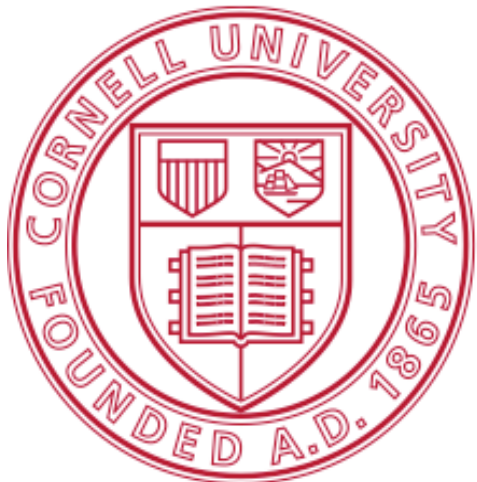
Impact on Natural Resources

- Benefits are wide ranging, but include:
- Sustainable use of agricultural plots
 - Reduced deforestation as soil fertility of current plots protected
 - Habitat protected, wildlife benefits
 - Reduced flooding and erosion
 - Siltation of rivers
- Costs may include:
 - additional labor inputs, but this is spread across the dry season when opportunity costs are low
 - Alternative to CF is continued degradation of soils, and further deforestation
 - the labor costs of land clearing
