



DOORS

locate conveniently and safely
when you build or remodel

To Use Less Space:


Usually a door in a corner of a room permits better use of wall space for arrangement of furniture than a door located in the center of a room wall.




A door located to open only a quarter of a circle takes less space in the room and interferes less with furniture location.

For Safe Use:

When a door opens at the top of a stairway, it is desirable to have a landing inside the door before the steps start. Stairway doors should be located (or identified in some way) so they will not be confused with doors leading to another room on the same level. Plan the door so it swings away from the stairway. Use a handrail on the stairway on the stairway.



A door which opens into a hall, or one standing ajar, may injure persons walking in the hall if it is opened suddenly. Instead, have the door open into the room.





Glass doors should be easy to identify as doors. A handle or push bar can help people identify a glass door. When fixed glass panels are used as a wall or part of a wall, some device should be used to keep people from walking into them. Plants in pots or boxes may be set in front of the full-length glass windows or panels. Use furniture or a decorative object as a barrier or traffic guide.

To Provide Wall Space:


To avoid a half circle door swing, or to avoid using space to swing a standard hinged door, consider one of these types.



recessed door between two rooms



bifold doors



folding door

Select

- Doors that operate smoothly and quietly.
- Exterior doors that will stand up to frequent use and exposure to weather.
- Door hardware that is sturdy and has a durable finish.
- Doors which suit your needs.

Doors can be made to order for special purposes (though standard models are less expensive).

- for unusual dimensions
- for unusual color, material or finish

Doors are available which are built to

- reduce sound transmission
- retard spread of fire

Accessories which add to convenience

Door closers are often used on exterior doors. Heavy closers are operated hydraulically, light ones are controlled with an air cushion.

Door stops attached to the wall or floor will stop the door from being opened too wide and keep the door from bumping a wall or piece of furniture.
