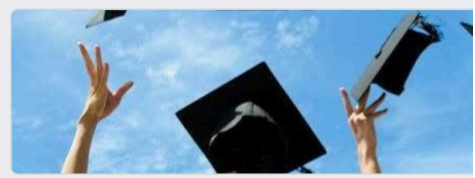

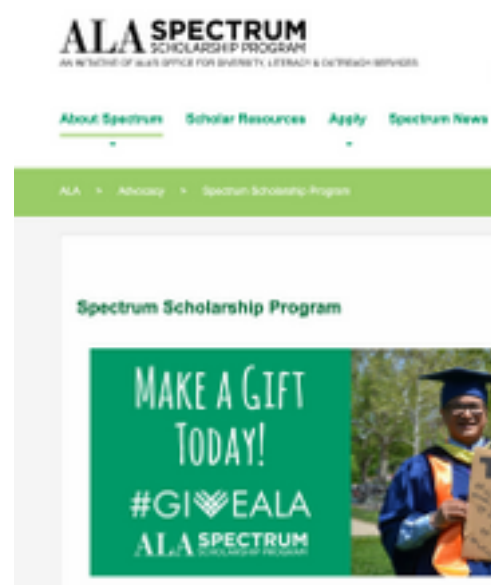


Spectrum Scholarship for Grad Students
