Approval of Agenda and Minutes

1. The agenda was approved as distributed.
2. The minutes of the December 1, 1983 meeting were approved as written.

Announcements

3. Dr. Sullivan announced that the nomination materials for this year's student member to the Board of Visitors selection process have been sent to the Commission members.
4. Dr. Sullivan announced that she will continue to meet with the student leaders at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesdays during the Winter Quarter.
5. Mr. Simmons announced that Jeffrey A. Swartz, SGA President, and the Interfraternity Council will be the recipients of this year's ODK Salutes Awards.
6. Mr. Swartz announced that an agreement has been reached with the Athletic Association to provide open seating for students in Cassell Coliseum at the January 28, and February 4, 1984 basketball games.

New Business

7. The minutes of the November 2, 1983 meeting of the Student Media Board were accepted.

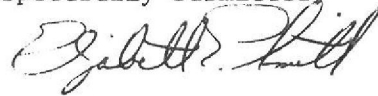


8. A motion was made and passed to approve the recommendation from the Student Budget Board to allocate \$448.53 in contingency funds to the Honor System to defray costs associated with the processing of cases. This allocation represents the original request of \$1403.86 less the earlier partial funding of \$700.00 and less the \$255.00 cost for a paper shredder. Mr. Locke, Chief Justice of the Honor System, stated that the paper shredder had not been budgeted for this year, but had been purchased due to a misunderstanding about the status of the budget allocation. Mr. Campion, Chair of the Student Budget Board, assured the Commission members that the Student Budget Board would continue to provide support to the Honor System during the year.
9. The minutes of the December 5, 1983 meeting of the Student Budget Board were accepted.
10. Dr. Sullivan commented on the concern raised by some members of the faculty and University administration about the inappropriate conduct of some students at athletic events and at the Commencement Ceremony. Mr. Hundley, President of the Senior Class, stated that the Senior Class Officers will be meeting with student groups to discuss appropriate behavior of graduating seniors at Commencement. Mr. Hart suggested that a clear statement regarding appropriate behavior of students at Commencement be developed. Dr. Sullivan requested that the student leaders give some consideration to the problem of student behavior at athletic events and Commencement.
