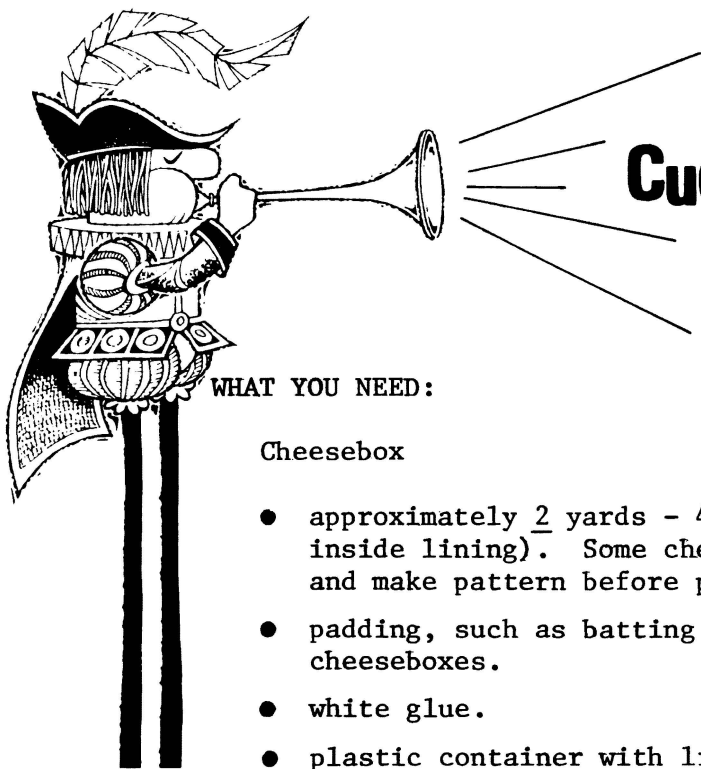


Cue Sheet

JOY ITEM

UPHOLSTER A CHEESE BOX



WHAT YOU NEED:

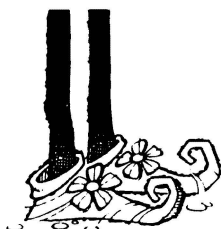
Cheesebox

- approximately 2 yards - 45" material (1½ yards felt for bottom and inside lining). Some cheese boxes vary in size. Take measurements and make pattern before purchasing fabric.
- padding, such as batting for quilts, 8 oz. package will do two cheeseboxes.
- white glue.
- plastic container with lid -- like a margarine tub.
- paint brush (2").
- knob or handle you plan to use (wood drawer knob).
- posterboard weight paper -- 1 large sheet.
- corrugated board for inside of box lid and bottom of box.
- scissors.
- tack hammer and regular hammer.
- clothes pins -- 10 or 12.
- upholstery tacks -- small nails will do.
- screw driver.
- cardboard and something to cut it with.
- tape measure.
- staple gun and staples.

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1. Repair box; sand off rough edges.

2. Measure - LID: Top - diameter _____
Band - width _____
length _____

BOTTOM: diameter _____
Band - length _____
width _____
Sides - length _____
width _____

3. Find center of lid top and drill hole for knob.

4. Cut heavy paper (poster board) to fit width and length of bands.

5. Cut corrugated cardboard to shape of lid and bottom of box.

6. To pad box - use a diluted glue solution ($\frac{1}{2}$ glue and $\frac{1}{2}$ water)
- apply with a 2" paint brush

Outside: Lightly pad lid top, and bottom sides from
band to within 1" of edge
DO NOT PAD BANDS

Inside: Lightly pad sides of box to within 1" from
top
DO NOT PAD INSIDE LID

Pad one side of each piece of corrugated cardboard

7. Cut fabric LID: Top (A) - Cut circle of fabric and diameter
of top plus enough to cover $\frac{1}{2}$ band

Band (B) - Cut strip 3 times band width plus
 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and the length plus 1"

Inside circle (C) (cardboard) - Cut 1" - 2"
larger than cardboard for $\frac{1}{2}$ -1" to turn under

BOTTOM: Sides (D) - Cut a strip on the bias that is
2 times width of side plus 2" and the length
plus 1"

Band (E) - Cut strip 3 times band width plus
 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and the length plus 1"

Inside circle (F) - Cut 1-2" larger than card-
board for $\frac{1}{2}$ -1" to turn under

8. Covering Cheesebox:

LID: Top (A) Tack or staple fabric to back covering top of lid.

Band (B) Place right side of fabric next to band (excess fabric extends toward top). Tack poster board strip to band. Pull fabric over cardboard and tack to inside of top.

Add decorative knob.

Cardboard circle (C) Cover padding with fabric. Glue fabric edges to side of cardboard that is not padded. Hold in place with clothespins until dry.

Slip covered circle inside top with padded side up. (Tight fitting cardboard should stay in place).

BOTTOM: Side (D) Tack to bottom band with wrong side next to box. Pull fabric over side of box and tack or staple to bottom.

Band (E) Cover same as top band except pulling fabric to bottom for tacking.

Cardboard circle (F) Cover same as top (C). Slip covered circle inside bottom with quilted side up.

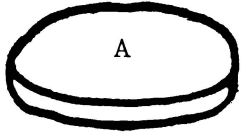
Felt - Cut circle diameter of bottom and glue on bottom to hide raw edges.

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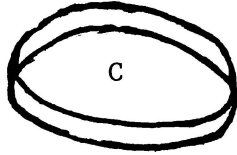

Use your upholstered box for storing your collectables - a sewing box - gift box to a friend or as a colorful accessory item. Your ideas for use:

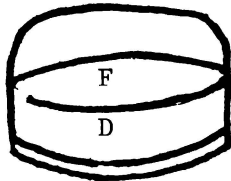

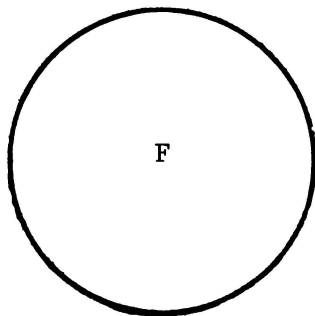
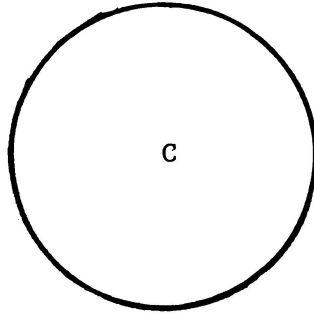
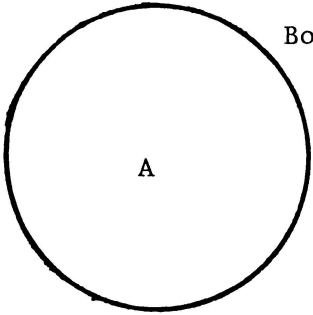
Lid - Outside
