"The information has been assembled from various sources within the Department, and from State schedules of legal weights. There is a considerable variation in weight per unit of volume due to differences among varieties, size of the graded commodity, condition and maturity, type of container, tightness of pack, and degree to which the container is heaped."

The list presented here is the best average which could be determined. "The approximate or average weights as given in this table do not necessarily have official standing as a basis for packing, or as grounds for settling disputes."

All weights are in pounds per bushel, box or crate as indicated.
