

As we enter into winter break, if you've been curious about 3D printing, come check out the Vet Med Library's Lulzbot printer. We've processed over 200 requests for students, faculty, staff, and the teaching hospital since June. For material types, we primarily print with PLA (food grade plastic), but other materials we have in stock include nylon, polyester, and a flexible material. We are also happy to try printing with other materials, just come meet with us to discuss options.

Also, while the library will be closed from December 22nd - January 1st (sorry, no printing during that time), if you'd like to see what the machine can do, or learn more about this technology in general, the rest of this week and in January before the semester begins are great times to swing by.
