Annual flower trials have been conducted at the V.P.I. Trial Gardens maintained by the Department of Horticulture on the Virginia Polytechnic Institute campus at Blacksburg since the summer of 1961. These trials are of considerable value in maintaining and improving the quality of varieties available to the gardening public. Characteristics such as habit and uniformity of growth, trueness and uniformity of color, flower productivity, and general garden value are considered. Donors of seed each year check the performances of their own and other samples. Bedding plant producers, florists, garden center operators, nurserymen, and home gardeners visit the gardens to select varieties to grow the following year.

This publication contains reports for both 1967 and 1968 trials. The report for 1968 starts on page 19. Suggested annual flowers for 1969 are listed on pages 20-22.

#### 1967 ANNUAL FLOWER VARIETAL TRIALS

The 1967 annual flower varietal trials and the evaluation of flower entries for the All-America Selections were conducted at the V.P.I. Trial Gardens, Virginia Polytechnic Institute, Blacksburg.

All seeds were sown the last week of March. The small seeded varieties were sown in metal flats containing a commercially prepared medium known as "Jiffy-Mix." The large seeded varieties were sown directly in 2 1/4" peat pots containing a steam-sterilized medium of equal parts of loam soil and peat moss.

After the seeds were sown, the containers were placed in a greenhouse at 70° F. under a low pressure, intermittent mist system, set to mist for intervals of 8 seconds per minute from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. As the seeds germinated, the containers were removed to a 60° F. greenhouse. Seedlings of the small seeded varieties were transplanted to 2 1/4" peat pots, containing equal parts soil and peat moss, after they developed the second set of true leaves. Seedlings of the large seeded varieties were roughed to allow only one plant per peat pot.

Starting on May 22, 1967, the plants were transplanted to outside beds previously fumigated with methyl bromide at the rate of 1 lb. per 100 sq. ft. to control weeds, diseases, insects, and nematodes. The plot for each variety was 6' x 4 1/2', with 15 plants spaced at 1 1/2' intervals. The beds were irrigated as needed during the growing season.

Preliminary evaluations were made during the growing season, with final measurements recorded the first 2 weeks of August. This period was considered optimum in regard to growth responses and esthetic charcteristics for most varieties. The varieties were evaluated objectively by height and width, and by a rating system. Width and height measurements in the tables represent averages in inches. In some instances where the plants had grown together forming thick mats or carpets, the width was recorded as "massed".

The rating system was based on 1 to 5, with 1 a very poor rating, and 5 excellent. Floriferous rating included flower, color, size, number, and uniformity. "N/A" means not applicable, with respect to plants grown for their attractive foliage, not flowers. Growth habit included growth characteristics such as branching habits, disease resistance, and uniformity of each plant size with in a given varietal plot, since there was considerable variation in some varieties.

The overall rating was given in an attempt to combine all factors of floriferous and other growth characteristics into one evaluation. In all instances, the varieties evaluated in the garden were compared with similar varieties and types. Therefore, there may be other varieties not present here that would be better types than those represented. Frequent rainfall helped prevent many of the annuals from producing growth and flowers as good as in previous seasons. Seed sources are identified on page 18.

The following varieties were outstanding in growth for 1967.

- AGERATUM. Blue Beauty, Blue Chip, Blue Danube and Blue Fox all had uniform growth and flowering habit.
- ALYSSUM. Carpet of Snow produced continuous bloom throughout the summer until frost.
- ASTER. Super Sinensis, Giant Mixed was the best of all the asters. It did not suffer as severely from aster wilt or yellows as the other varieties.
- BALSAM. Camellia Flowered Double and Color Parade provided large quanities of flowers and had the best compact growth.

- BEGONIA. Plants were grown in full sun. Merville Rouge, Red Trionphe and Red Triumph provided high flower production with uniform growth.
- CELOSIA. Forest Fire Improved, Plumosa Golden Triumph, Sunburst Gold, and Golden Gem were outstanding, with Pampas Plume, Sunburst Red, and Orange Feather producing excellent flowers and growth.
- CHRYSANTHEMUM. Eastern Star Improved provided an abundance of flowers and was most attractive in mid-summer.
- CLEOME. There was very vigorous growth in Helen Campbell, and in Rose Queen, which has attractive pink flowers.

CINERARIA. Condidissima had attractive foliage and compact habit of growth. COLEUS. Flaming Foliage, Select Mixture, and Salmon Flame were outstanding

in their foliage coloration and were vigorous growers.

- COSMOS. Her Majesty and Sunset bloomed continously throughout the summer and had attractive foliage.
- DAHLIA. Coltness Hybrids Mixture and Double Bedding Mixed were compact growers with small flowers over a long blooming period.
- DIANTHUS. Double Mixed and Single Charms had attractive flowers, and bloomed throughout the summer.
- DIGITALIS. Foxy is the first biennial to bloom the first season. It had most attractive flowers.
- GERANIUM. Several geraniums grown from seed flowered true to color and had good compact growth. Varieties formerly grown under a number designation are now available as Carefree Bright Pink, Carefree Scarlet, Carefree Deep Salmon, and Carefree White.
- IMPATIENS. Sixteen varieties were grown under full sun. A Go-Go, Dwarf Orange, Pink and Rose, Imp Hybrids Formula Blend, Red Herald, Shade

Glow Series, Orange, and Red had dwarf growth with many flowers. MARIGOLD. Of the 21 varieties grown, these appeared to be superior;

- Dwarf Sparky, First Lady Marigold, Gold Coins Mixed, Golden Treasure, Golden Jubilee, King Tut, Orange Jubilee, Spanish Brocade, Sparkler, and the Tiger.
- PANSY. Butterfly Hybrids, Giant Majestic Mixed , Masquerade, Super Giant Yellow with Eye, and Westland Giants, were of vigorous growth and produced flowers throughout the summer.
- PETUNIA. The F. Grandiflora petunias have larger, somewhat more attractive blooms, usually ruffled or fringed. The outstanding F. Grandifloras were Bright Red, Grand Prix, King of Diamonds, Maytime, Peach Blossom, Pink, and Spring Song Improved.

The F. Multiflora petunias have smaller but earlier flowers and are profuse bloomers all season, especially during the hottest part of the summer. Excellent F. Multifloras were Blue Ribbon, Brass Band, Coral Salmon, Cover Girl, Festival, Pink Satin, Plum Blue, Plum Pink, Plum Pudding, Plum Purple, Polar Cap, Popeye, Purple Plum, Snowdrift, Starfire, Victory, White Avalanche, and White Harmony.

The F. Multiflora Doubles are more vigorous, more rain-and-windproof, and better suited for bedding purposes than the other largeflowered kinds. The outstanding double multifloras were Blue Jay, Cardinal, Cherry Tart, Honey Bunch, Lavender Delight, Pink Delight, Pink Riches, Red and White Delight, and White Delight.

PHLOX. Cecily Mixtures Globe Scarlet Ball and Twinkles of Red and Salmon Shades bloomed profusely and were of compact growth.

SALVIA. Outstanding varieties with compact growth and brillant flower color

were Bonfire, Flash, Little Red Riding Hood, Magic Fire, Pompeii, (Hot Jazz), Purple Blaze, Scarlet Midget, and St. John's Fire.

- SNAPDRAGON. Carioca Mixed, Cherry Rocket, Frontier Strain, Mixed Colors, Forest Pink, Garden Type Double Mix, Rocket Mixed, Rocket Strain, Mixed Colors, and Sprite Mixture all produced an abundance of flowers with excellent growth.
- ZINNIA. Thirty-five varieties of zinnias were grown with several duplications. Carousel Giant, Violet Queen, Dahlia Flowered-Illumination, Firelight, Lilliput-Crimson Gem, Lilliput-Golden Gem, Lilliput-Mahogany Gem, Lilliput-Scarlet Gem, Mini-Pink, Pink Buttons, Pink X Cactus, Senorita, and State Fair were outstanding in flower production and dark green, vigorous growth.

#### 1968 ANNUAL FLOWER VARIETAL TRIALS

The 1968 annual flower varietal trials and the evaluation of flower entries for the All-America Selections were conducted at the V.P.I. Trial Gardens on the Virginia Polytechnic Institute campus at Blacksburg.

The small seeded varieties were sown the last week in March in metal flats containing a commercially prepared medim known as "Jiffy-Mix." The large seeded varieties were sown the third week in April directly in  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " peat pots containing a steam sterilized medim of equal parts loam soil and peat moss.

After the seeds were sown, the containers were placed in a greenhouse at  $70^{\circ}$ F. under a low pressure, intermittent mist system, set to mist for intervals of 8 seconds per minute from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. As the seeds germinated, the containers were removed to a  $60^{\circ}$ F. greenhouse. Seedlings of the small seeded varieties were transplanted after they developed the second set of true leaves into  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " peat pots, containing equal parts soil and peat moss. Seedlings of the large seeded varieties were roughed to allow only one plant per peat pot.

Starting May 27, 1968, the plants were transplanted to outside beds previously fumigated with methyl bromide at the rate of 1 lb. per 100 sq. ft. to control weeds, diseases, insects and nematodes. The plot for each variety was 6' x 3', with 8 plants spaced at  $1\frac{1}{2}$ ' intervals. The beds were irrigated as needed during the growing season.

Preliminary evaluations were made during the growing season with final measurements recorded the first two weeks of August. This period was considered optimum as regards to growth responses and esthetic characteristics for most varieties.

The varieties were evaluated objectively by height and width, and by a rating system. Width and height measurements in the tables represent averages in inches. In some instances where the plants had grown together forming thick mats of carpets, the width was recorded as "massed."

The rating system was based on 1 to 5, with 1 a very poor rating and 5, excellent. Floriferous rating included: flower, color, size, number, and uniformity. N/A means not applicable, with respect to plants grown for their attractive foliage and not flowers. Growth habit included: growth characteristics and uniformity of each plant size within a given varietal plot, since there was considerable variation in some varieties. The overall rating was given in attempt to combine all factors of floriferous and other growth characteristics into one evaluation.

In all instances the varieties evaluated in the garden were compared with similar varieties and types. Therefore, there may be other varieties not present here that would be better types than those represented. Frequent rainfall and severe high temperatures prevented many of the varieties from producing the growth and quality of/or quantity of flowers present in previous trials. Seed sources are identified on page

#### Suggested Annual Flowers for 1969

The following varieties were outstanding for 1968.

- AGERATUM. Blue Beauty, Blue Carpet, Blue Mist and Snow Carpet had uniform growth and flowering.
- ALYSSUM. Extra Early-Extra Dwarf, New Carpet of Snow and Pastel Carpet had similar growth habits.
- BALSAM. Double Flowered Dwarf Mixture was outstanding.
- CELOSIA. Formulated Mixture, Golden Triumph and Prairie Fire produced excellent flowers and growth.
- CLEOME. Helen Campbell, Pink Queen and Rose Queen had very vigorous growth and attractive flowers.

COLEUS. Croton Leaved Dark Shades, Croton Leaved Mixture, Multicolor Rainbow and

Rainbow, Chartreuse had outstanding foliage coloration and were vigorous growers.

- DAHLIA. Border Jewels, Coltness Hybrids Mix, Elite Dwarf Hybrids, Fleck's Extra Dwarf Hybrids were compact growers with small flowers.
- DUSTY MILLER. Hoar Frost and Maritima Diamond had attractive foliage and compact growth.
- GERANIUM. Moreton Series of Deep Salmon and Picotee Scarlet were vigorous growers with a profusion of bloom.
- IMPATIENS. Elfin Pink, Elfin Purple, Elfin Scarlet and Shade Glow Series -Mixed Colors had compact growth and many flowers.
- MARIGOLD. Early Gold, King Tut, Lemondrop, Petite Orange and Red-and-Gold were superior to all the marigold varieties grown.
- PETUNIA. The F<sub>1</sub> Grandiflora petunias have larger, somewhat more attractive blooms, usually ruffled or fringed. The outstanding F<sub>1</sub> Grandifloras were: Grand Prize, Harvest Moon, King of Diamonds, Maytime, Mid Blue, Peach Blossom, Pink Magic, Pink Mascot, Red Magic, Rose Perfection, Tickled Pink, and Vesuvius.

The F<sub>1</sub> Multiflora petunias have smaller but earlier flowers and are profuse bloomers all season, especially during the hottest part of the summer. Excellent F<sub>1</sub> Multifloras were: Blue Mist, Cover Girl, Deep Blue, Festival Kewpie, Orange Bells, Pacesetter, Pink Bountiful, Pink Foam, Pink Profusion, Plum Blue, Plum Pink, Plum Pudding, Plum Purple, Polar Cap, Popeye, Purple Plum, Rose Magic, Salmon Coronet, Snowdrift, Starfire Improved, Starkist Victory, and White Avalanche.

The F<sub>1</sub> Multiflora Doubles are more vigorous, and better suited for bedding purposes than the F<sub>1</sub> Grandiflora Doubles. The outstanding double multifloras were: Cardinal, Cherry Tart, Honey Bunch, Lavender Delight Improved, Pink Delight, Pink Riches, Red-and-White Delight, Scarlet and White Delight.

- SALVIA. Outstanding varieties with compact growth and brillant flower color were: Bonfire Elite and Red Pillar.
- SNAPDRAGON. Bright Butterflies, Frontier Strain Crimson, Dainty Orchid, Orange and White produced an abundance of flowers with excellent growth.
- VINCA. Alba Pura, Dwarf Little Delicata and Polka Dot were profuse bloomers with attractive glossy green foliage.
- ZINNIA. Cherry Buttons and Torch were the best as the other varieties were more suspectible to leaf spot and mildew diseases.
