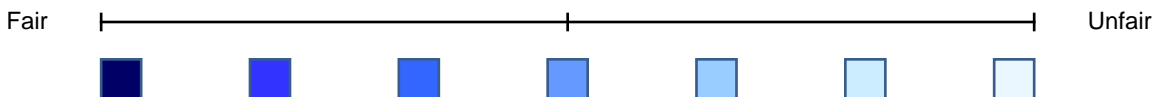
Describe the **Amount** of Your Intended Use in Relation to the Copyrighted Work as a Whole:

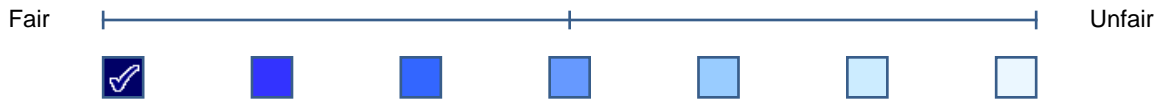
