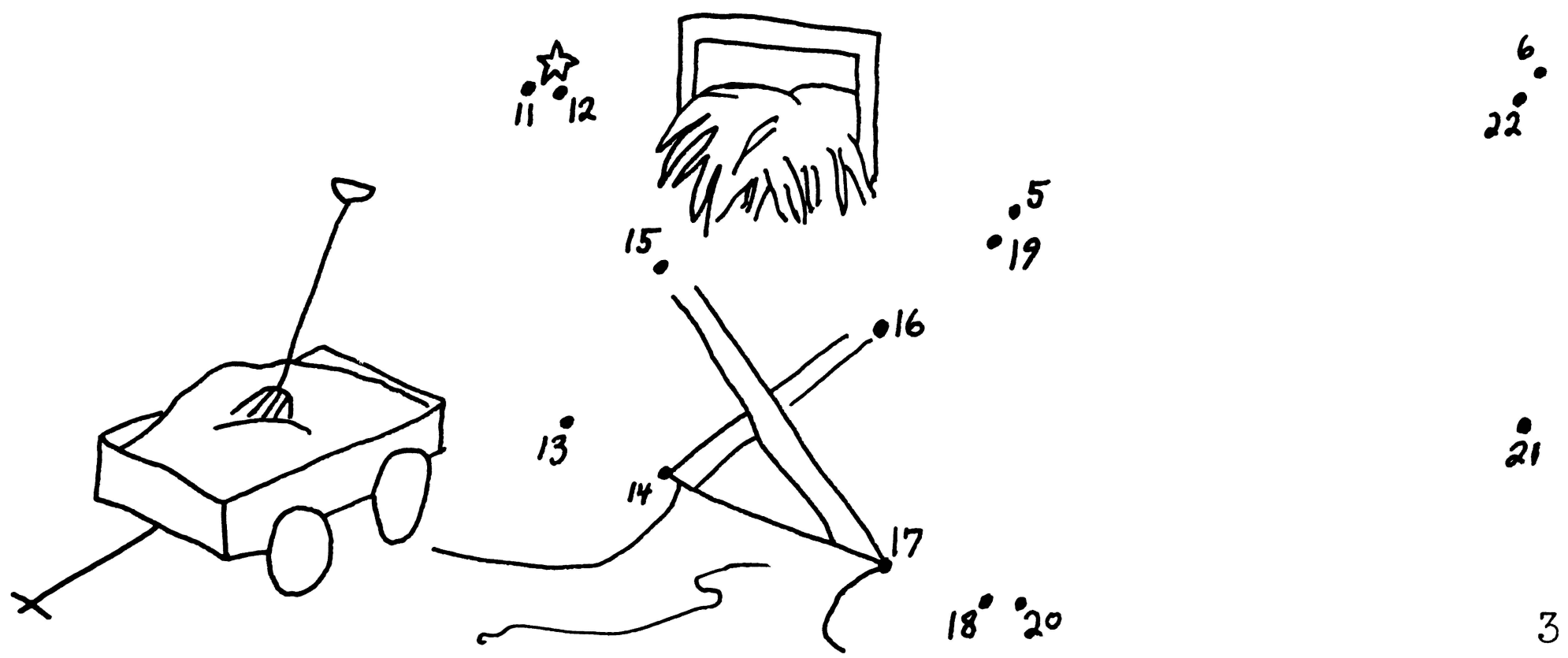
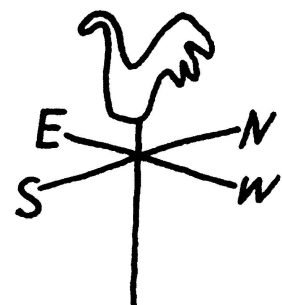


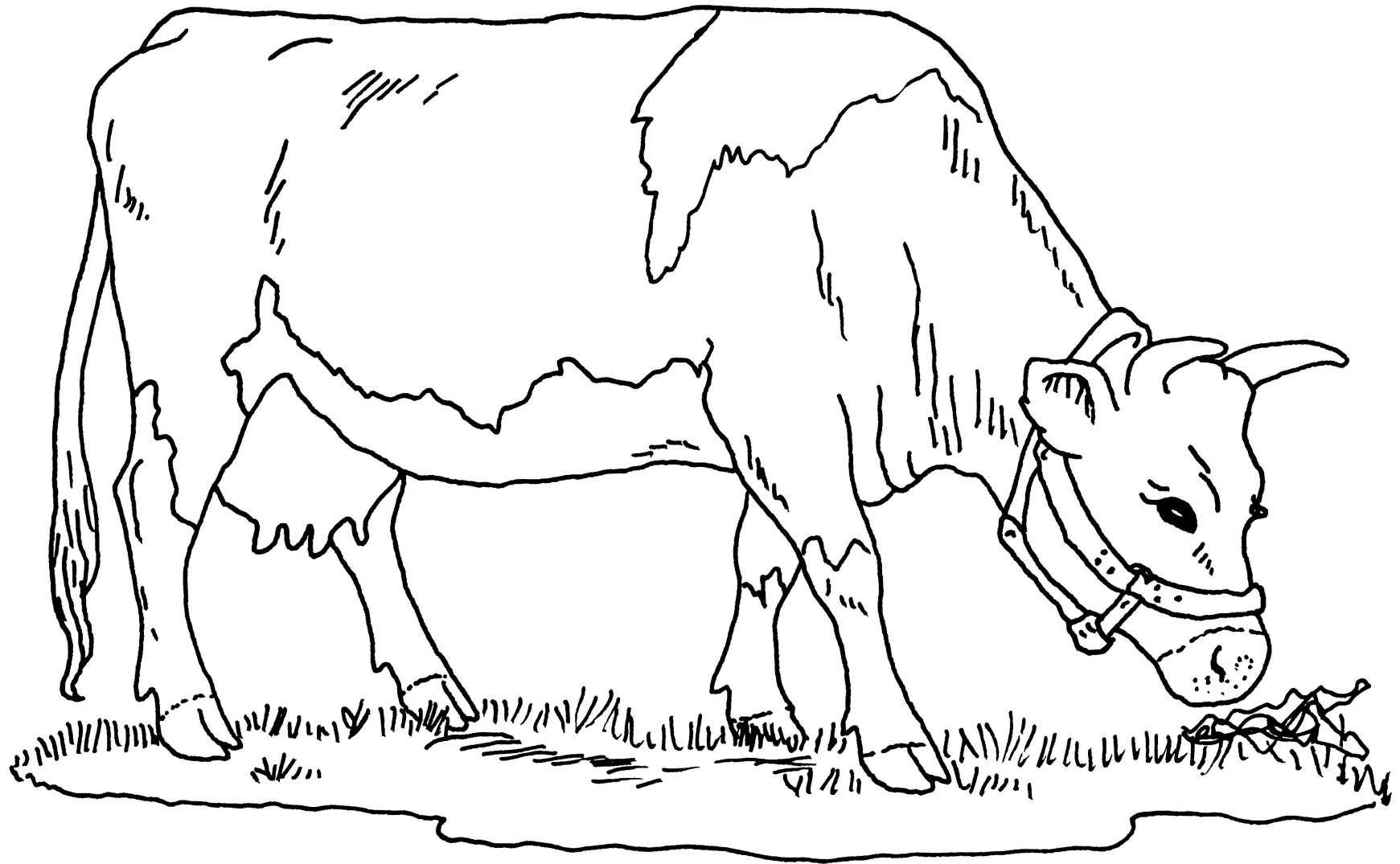
Let's go to the country and visit a dairy farm.

I am a frisky cow.

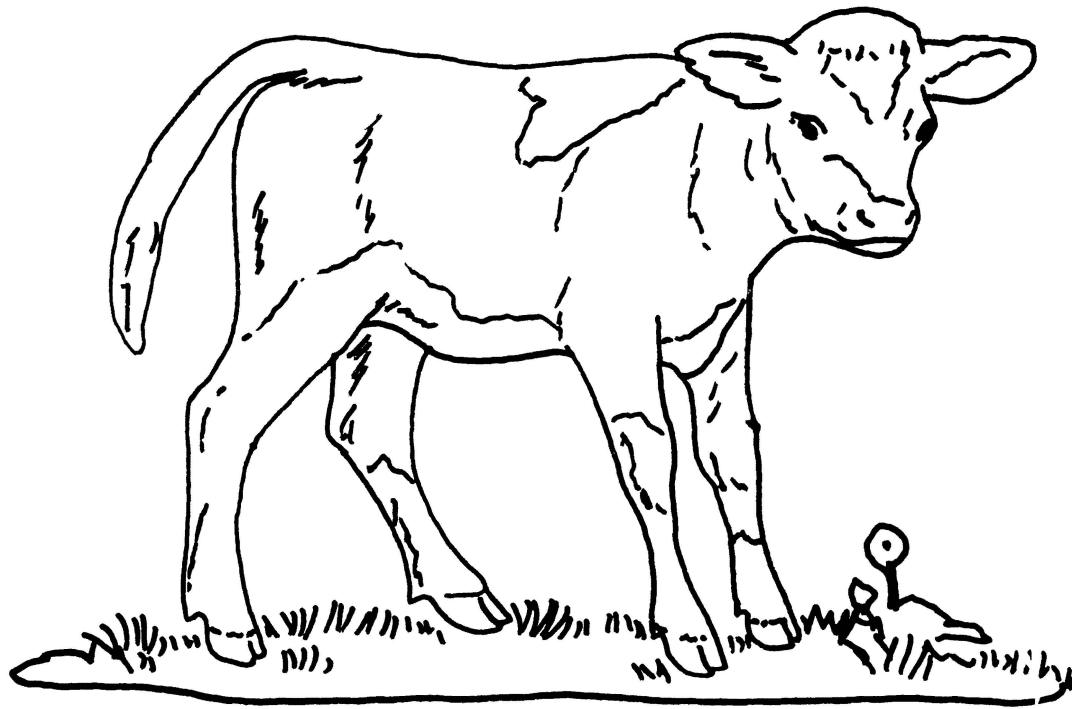


Start at the star.

2,3,4,5,....

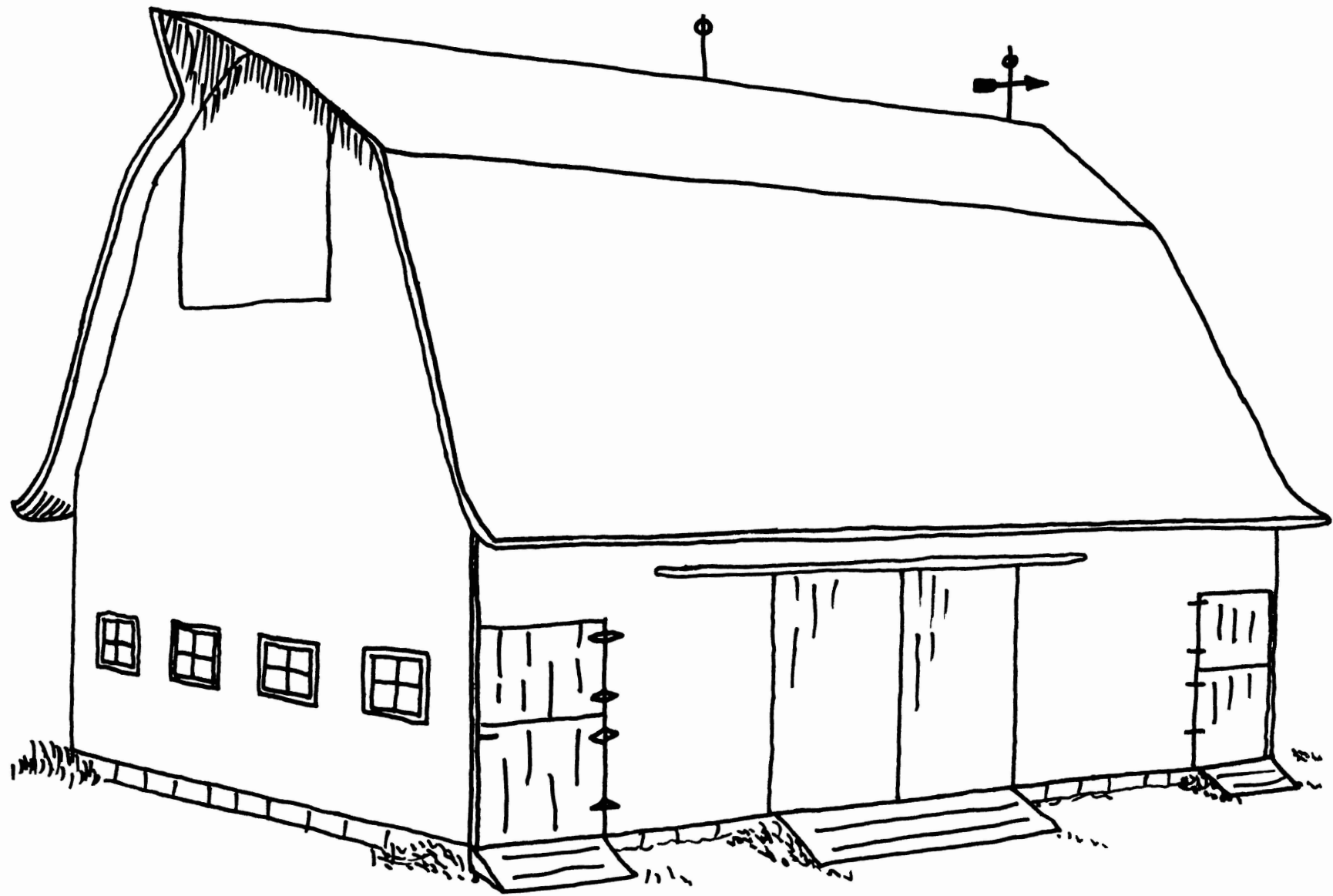




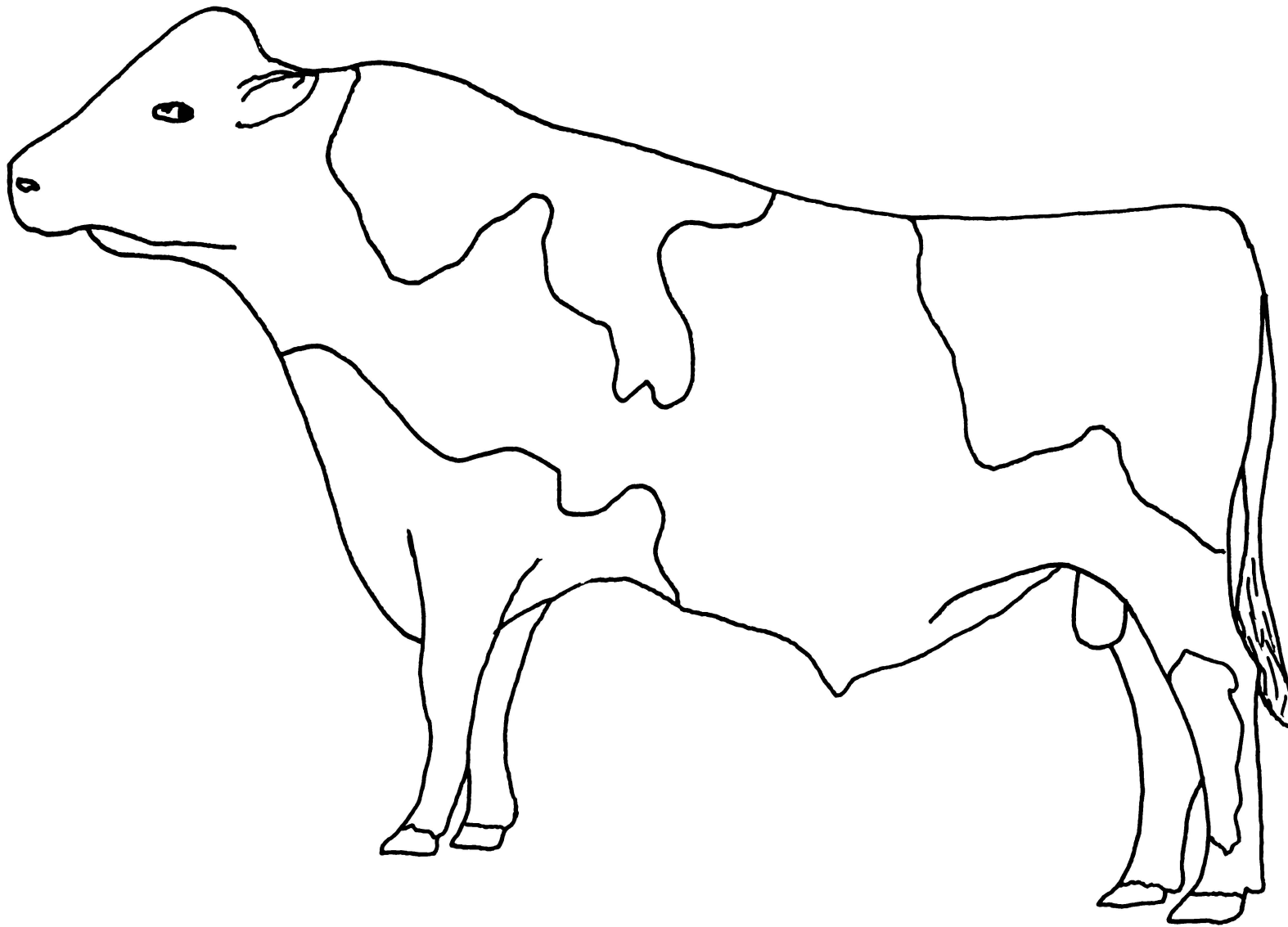
This is farmer Brown's cow. The farmer milks the cow every night and morning. The cow eats grass and hay and corn. Color the cow brown and white.



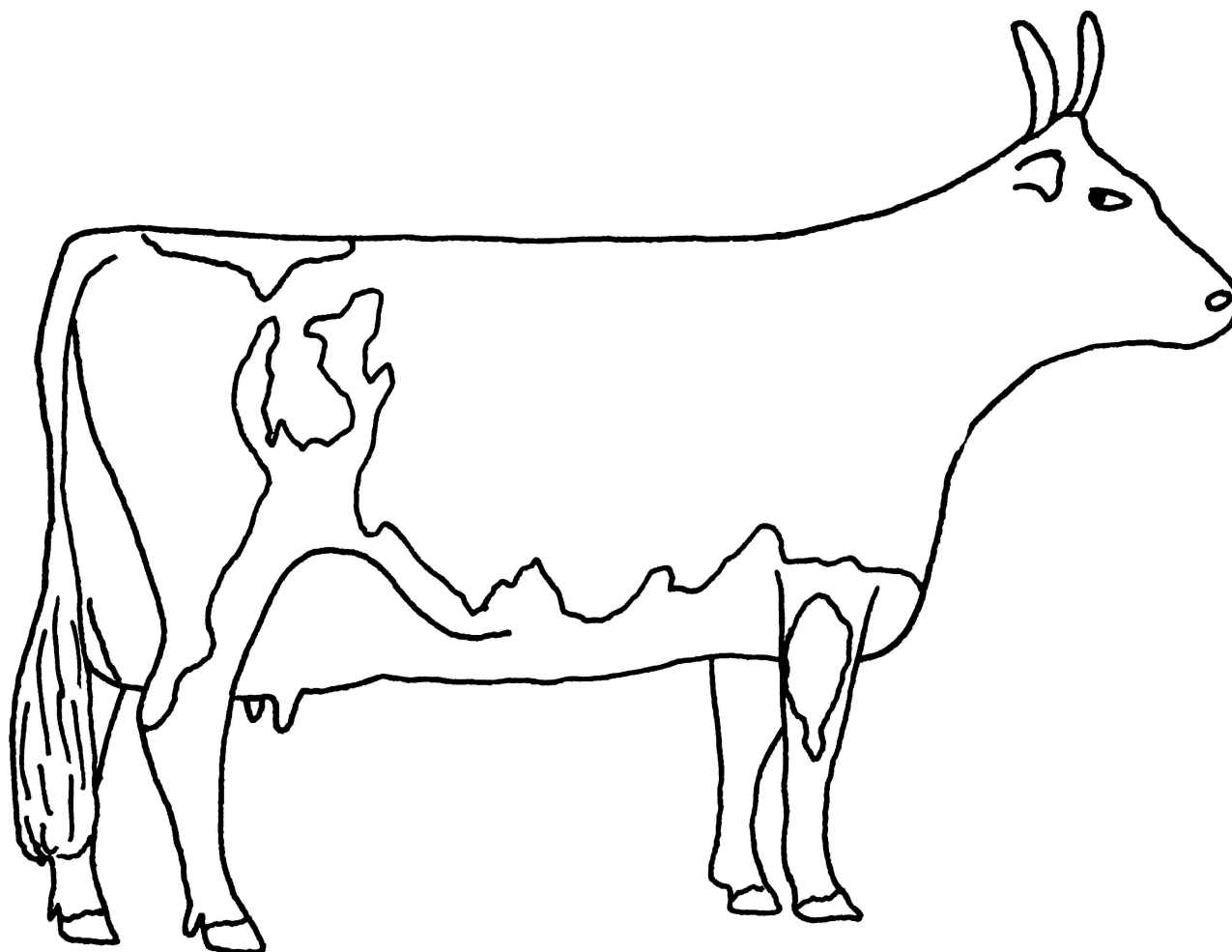

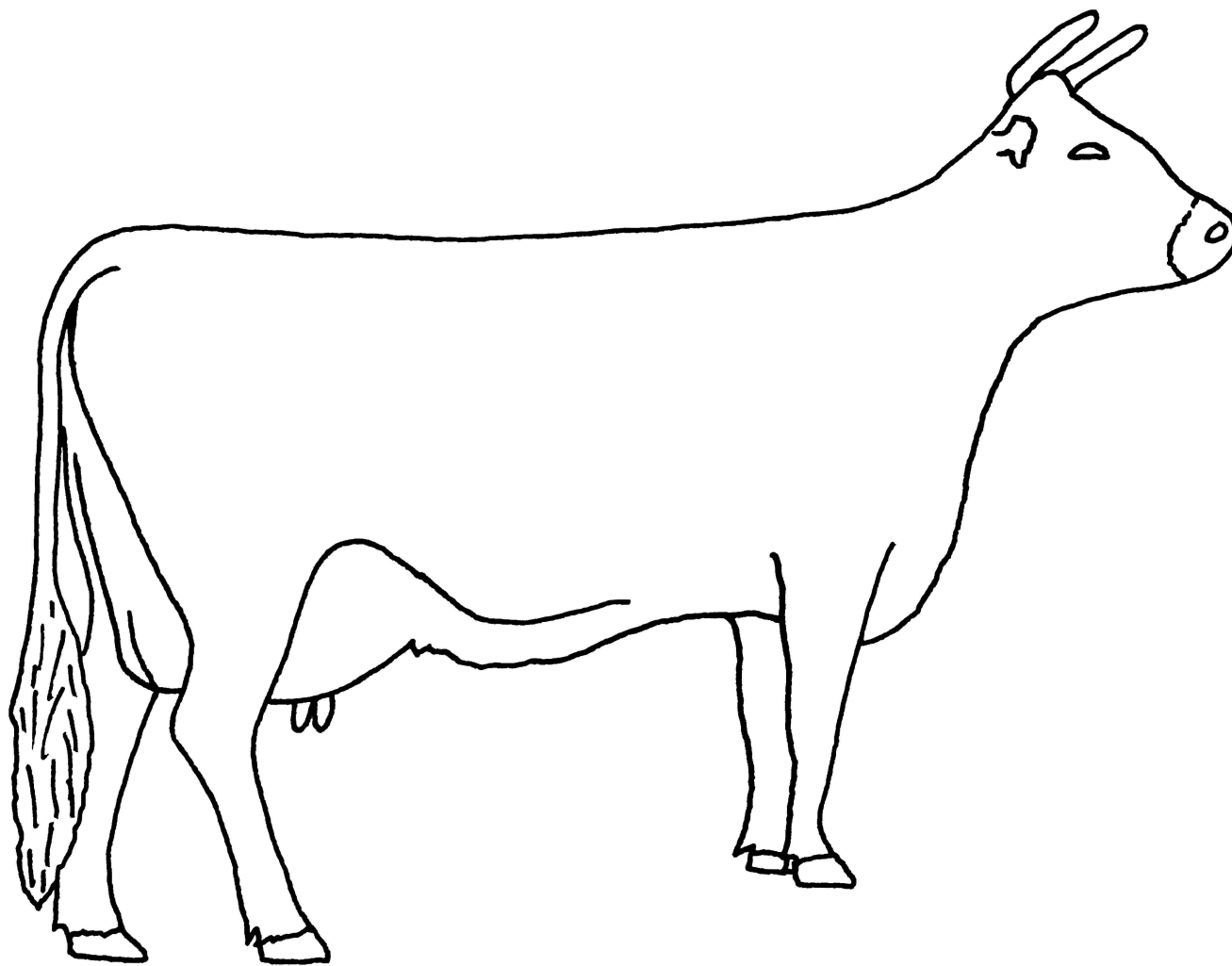
The hay is stored in the loft at the top of the barn. The cows live in the first floor.



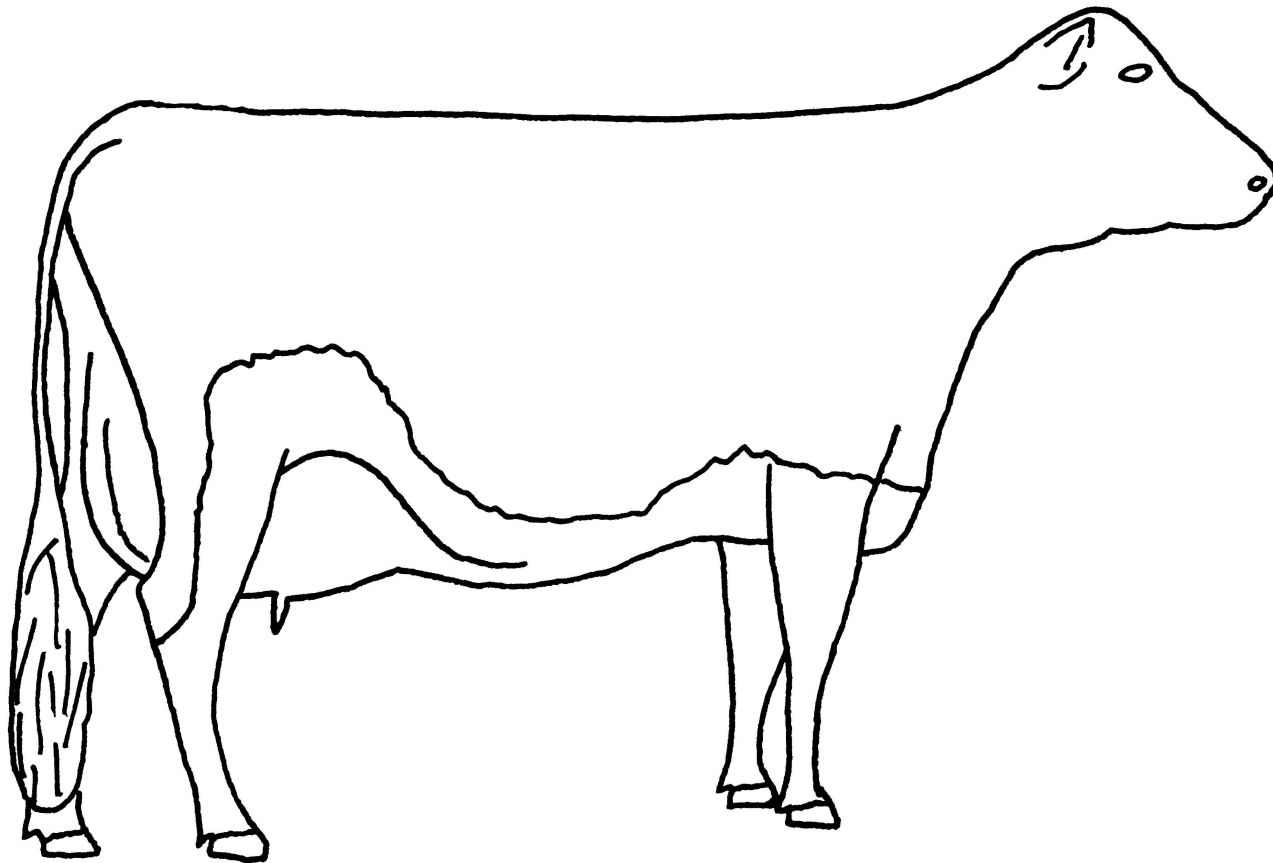
My name is Ivanhoe. I am a Holstein bull.

Color my spots black.



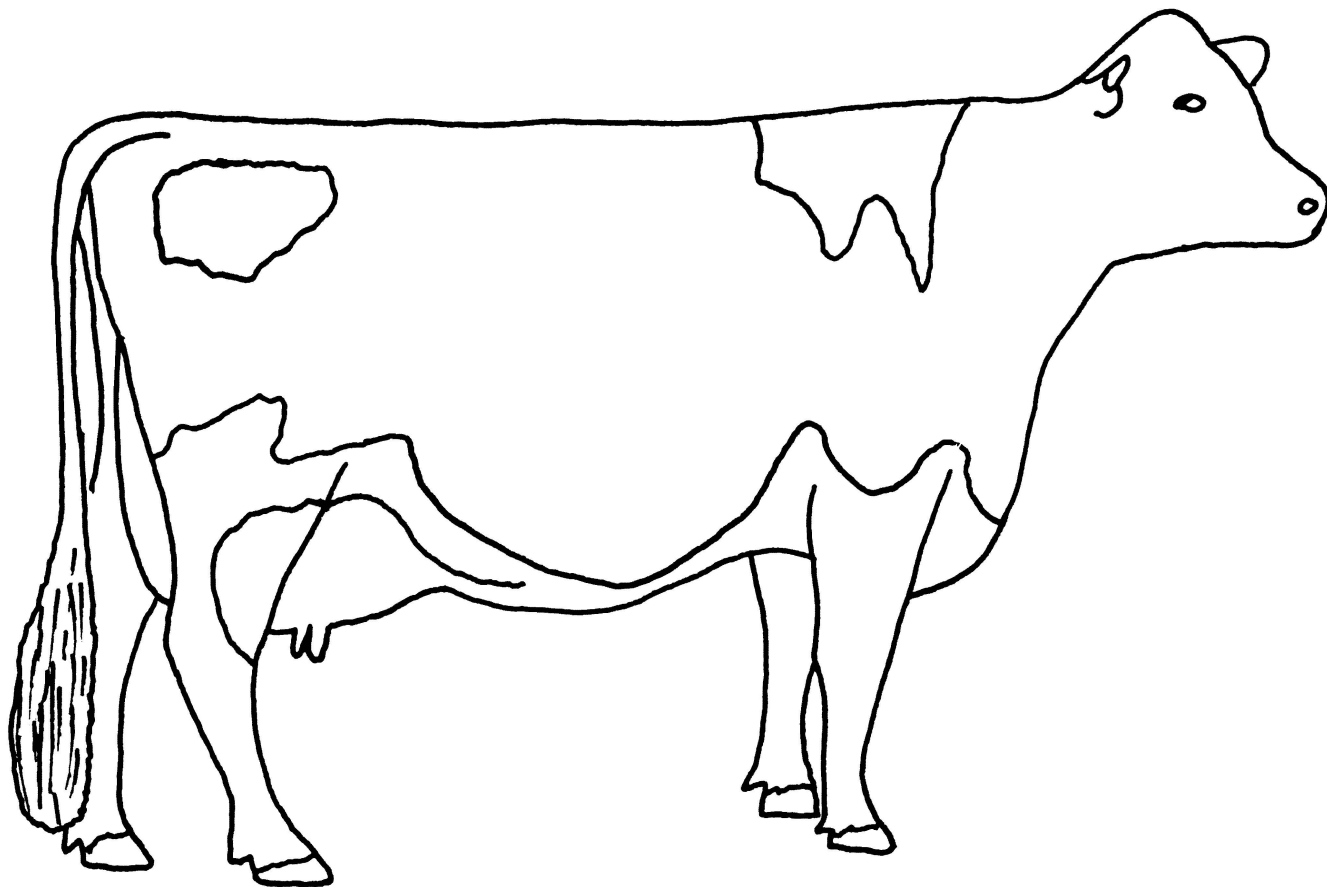
My name is Ada. I am an Ayrshire cow.
Color me red with white spots.



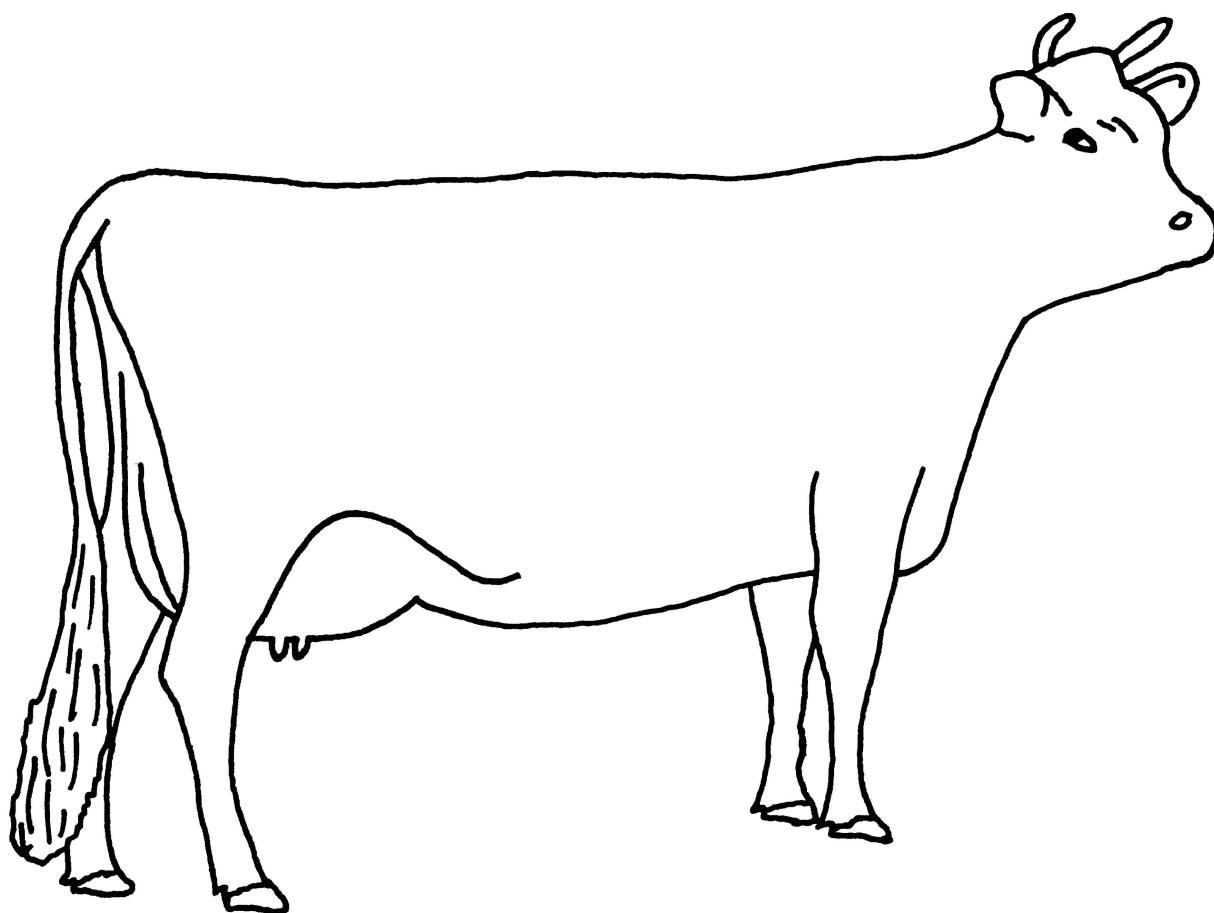
I am a Brown Swiss cow. My name is Bossie.
Color me brown. Make my feet black.



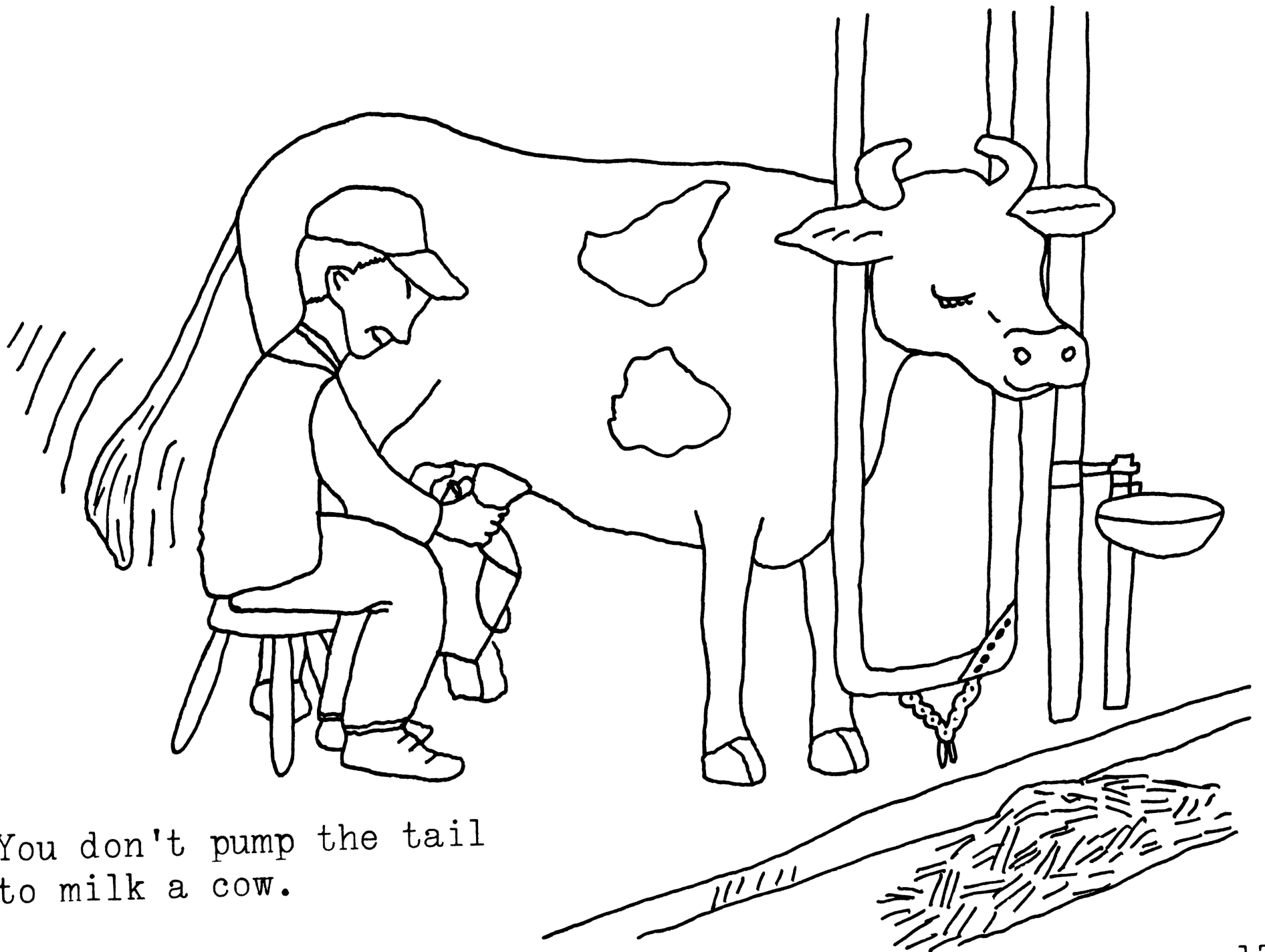
I am a Guernsey cow. My name is Gertrude.
Color me orange with white spots.



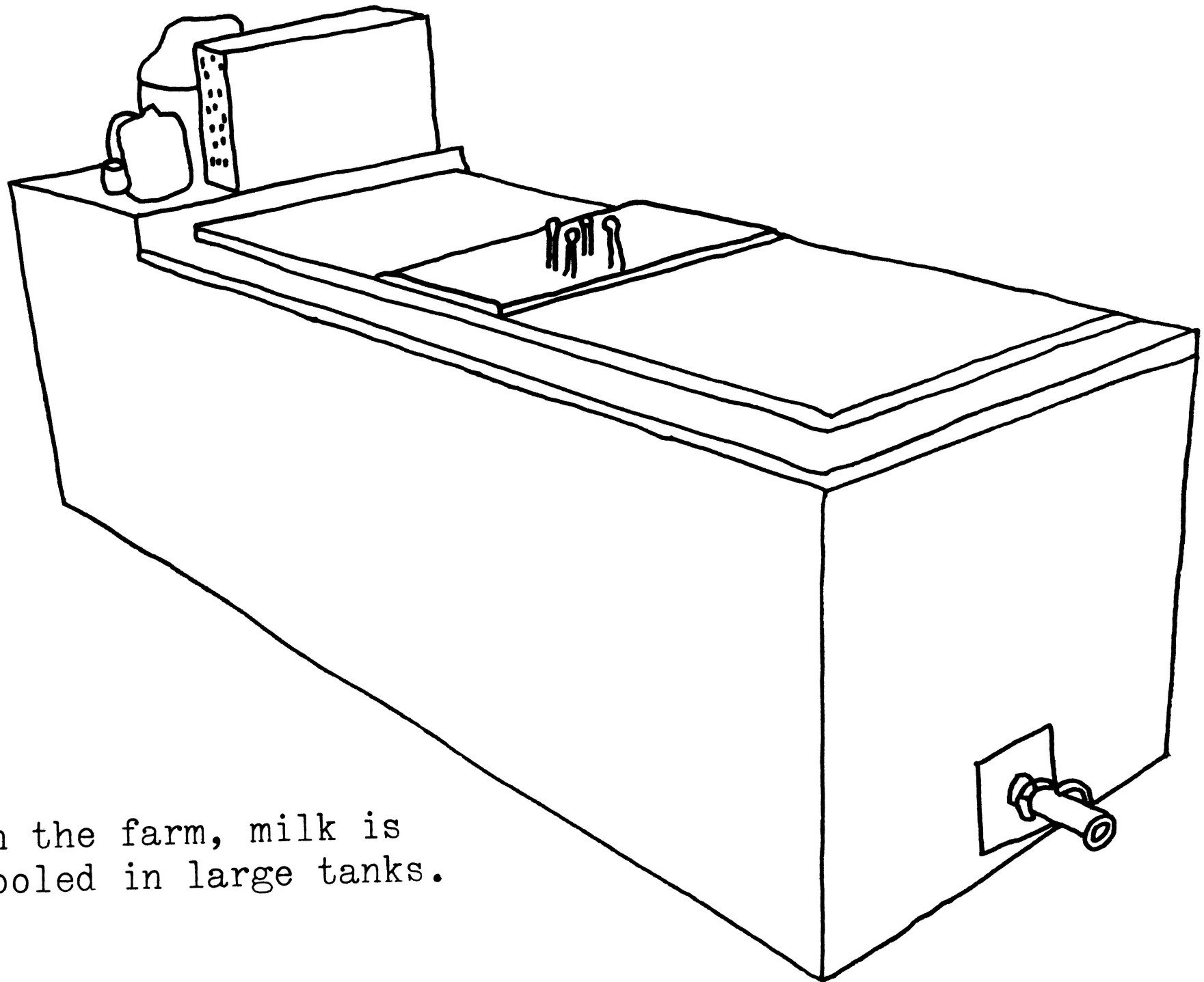
Holly is my name. I am a Holstein cow.
Color me black with white spots.



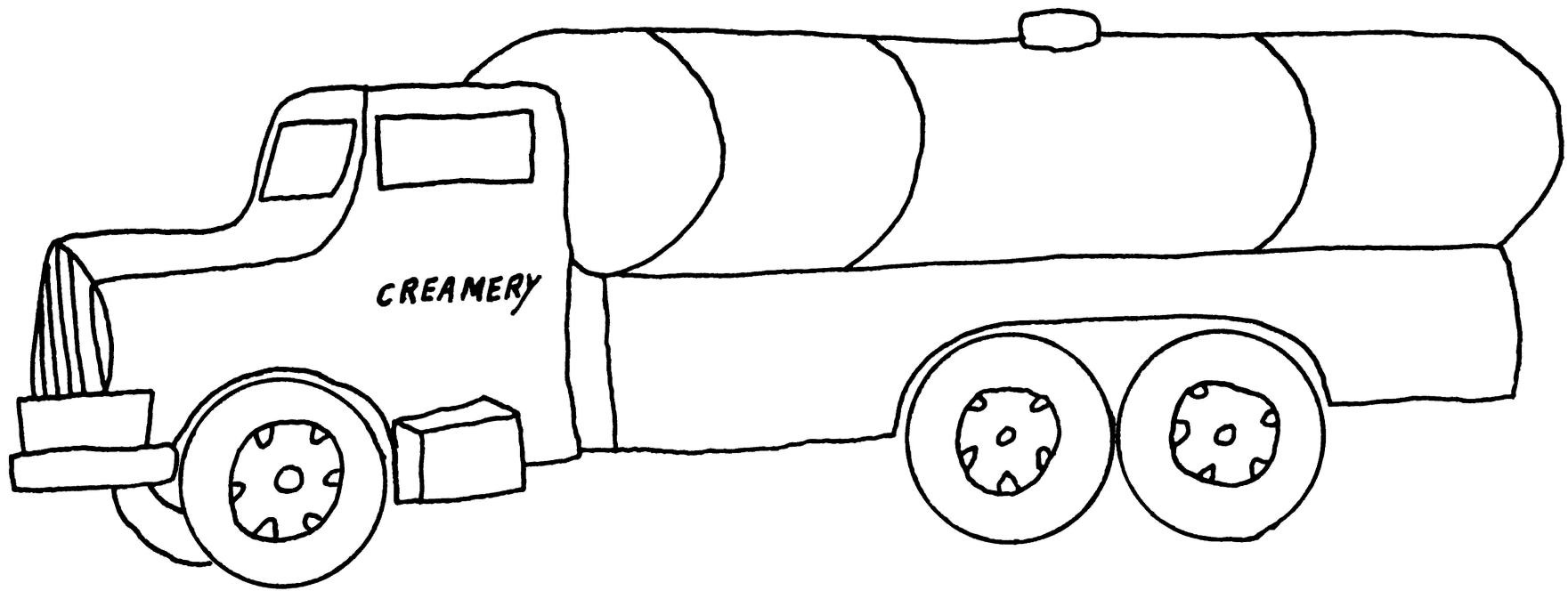
Elsie is my name. Jersey is my breed.

Color my tail and feet black.



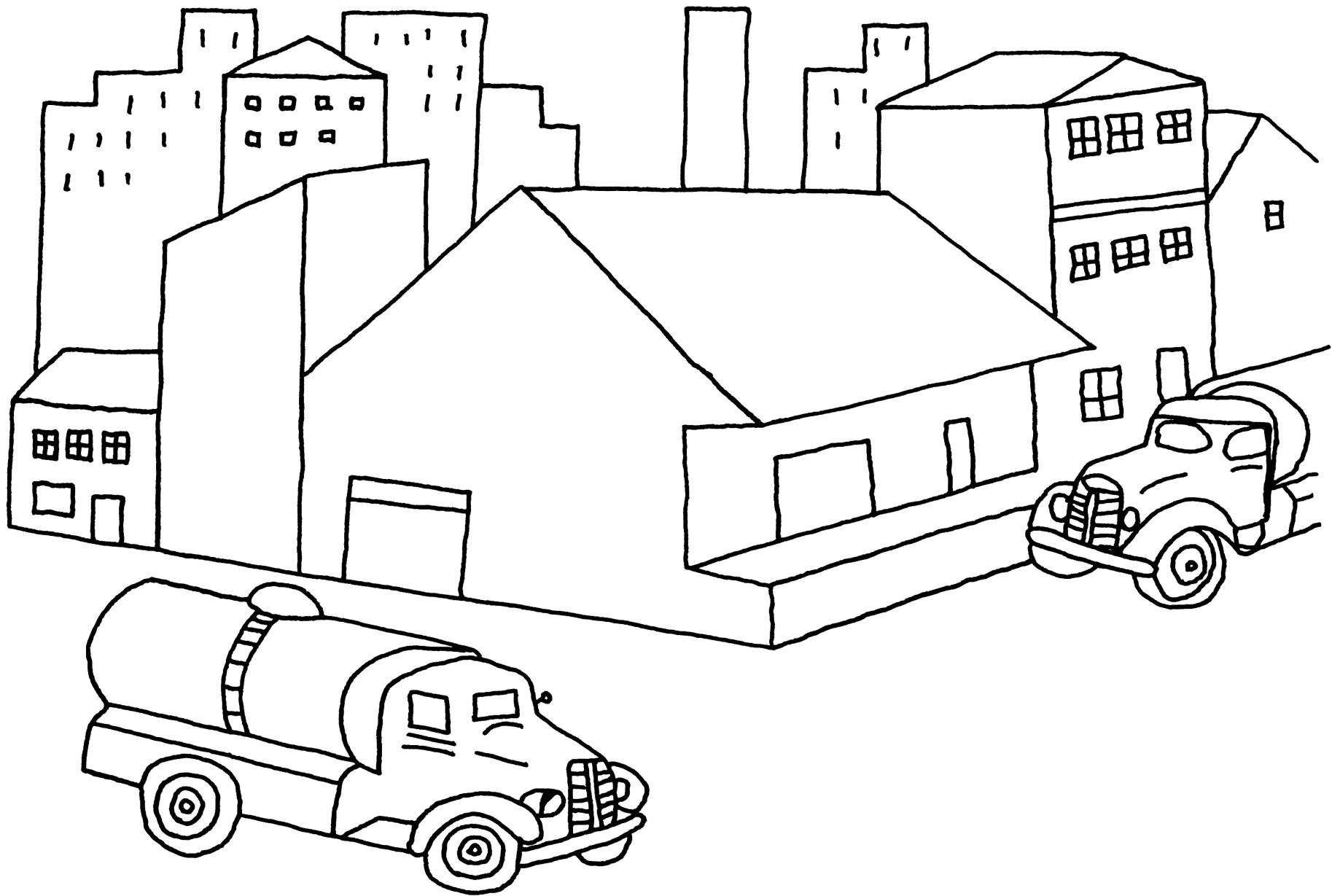
You don't pump the tail

from the farm to the milk plant.



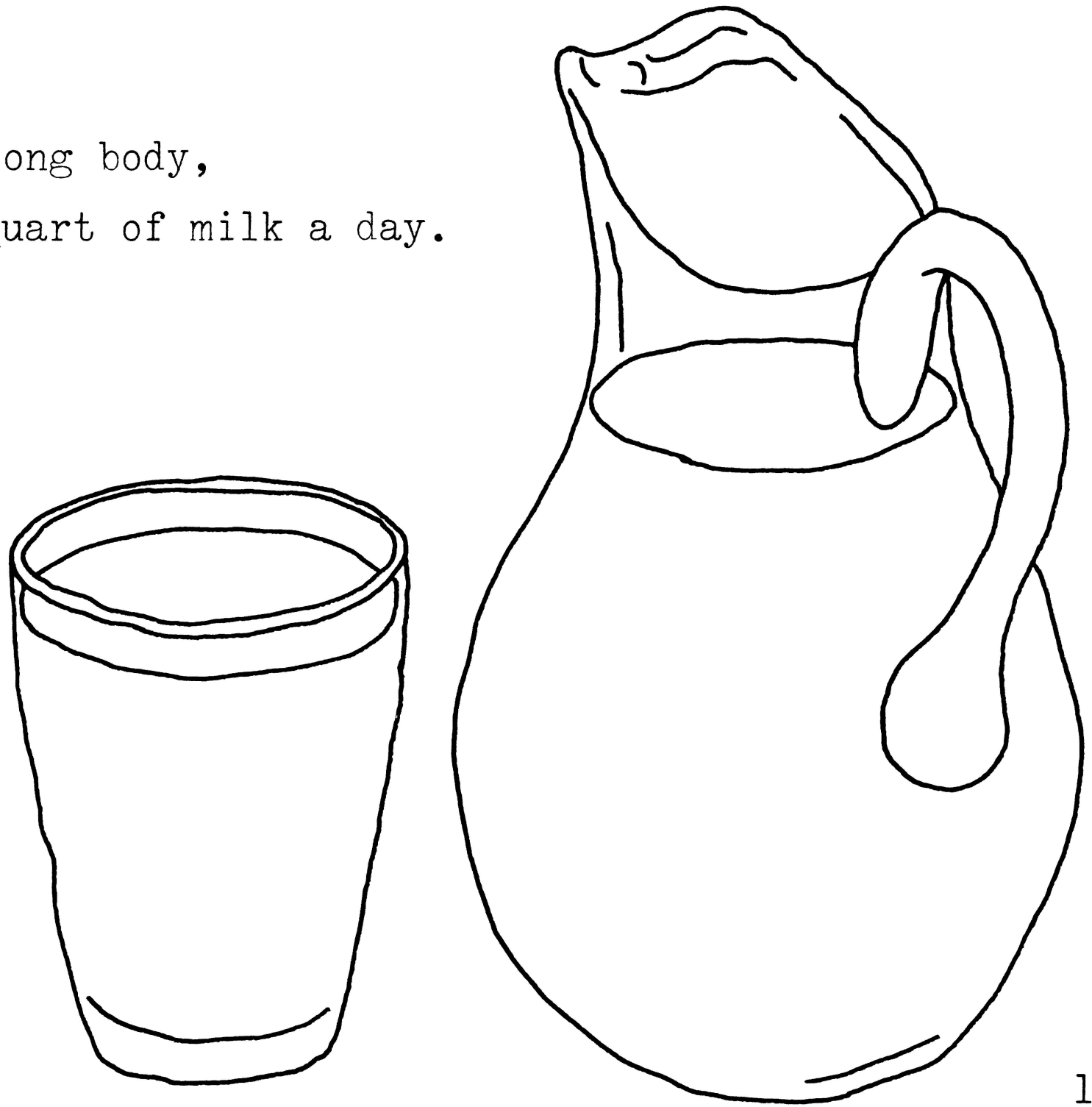
In the plant, the milk is cleaned and heated.

The dairy products (milk, ice cream, butter, cream, and cheese) are delivered daily to stores and homes.

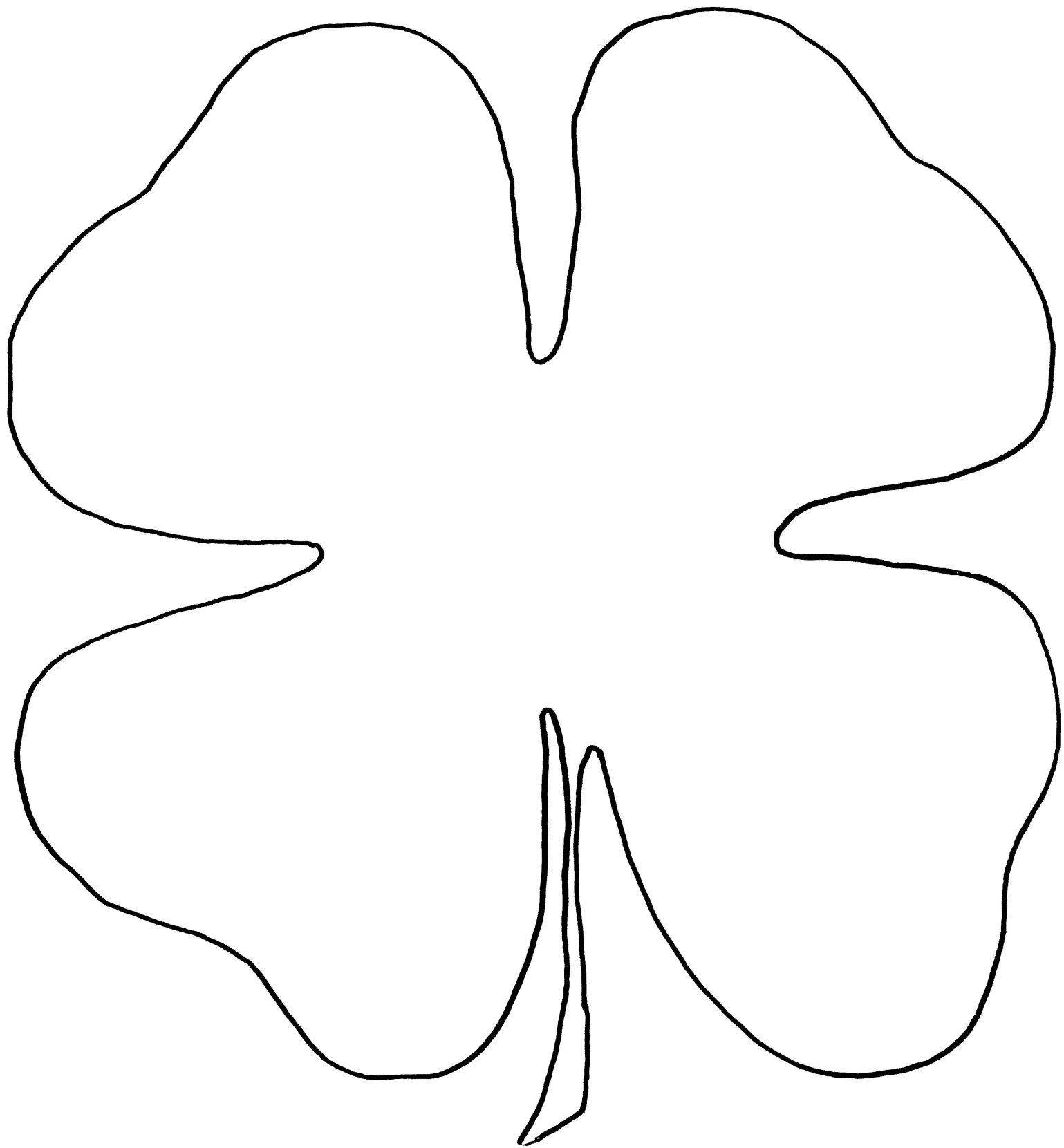


For a strong body,
