General Policy and Disclaimer

ARC welcomes you to its website and hopes that you will find the information presented useful and informative. Information Collected

When you browse the ARC website or download files, certain information about your visit is automatically gathered and stored. This information does not identify you personally and is not readable by other servers. We gather this information to help us make our site and services more useful to you. We do not collect personally identifiable information unless you voluntarily submit it on our website.

If you send an email to ARC staff through this website, the personal information you provide will be used only to respond to your message. We will not disclose or share this personal information outside of ARC without your explicit permission.

Cookies

Unless you set your browser to block cookies, cookies will be placed onto your computer's browser when you visit our site. The date and time, the originating IP address, the object requested, and the completion status of the request are collected and saved for each request received by the server. We use a company to collect this information on our behalf. This company, Google Analytics, has its own privacy policy, terms of use, and cookie statement. In addition, we use a third-party email service provider called MailChimp to manage our email distribution lists. If you are signed up for an ARC email distribution list, MailChimp will use cookies to track whether and when you open the emails and which content you click on. What is a Cookie?

A cookie is small data file used by websites to track your Internet use. When you visit a website, the site may place a cookie on your web browser so that it can recognize your computer in the future. Cookies cannot read data from your computer's hard drive or read cookie files from other websites.

Our website uses cookies to gather summary demographic information, and remember your browser when it is used to visit our site again later. Although using persistent cookies creates a more streamlined experience for the user, our website will also work without them.

Pop-Ups

When you first enter ARC's website, you will see a pop-up that allows you to enter your name and email address, and choose the ARC email distribution list(s) you would like to join. Entering this information is voluntary. If you do not wish to provide this information, click on the top right corner of the pop-up to close it.

MailChimp, a third-party email service provider, manages ARC's email distribution lists. Links to MailChimp's policies are provided under "Cookies," above.

Deleting or Blocking Cookies

If you do not wish a cookie to be placed on your computer, you may set your browser to block cookies. Web browsers enable you to set your cookie preferences before you start browsing.

If you already enabled a cookie, you may delete the cookie by emptying your cache or deleting them from your browser folder. You can clear your browser to completely remove all browsing data from your hard drive. If you have more than one browser, be sure to delete browsing data from each browser to remove all data from your computer.

The cookies that ARC installs via its home page pop-up will expire after one year.

Social Media

ARC manages a presence on social media sites such as YouTube, Twitter, and Facebook. We do not collect any personally identifiable information through these sites. Each social media platform has its own privacy, security, and accessibility policies. We encourage you to read these policies before engaging in
