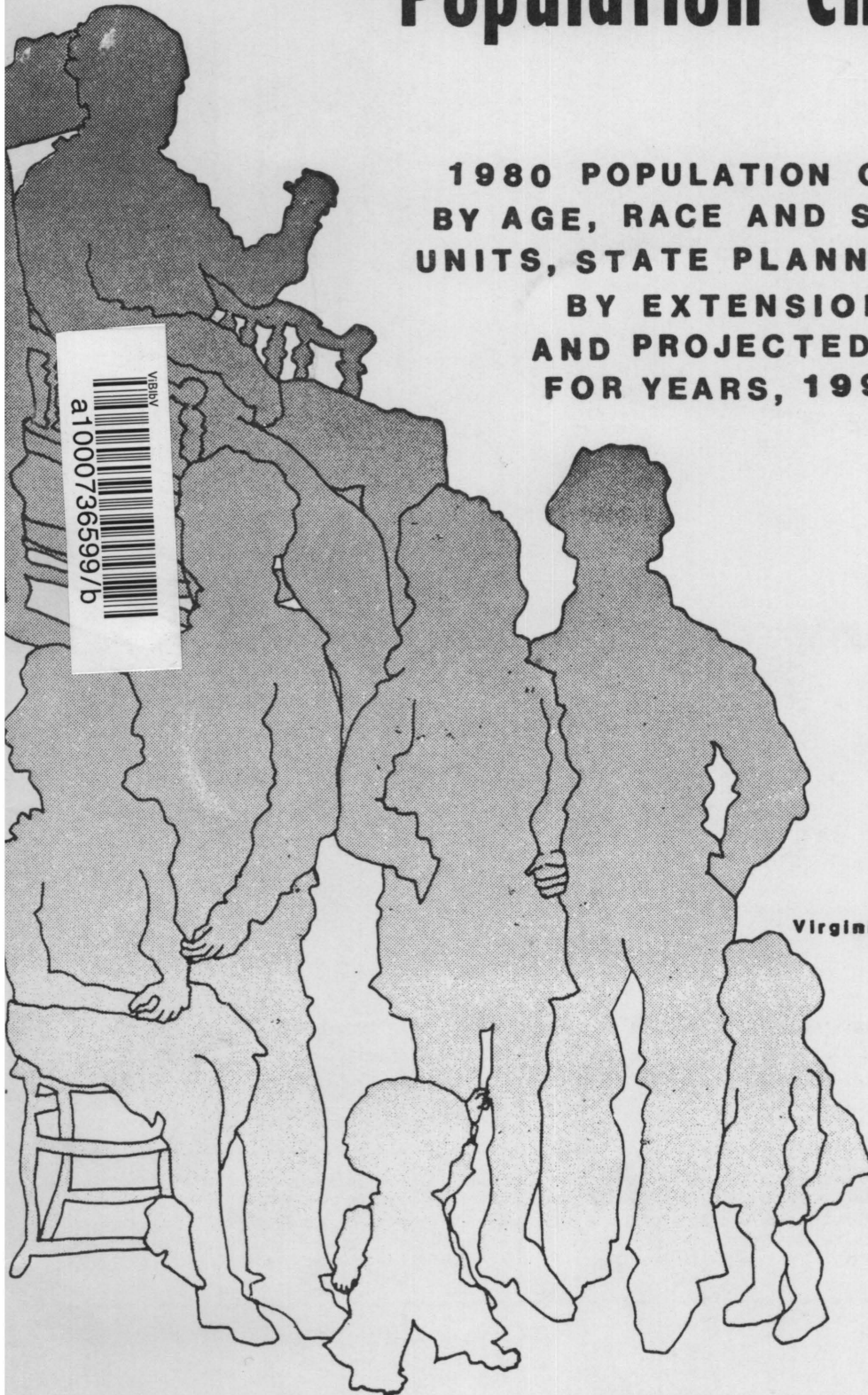

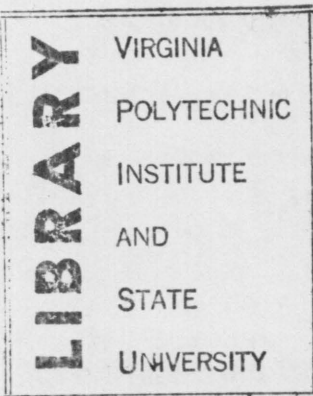

Like any report which attempts to predict future conditions the following population data represents forecasts that are subject to change from a variety of unforeseen social and economic factors and may, from time to time, require the State to make minor adjustments. The data are the most recent predictions prepared by the Virginia Department of Planning and Budgeting, and based on current factors.

The population information contained in this report is useful to Extension for it allows the Extension professional to:

- Obtain new demographic knowledge for assistance in developing Plans of Work and evaluating possible new program emphasis areas.
- Measure the actual number of 4-H members against 4-H potential members by age, sex and race.
- Pinpoint areas where greater efforts need be made in order to strengthen 4-H programs and participation.
- Explain reasons for both low and high 4-H enrollments.
- Compare data between Extension Units and Districts with a standardized base.

The data in Table 1 show total 4-H age youth for 1980, 1990 and 2000, by age, sex and race for Extension Units, all other cities, and for State Planning Districts. Table 2 presents this same information at the Extension District level. Percentages at the District level are shown in Tables 3 and 4. Table 3 compares youth by specific ages within the perspective age divisions by percentages for Extension Districts and the State. Table 4 utilizes the State as the population base and draws percent comparisons by Extension Districts.

A brief overall analysis of the data 1980-2000 show a general decrease in the number of future 9 year olds, an increase in youth ages 10-14 years, and a reduction in youth 15-19 years. The Northern district is the only district expected to show a gain in youth 9 years of age. Gains in youth age 10-14 will be registered in all but the East Central and West Central districts. For youth 15-19 years only the Northern district is expected to show a numerical increase.

Due to the confidentiality of census data, total figures for the 1980 age breakdowns for Units and Planning Districts and Extension Districts may be different from the sum of the parts which go towards making up that total. The reason for the discrepancy as explained by the Bureau of the Census is as follows:

#### SUPPRESSION OF DATA FOR CONFIDENTIALITY

To maintain the confidentiality promised respondents and required by law, the Census Bureau takes precautions to make sure that its published data do not disclose information about particular individuals and housing units. To accomplish this, the Bureau suppresses data for some characteristics which are based on a small number of persons and/or housing units in the geographic area. Under certain conditions, both primary and complementary suppression may take place.

The general rules of primary suppression are as follows: counts of total population by race and Spanish origin are never suppressed; other characteristics for persons are shown only if there are 15 or more persons in the geographic area.

In some cases, complementary suppression is applied to prevent the derivation of primary suppressed data by subtraction.

The data for this publication were taken from the 1980 Census of Population, Characteristics of the Population, General Population Characteristics, Virginia Table 45, Age by Race, Spanish Origin, and Sex for Counties, 1980 and from Virginia Population Projections 2000, prepared by Donald P. Lillywhite and Debra A. Stephens, Department of Planning and Budget, Research Section, Richmond, Virginia.

The Population projections for 1990 and 2000 for Counties, Cities and Planning Districts in this publication replace the projections reported in the Population Characteristics publication, December 1977.
