New Business


3. Mr. Richard D. Mailloux reviewed the ODK Roundtable discussion concerning student behavior at basketball games. The student leaders decided to take their concerns regarding inappropriate behavior at basketball games to their organizations. They felt this would aid next year's student leaders in dealing with this issue prior to the 1985-86 basketball season. Dr. Wisman reiterated his concern regarding this behavior and questioned whether or not there might be another way to deal with this issue. Mr. Moore expressed a concern regarding behavior at commencement. Dr. Wisman suggested that Mr. Wenk communicate with the class to encourage appropriate behavior at commencement. Dr. Cross concluded the discussion by encouraging student leaders to discuss with their organizations the concerns regarding behavior at basketball games and commencement.
4. The Media Board Minutes of January 8, 1985 were approved following a discussion of Item C. Item C concerns a discussion and motion to extend Media Board voting rights to Business Managers. Dr. Cross will request that SCAB table consideration of this ammendment until the CSA Task Force Report is presented to the Commission. Ms. Fitzgerald stated that WUVT is checking into increasing their signal. This would require FCC and BOV approval. The FCC approval would take up to two years.
5. The Media Board Minutes, January 29, 1985 were approved following a discussion of Item D. Dr. Cross stated that his intent is to request that SCAB table consideration of this ammendment until the CSA Task Force Report is presented to the Commission.
