Report on Farm Building Work and plan
service from Aug. 13th 1923 to Nov. 15th 1923.

The use of plans for building work has greatly
increased in the past five years. The extensive
plan service offered by N.P.S. has not been ^{greatly} advertised
due to the fact that more calls have been
received for plans of a special nature than
could possibly be properly handled by the
force we now have. The service has been
developed along sound & conservative lines
to insure the greatest amount of good
to the farmer with the least possible
expenditure in the preparation of plans.

Our files have plans of every type of farm
buildings nearly all of which have been prepared
by this department. Plans prepared by other insti-
tutions and the U.S. Dept. of Ag. are also on file
but we have found that Virginia ~~conditions~~
^{like many other states are peculiar unto itself and general}
plans quite different from other states and have
^{hardly} found very little use for these outside plans.

Requests for special plans have received
our earnest consideration in this way that
if a special plan can be made somewhat
of a standard plan we make complete drawings
and fill the calls as far as this plan will. If
the special plan is quite minor we prepare
same.

Quite recently a bulletin was put out giving a brief description of each standard plan which we have on file - this bulletin has been sent to each Co. Agent as well as Home Demonstration agents. The result has been an increased call for plans.
