figure E 30 MW6, September 23, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>



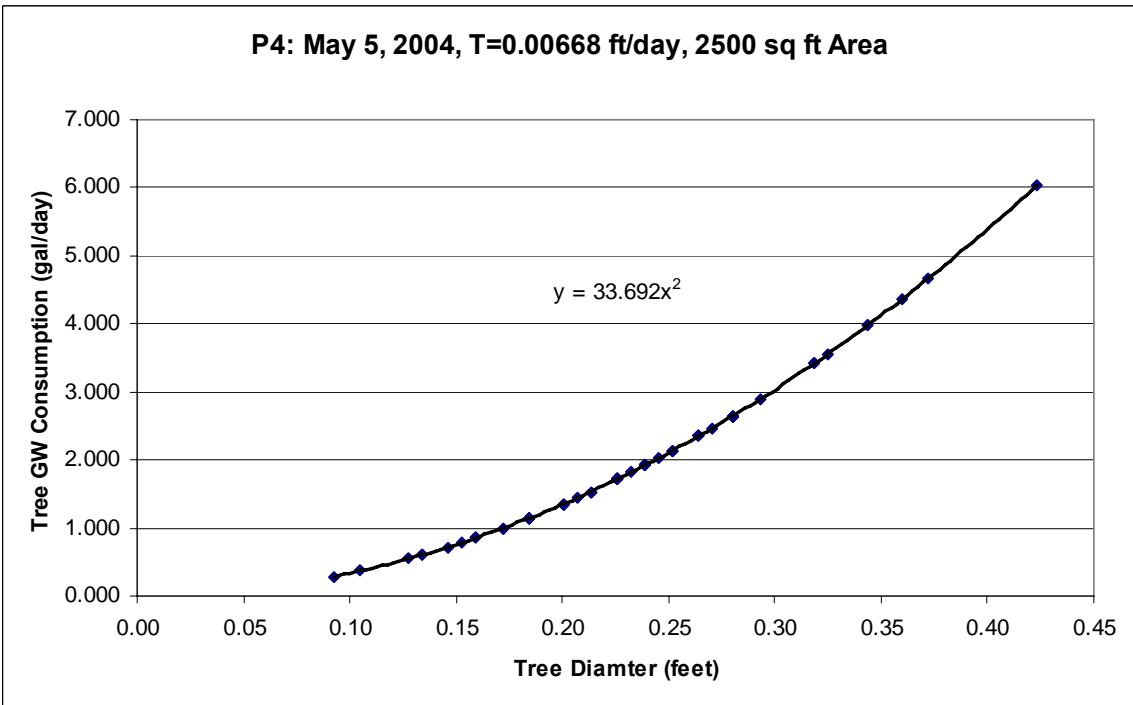
**Figure E 31 MW6, October 4, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>**

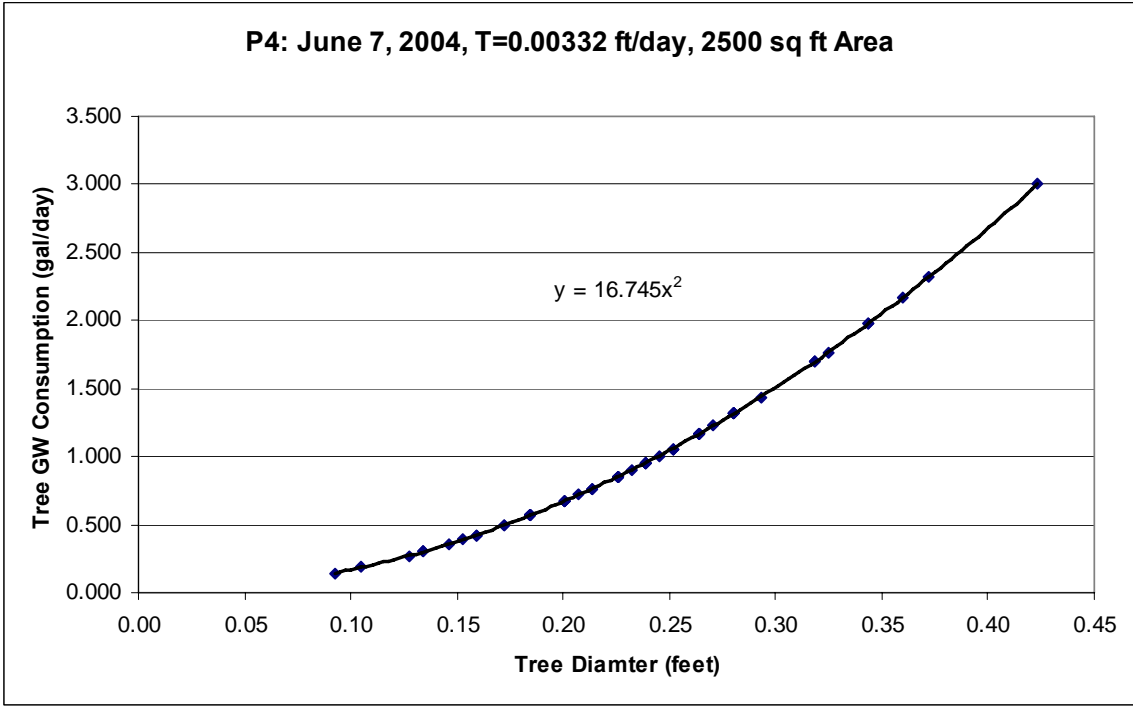


Figure E 35 P4 June 7, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>

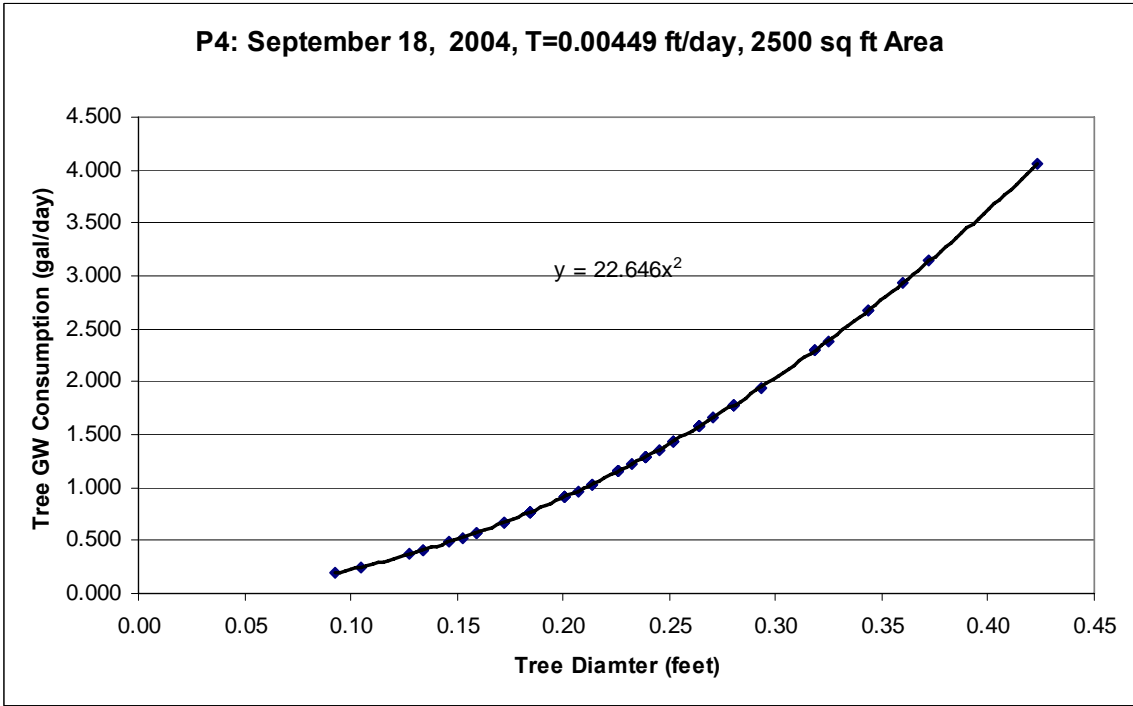
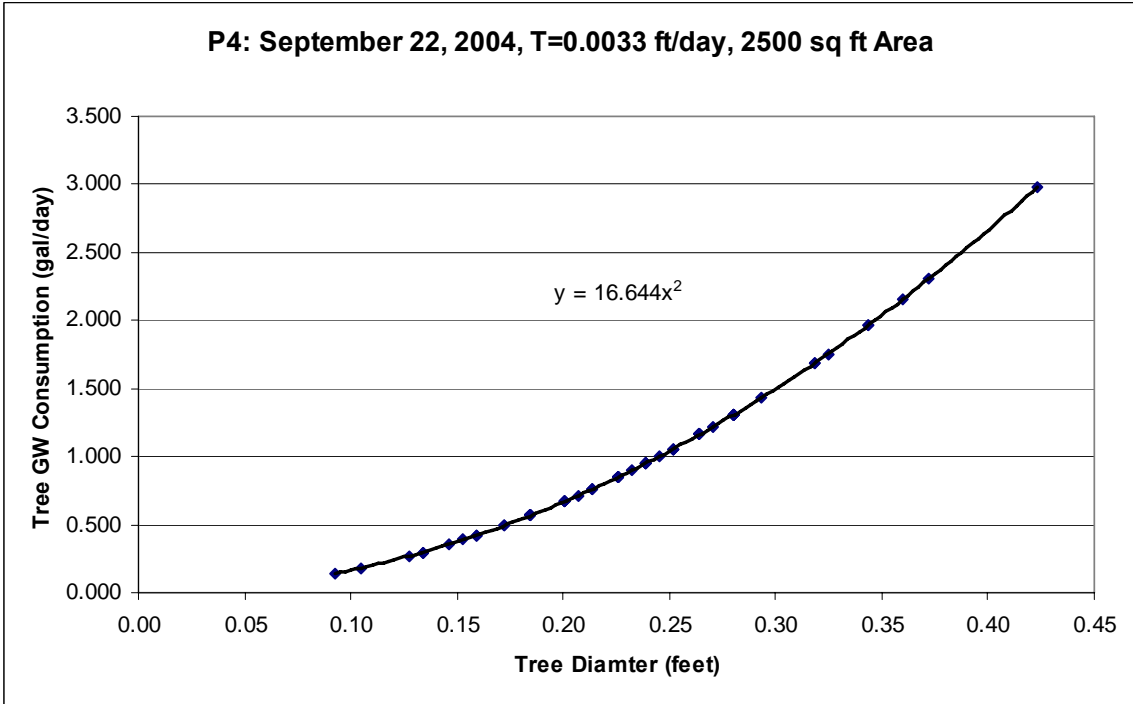
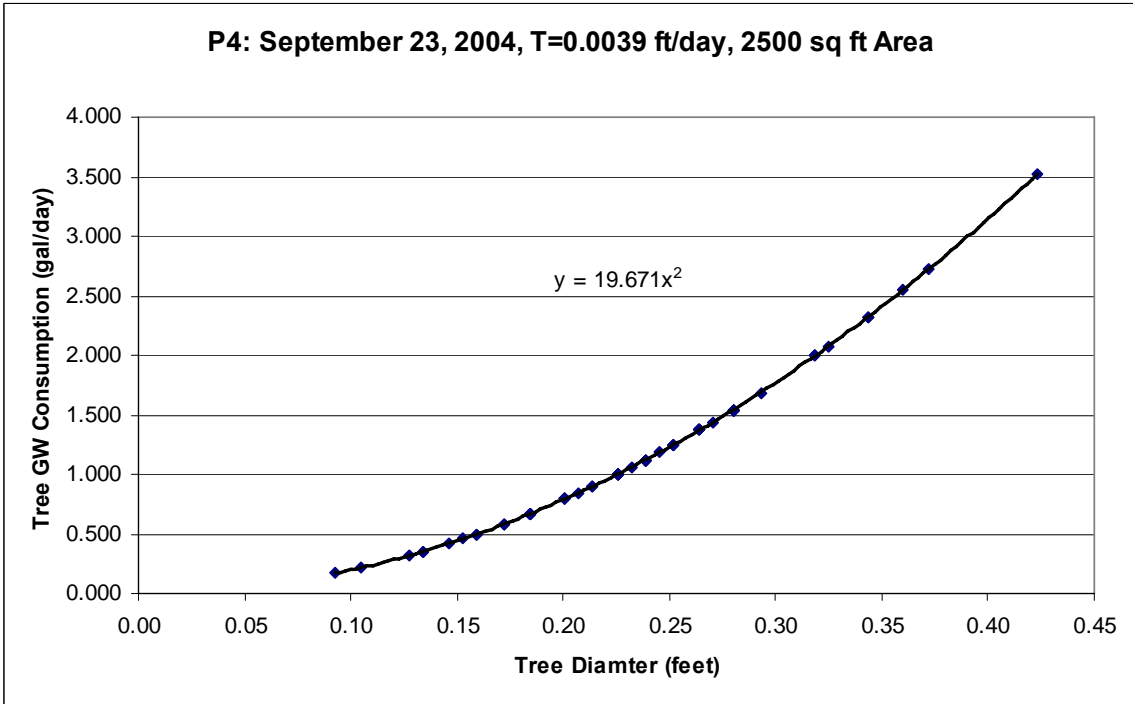


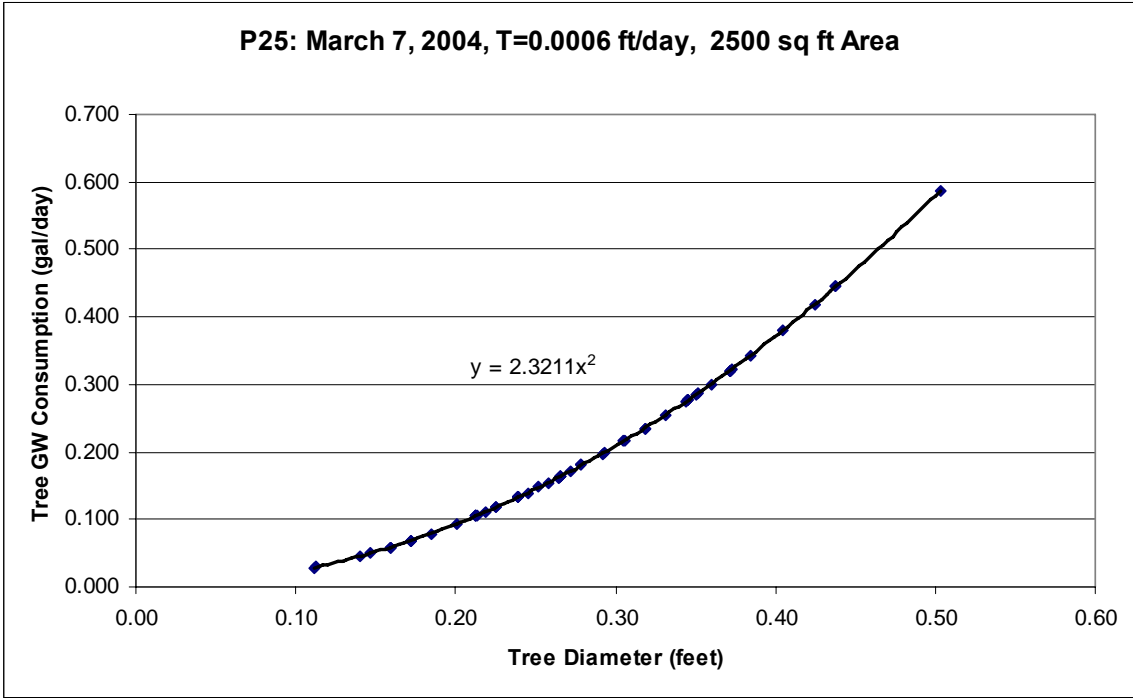
Figure E 36 P4, September 18, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>



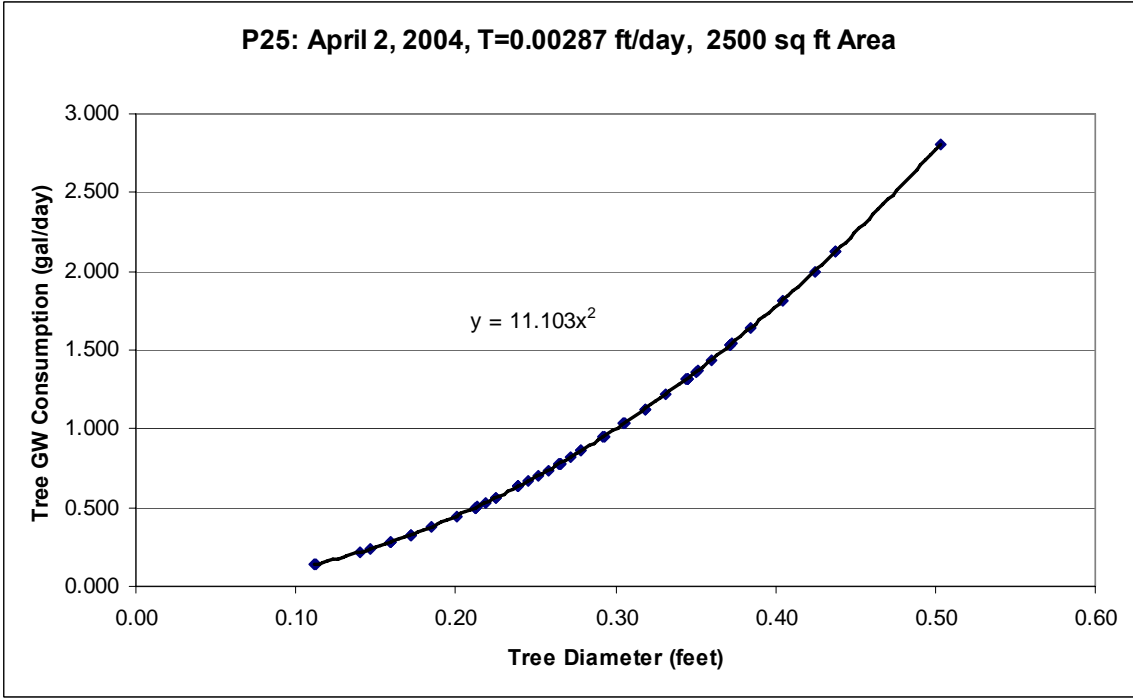
**Figure E 37 P4 September 22, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>**



**Figure E 38 P4, September 23, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>**

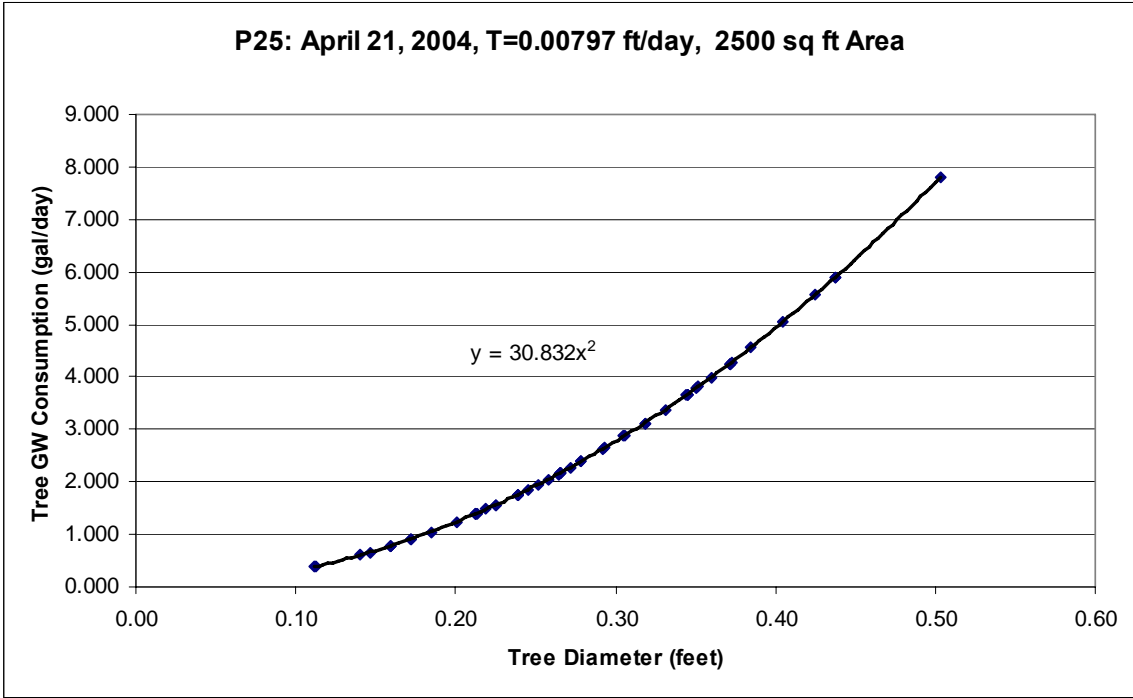


**Figure E 39 P25, March 7, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>**

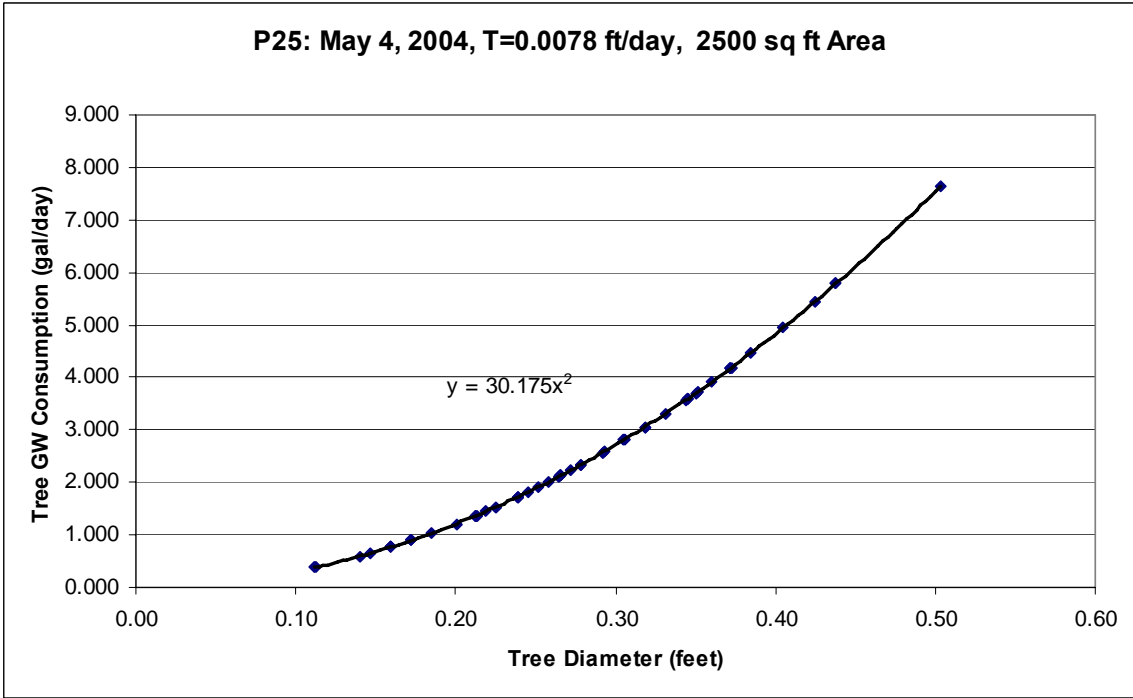


**Figure E 40 P25, April 2, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>**

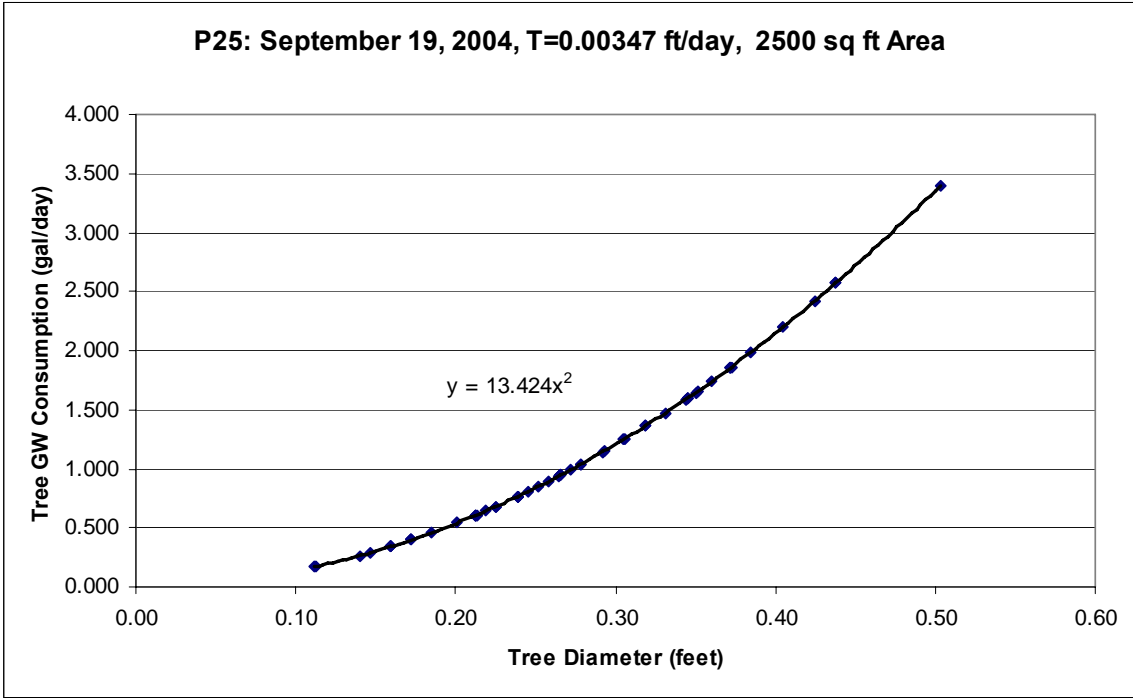


Figure E 43 P25, September 19, 2004, 2500 ft<sup>2</sup>

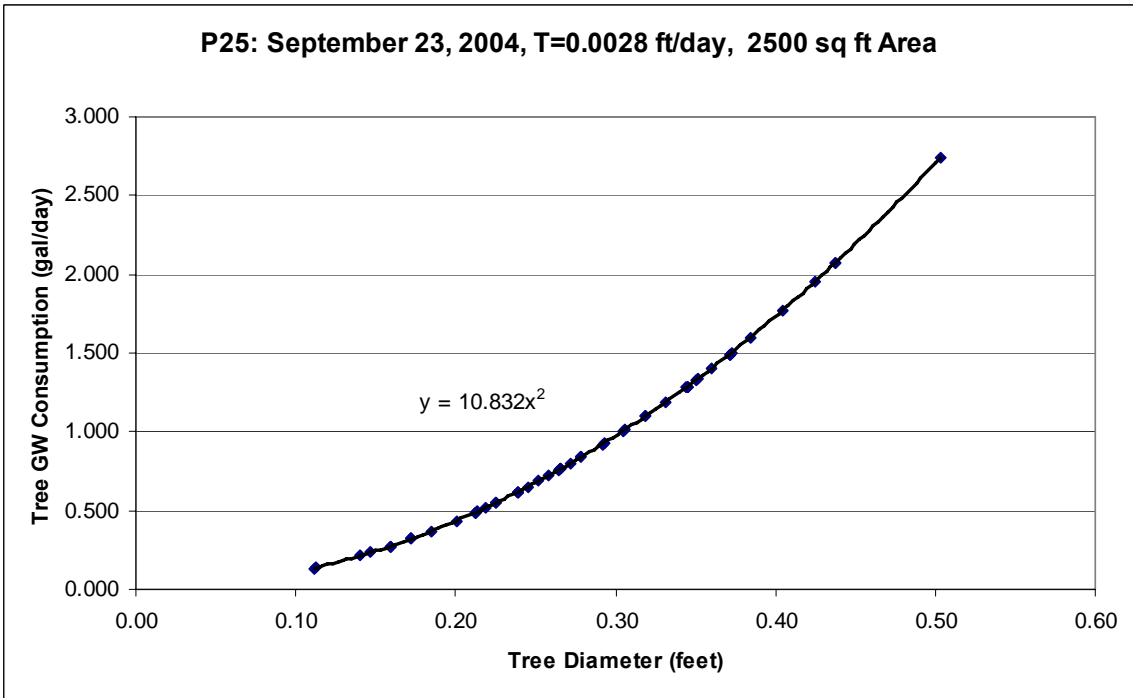


Figure E 44 P25, September 23, 2004
