



You should know that 4-H is a part of Virginia's Land-Grant institutions (Virginia Tech and Virginia State University) with the U.S. Department of Agriculture and local governments cooperating. 4-H members participate in projects that use information and ideas from the universities. Adult volunteers, trained by university staff, teach projects that cover a wide range of activities. Each project offers a chance for 4-H members and their families to "learn by doing." 4-H teaches youth leadership, citizenship, and skills they will use throughout their lives.
