1. Call to Order and Announcement: Dr. Ford (chairing the meeting for Dr. Roselle) called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm. It was announced that the next meeting will be held June 8 at 3:00 pm in the Burruss Hall Board Room. (NOTE: Change is to 6th floor Library). A memorandum was distributed to the membership explaining the procedure for receiving graduation checklists in the offices of the Registrar and Provost.
2. The Agenda was approved as distributed.
3. The Minutes of the meeting of April 27, 1987, were corrected as follows: four years rather than one year approval should be noted for Laboratory Experiments in Organic Chemistry, M. Hudlicky and IBM-PC Microcomputer Interfacing, Scientific Instrument Automation, David E. Larsen and Paul E. Field. The minutes were approved as corrected.
4. The Course Criteria Committee report was approved as distributed. The changes restrict enrollment in mathematics courses for majors based upon performance and enrollment in language courses based upon previous high school course work. Detailed reports are on file in the Office of the Provost. Effective date is Fall, 1988.
