



# JetBlue Plans to Speed Up Transition to Sustainable Aviation Fuel

JetBlue Airways Corp. said it plans to speed up its transition to sustainable aviation fuel with an offtake agreement with bioenergy developer SG Preston.

Targeting a start in 2023 and continuing over a 10-year period, SG Preston will deliver at least 670 million gallons of blended SAF to JetBlue to fuel its flight operations at John F. Kennedy International Airport, LaGuardia Airport and Newark Liberty International Airport.

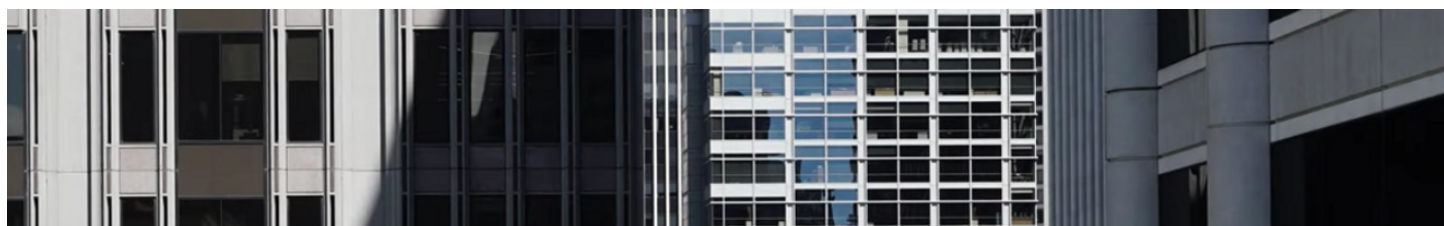
JetBlue said it will convert 30% of its fuel buy across JFK, LaGuardia and Newark Liberty from traditional Jet-A fuel to SAF.

Sustainable aviation fuel is jet fuel produced from biological resources that can be replenished rapidly and without impacting food supply, the airline said. Compared to traditional petroleum-based Jet-A fuel, renewable options can significantly reduce both greenhouse gas emissions and other air pollutants such as particulate matter and sulfur oxides, JetBlue said.

With the addition of this SG Preston agreement to its previous SAF commitments, JetBlue said it is ahead of pace on its target to convert 10% of its total fuel usage to SAF on a blended basis by 2030.

JetBlue is doubling its previous SAF commitment with SG Preston, which was first unveiled in 2016.
