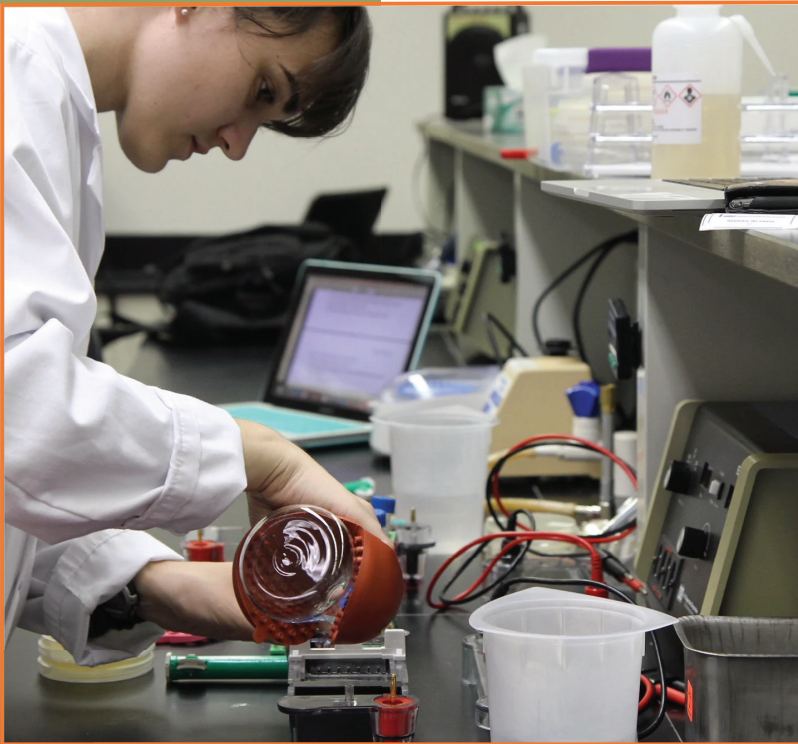




# PHAGE HUNTERS
