- Recenters to section based on user input

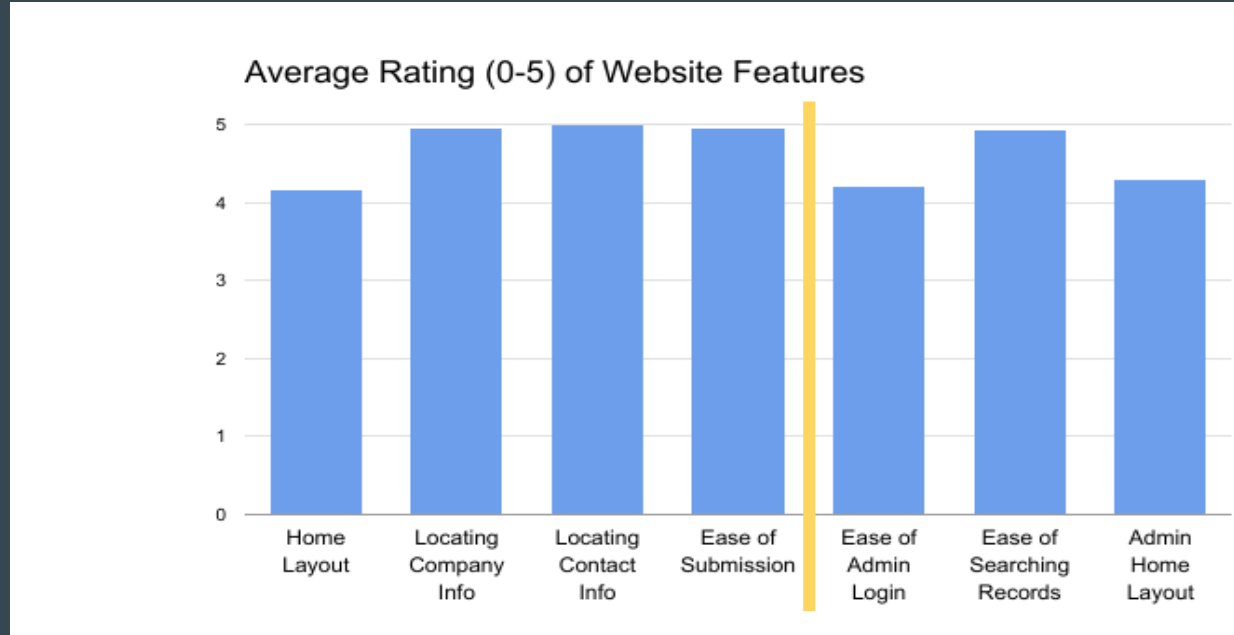
Website Functionality (back-end)
