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



What We're Doing


- Task: Determine trends in paleontology

- Work: Text mining the abstracts and building word counts to perform analysis on.

Fostered a better understanding of automated textual analysis

Future Work

- Extract, analyze, and present data relating to the authors of the publications
 - How authors relate to each other
 - How authors relate to a particular subject
 - Show demographics of the authors
 - Can be represented as a graph data structure
- Integrate the code into a web application
 - Users submit their abstracts to the app
 - Users can do it all themselves instead of submitting to devs and waiting for a result
 - Users can customize report parameters and stop words
