

AN INSIDE JOB: EMPLOYEE THEFT

Retail workers will steal more than 40 billion dollars from American businesses this year. It takes 40 to 50 shoplifting incidents to equal the loss caused by one dishonest employee. And one out of every three business failures will result from employee dishonesty.

The Community Resource Development staff of the Virginia Cooperative Extension Service feels that **AN INSIDE JOB** is an effective employee-theft prevention presentation that law enforcement agencies can and should incorporate into their overall business-crime prevention program. Combine **AN INSIDE JOB** with live presentation to educate business owner/operators on who the employee thieves are, how they operate, and how to stop them.

Suggested Uses:

To provide select audiences with accurate, current knowledge of employee theft. To provide an educational program to serve as an introduction piece for audience discussion.
