Approval of Agenda and Minutes

1. The agenda was approved as written.
2. The minutes of the Thursday, November 21, 1985 meeting were approved with the addition at the request of Jeff Mitchell that the RHF resolution pertaining to the Office of Housing and Residence Life be attached to the Tuesday, December 10, 1985 minutes.

New Business

3. Dr. Edward F. D. Spencer distributed the letter written to Mr. Jeff Mitchell in response to the resolutions passed by the Residence Hall Federation, the Student Government Association, and the Commission on Student Affairs. Dr. Spencer explained that the overwhelming response from students in favor of 24 hour visitation is important in considering the changes to be made in Fall of 1986. Students expressed concern pertaining to the delayed timing of implementing the change. Dr. Spencer explained that timing is important to provide for the minority of students who are not in favor of 24 hour visitation and to honor the current Housing Contract signed by the students with the university.

4. The Minutes of the November 6, 1985 Student Media Board were approved with the change introduced by Ms. Miller that Item D, page 3 should read: "Mary-Margret Koball noted that she has not received the assessment from the Bugle; the Collegiate Times has been received." Ms. Miller reported that the QC is confident that they will publish.
5. Mr. Mitchell requested that the Chair of the I.D. Committee be invited to address the Commission.
6. The meeting was adjourned at 4:40 p.m.
