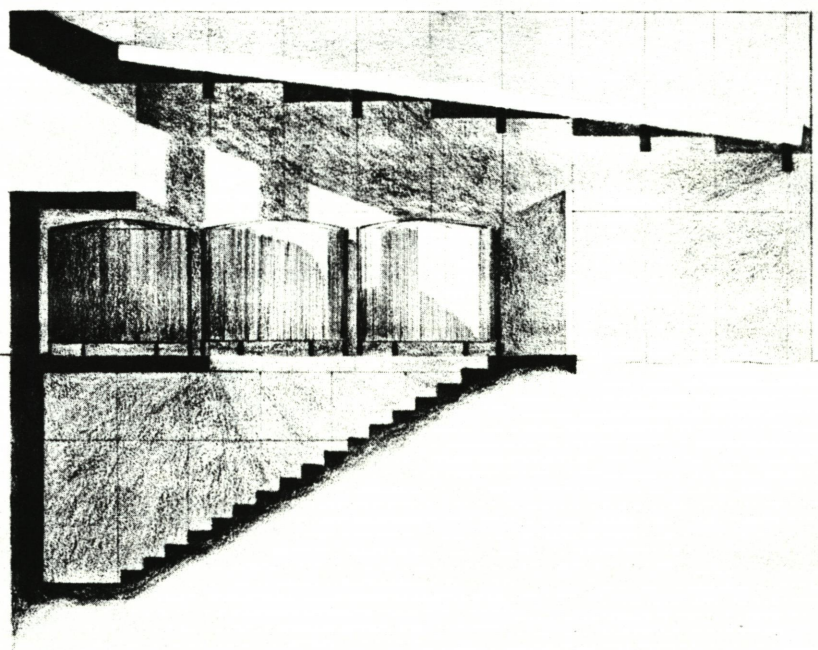


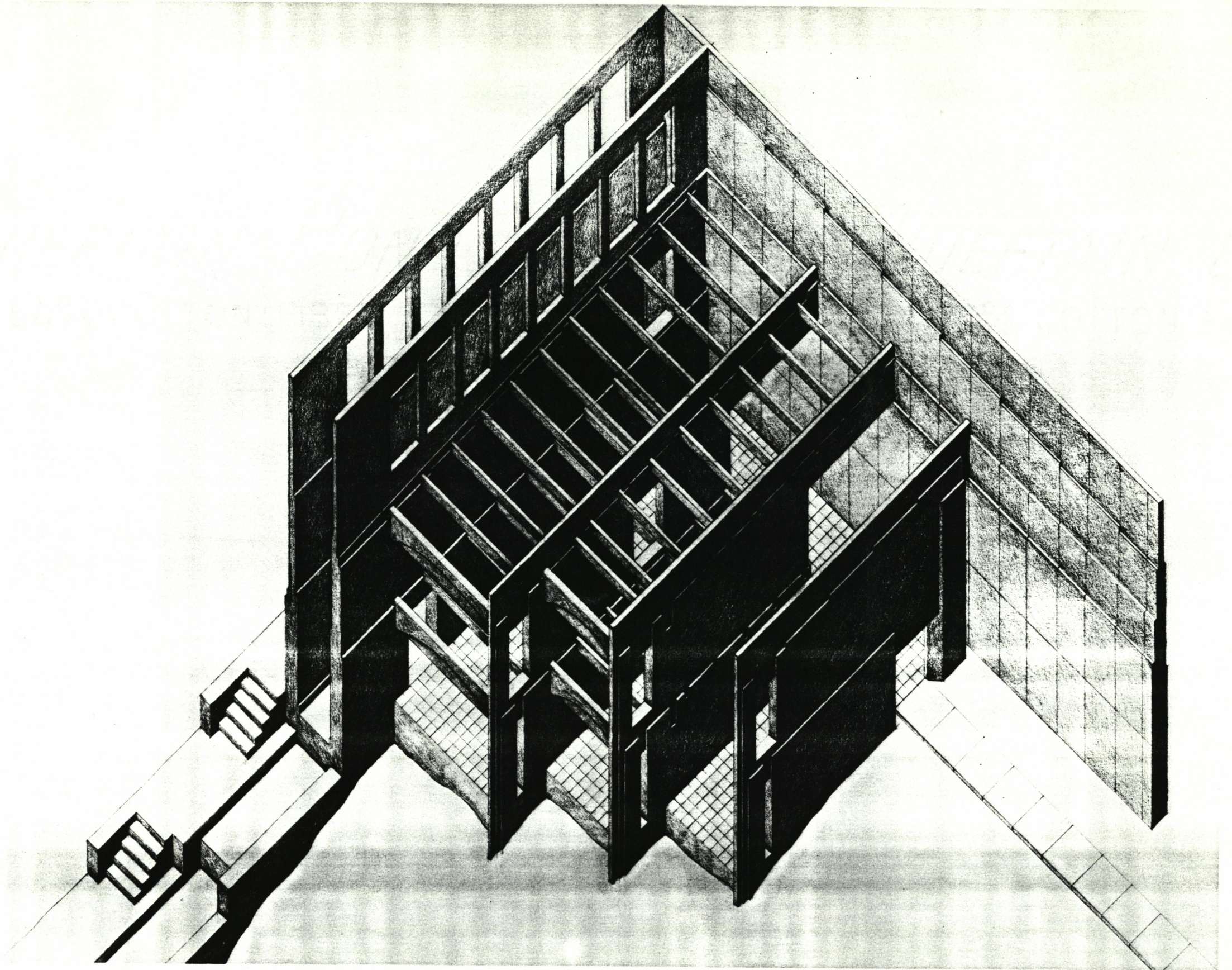


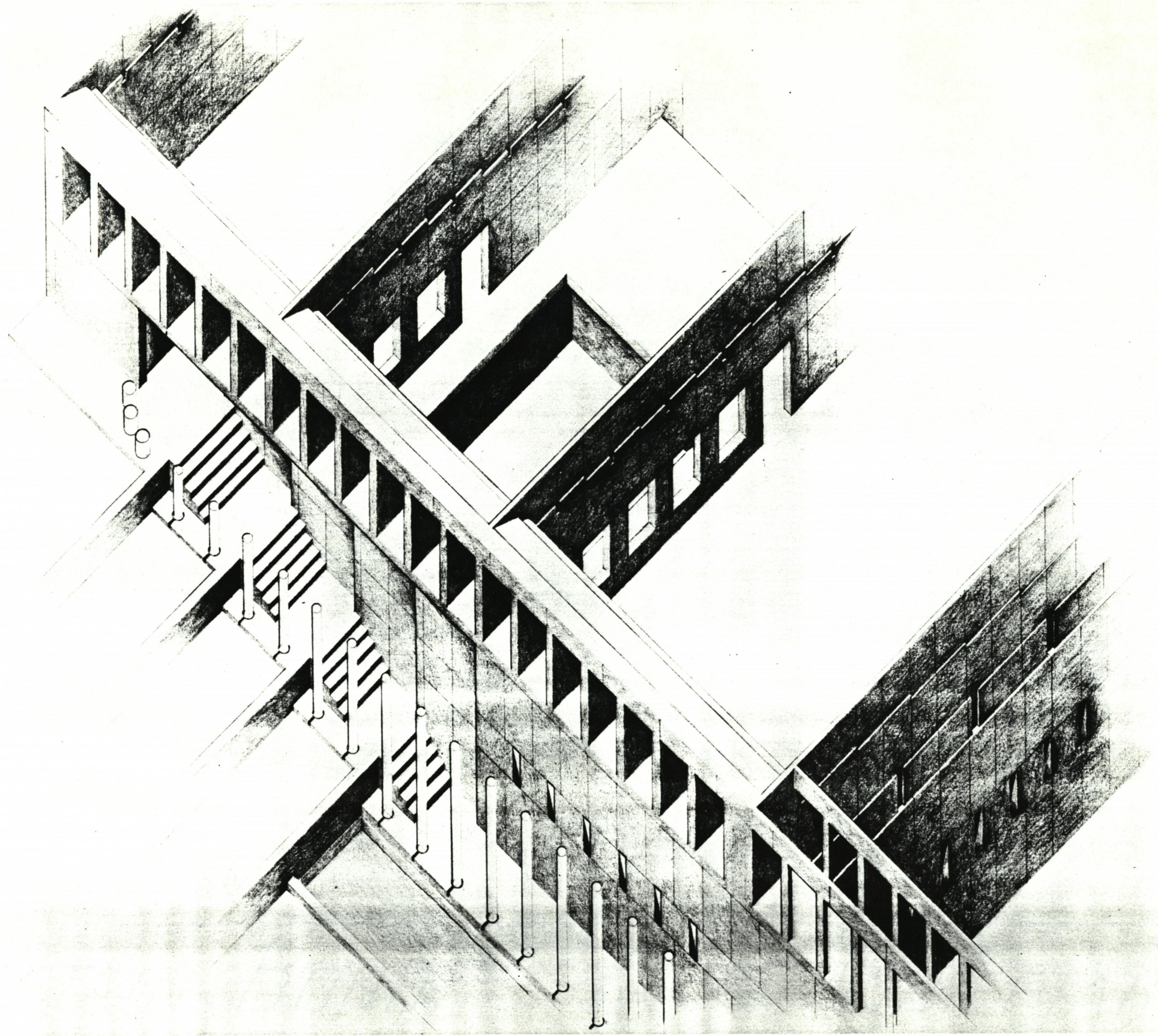
CHIFFON BOND
