The Site

The site I chose is located at a very busy and noisy intersection, P and 22nd Streets in Washington, D.C. Adjacent to Rock Creek Park, this site has been transformed many times over the years from the Rider and Hunt Club of Washington in the early 1900s to a gas station and parking lot now. The site has two very different edge conditions to the east and west. On its eastern side across a three land northbound street is a tall and large scale apartment building. On the western side across a three lane southbound road is Rock Creek Park.
