1. Call to Order and Announcements: Dr. Perry called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm. There were no announcements.
2. The Agenda was approved as distributed.
3. The Minutes of the meeting of September 28, 1987 were approved with the following correction:  

The transfer of the undergraduate degree in Public Administration from the R. B. Pamplin College of Business to the College of Architecture and Urban Studies will become effective Fall Semester, 1989 and all diplomas will be awarded in AUS beginning Fall semester, 1989.
4. The Course Criteria Committee report was approved as presented. ART 4306 Advanced Visual Communication was approved to be offered as a quarter course in the 1987-88 academic year.
5. Dr. Dugger presented three Faculty-Authored Textbooks for approval. The texts were each approved for four years with one dissenting vote.
  - a. Bohannon, John N. (1987). Psychology: Research and Applications. Lexington, Mass: Ginn Press (For Psych 2000). Four year approval
  - b. Campbell, James B. (1987). Introduction to Remote Sensing. New York: The Guilford Press (For Geog. 3350 and 4350). Four year approval
  - c. Rogers, W. B., Crittenden, J. B., & Hammond, R. H. (1987). Introduction to Fortran 77 and the Personal Computer. New York: McGraw-Hill (For ISF 1005 and 1006). Four year approval
6. CUS Resolution 87-88A - Transfer Credit/Required Medical Drop was removed from the table for discussion by the Commission. Following discussion a motion to approve the resolution was seconded and passed. A copy of the resolution is attached.

7. Other Business

- a. Approval was granted for two years for the following Core Curriculum sequence Natural Science Area (8 semester credit hours, including laboratory) PIIYS 2175-2176 and 2715-2716 - Principles of Physics and Physics Laboratory.
- b. Dr. Perry distributed the procedures for special admissions, designed to include appropriate faculty involvement in the process. He explained that the university will use these procedures beginning immediately to respond to departmental appeals on behalf of students who should be considered for admission to the University under special circumstances. These procedures may apply to any student but will primarily provide special consideration for students with exceptional athletic skills.
