Minutes of the January 14, 1982 Meeting

The Commission on Student Affairs met on Thursday, January 14, 1982 at 4:00 p.m. in Room 344, Squires Student Center.

Members Present: Dr. S. M. Sullivan, Chairperson, Mr. D. Anderson, Mr. D. Banick, Ms. K. Bollard, Mr. G. Brainerd, Mr. W. J. Butke, Ms. L. DeVito, Mr. G. Franks, Mr. J. Graham, Mr. G. The following actions were taken:

Approval of Agenda and Minutes

1. The agenda was approved with the addition of the distribution of the report from the Ad Hoc Committee on Student Grievances as an item under "New Business."
2. The minutes of the December 10, 1981 meeting were approved as written.

Announcements

3. Dr. Sullivan announced that the approved and registered events from December 8, 1981 to February 11, 1982 were included with the Commission agenda. General Lane questioned whether the demonstration by The Peace Group, as advertised in the newspaper, had been approved by the University. Dr. Sullivan responded that she would look into this matter.

New Business

4. The minutes of the December 11, 1982 meeting of the Student Publications Board were approved as distributed. Ms. DeVito reported that the Student Publications Board will be conducting a study on the honoraria paid to certain officers of student publications. She was asked to report back the findings of this study to Commission.
5. The minutes of the December 1, 1981 meeting of the Student Constitutional Affairs Board were approved as distributed.
6. General Lane distributed the Report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Student Grievances to Commission. The contents of this report will be discussed at the CSA Meeting on January 28, 1982.

Old Business

7. Dr. Sullivan announced that Ms. Jane I. Brandt, University Legal Counsel, was unable to be present at the Commission meeting. Dr. Sullivan requested that Commission members forward to her questions they wished to have addressed by Ms. Brandt and that she would send these questions to Ms. Brandt for a response.

Dr. Sullivan introduced Mr. Steven M. Janosik, Associate Director of University Housing Services. Mr. Janosik distributed to Commission a draft of the results of the Lifestyle Survey conducted during the Fall Quarter, 1981. Mr. Janosik commented that the results of the survey show that there is support from the student body for more liberal residence hall lifestyles and visitation. Mr. Banick requested that Commission receive the final report of the Lifestyle Survey.

Mr. Janosik also distributed to the Commission the University Housing Policy Statement for the proposed revisions to University Policies for Student Life, 1982-83 and the University Housing Services administrative policy statement on visitation for publication in the Student Handbook. The Commission approved a motion to endorse the visitation policy as presented by the University Housing Services.

Dr. Sullivan introduced Dr. D. David Ostroth, Acting Director of Student Development Services. Dr. Ostroth distributed to Commission the revision of the solicitation policy to be substituted for pages 5-8 in the proposed revisions to UPSL, 1982-83.

Dr. Ostroth also distributed copies of the policy resolution on campus disturbances and a copy of a memorandum from President Lavery designating University officials authorized to enforce the policy.

Dr. Ostroth reported that the Office of Student Development Services had reviewed Sections 5, 6, and 7 of the proposed revisions to UPSL, 1982-83 and that only editorial changes will be made to these sections.

Dr. Ostroth was asked by the chair to distribute a second draft of the proposed revisions to UPSL, 1982-83 to Commission at the February 11, 1982 meeting.
