
Absent: Mr. Herren and Ms. Kosenko and Dr. Maxwell.

The meeting was held at the W. H. Sardo Pallet Laboratory on Airport Road and was called to order by Dean Roselle at 3:30 p.m.

A tour of the Forest Products Center was conducted by Dr. Marshall White.

1. Approval of Minutes - The minutes of the CGSR meeting of November 18, 1981, were approved.
2. G-1, G-2 and G-2A Forms - A motion was made to seek advice from the College of Business faculty with expertise in taxation before any recommendation is made by the Commission on Graduate Studies and Research about procedures for filing by graduate assistants. Motion approved.
3. RESEARCH - Publications from other universities were perused and a research publication covering certain aspects of research at Virginia Tech was distributed.
4. Policy on Graduate Study and Programs - A motion was made to refer this item to the Program Criteria Committee for further investigation and possible formulation of a statement on types of programs the CGSR should review. Motion approved.
5. Graduate School Catalog - It was noted that approximately one-third of the Graduate School budget is used for the printing of graduate catalogs. CGSR members were asked to bring any suggestions or recommendations for cost reductions and/or catalog improvements to the attention of Dean Roselle. Several such were discussed.
6. Approval of Textbook - Religion and Morality in American Schooling by T. Hunt and M. Maxson was approved for use in EDCI/REL 4980 - Religion and Education.
7. Adjournment - The meeting was adjourned at 5:12 p.m.
