

A Look at Bachelors Degrees Awarded by Program Area and Region


Are there different trends in the number of degrees awarded by program area across the U.S.? To answer this question we used a function in the FAEIS Report Builder that allows you to select institutions by state. For comparison purposes, we created 4 regions as indicated in the map below.



Using the FAEIS database for degrees awarded, we created tables that included all institutions that reported bachelors degree data for all three of these academic years, 2006-'07, 2007-'08, 2008-'09 in each of the FAEIS program areas. Those areas are [Agriculture, Agriculture Operations, and Related Sciences](#), [Family and Consumer Sciences/Human Sciences](#), and [Natural Resources and Conservation](#).



Bachelors Degrees Awarded in Agriculture, Agriculture Operations, and Related Sciences by Region




