### Education Scholarship & Research

The Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) defines education scholarship as “any material, product, or resource originally developed to fulfill a specific educational purpose that has been successfully peer-reviewed and is subsequently made public through appropriate dissemination for use by others.”<sup>1</sup> It is difficult to deny the merits of not only consuming, but also producing education scholarship.

Effective education scholarship drives continuous program improvement and supports the professional development of teaching faculty and everyone benefits. Students benefit from the use of innovative teaching strategies. Faculty benefit from feedback from the peer-review process, broadening their teaching toolboxes, and having a record of their efforts. Institutions benefit by gaining name recognition amongst educational leaders on a national level. The message is clear...we, as health professions educators, need to engage in the practice of education scholarship. But, how do we get started?

The Office of Continuing Professional Development and TEACH understand that education scholarship can be challenging. We want to help. Here are some resources and ways to get the ball rolling:
