The Commission on Student Affairs met on Thursday, January 17, 1980 at 4:00 p.m. in Room 344 of Squires Student Center. The following members were absent: Dr. George Hugheston, Dr. Jane Wentworth, Tim McKissick, and J. J. August.


1. Ms. Kathy Rowe moved that the agenda be approved as distributed. The motion was seconded and General Acuff called for the question. The motion was passed unanimously.
2. Ms. Kathy Rowe moved that the minutes of the meeting of January 3, 1980 be approved as distributed. The motion was seconded and Mr. Jim Tucker called for the question. The motion was passed unanimously.
3. Ms. Kathy Rowe sought approval of the constitution of the Virginia Tech Branch of the American Society of Agricultural Engineers. This item was excepted from the approval of the November 29, 1979 minutes of the Student Constitutional Affairs Board. Ms. Kathy Rowe moved for approval. The motion was seconded and Mr. D. K. Brockett called for the question. The motion was passed unanimously.
4. Mr. Ray Wasielewski, representing the Student Budget Board, requested approval of a \$175 Small Grant for the Wildlife Society. The proposal for the request was attached to the agenda. Mr. Wasielewski moved for approval and the motion was seconded. Mr. Doug Waters called for the question. The motion was passed unanimously.
5. Mr. Ray Wasielewski, representing the Student Budget Board, presented the guidelines for 1980-81 Budget Board requests. Mr. Wasielewski explained that these guidelines were generally the same as in past years with some items elaborated upon for clarification. The focus of the Student Budget Board through the guidelines is to get the best use out of the available funds. Mr. Bob Lineen spoke briefly on the flexibility of the guidelines and pointed out that exceptions were a matter of convincing the Board and the Commission of the need for funds in excepted categories. Ms. Kathy Rowe reminded the Commission that they are responsible for assisting the Student Budget Board in designing guidelines, and once established for understanding the implications thereof when budgets are presented in May.

Mr. Wasielewski moved for approval. The motion was seconded and the question was called by Mike Hadeed. The vote was unanimous.
