

Describe the **Purpose** and Character of Your Intended Use:

I am including one page (pg.5) from this glossary in my Master's thesis to illustrate how elections terminology is translated from English into the Navajo language in New Mexico. Since my thesis is focused on elections administration in three counties in Arizona (which do not provide written translations of elections materials to Navajo-speaking voters), this example will allow readers to recognize differences in language access from jurisdiction to jurisdiction.
