MINUTES

COMMISSION ON UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES

October 25, 1982 - 3:00 p.m.  
Board Room - Burruss Hall

PRESENT: Dr. Wilson, Chairman; Dr. Hall, Secretary; Dr. A. G. 1. The meeting was called to order by Dr. Wilson. He announced, first of all, that for the remainder of the quarter at least the Commission would need to change its meeting place from Burruss Board Room to the Library Board Room on the sixth floor of the new wing. He also reported to the Commission on recent actions within the University Council. Most especially, he called attention to three CUS Resolutions approved at the University Council just past. They were Resolution F (for changing catalog disclaimer statement), Resolution G (pertaining to internal transfers), and Resolution I (on guidelines for degree requirement changes). Effective dates on the latter two resolutions were changed from September 1982 to September 1983.

Substantive discussion of the resolution was postponed for the next meeting.
