- 3. Textbook Approval Approval of the User's Instructions for NPSP prepared by Dr. Walter R. Pirie, Statistics Department, to be used in STAT 5660 Nonparametric Methods was discussed. There was some question as to whether such manuals require CGS approval. This matter will be investigated by the Graduate School, and a recommendation will be brought to the Commission for consideration.
- 4. Course Criteria Committee - Harold Burkhart The renumbering of EDPE 5201 to EDPE 5320 Orthopedic Testing and Rehabilitation was approved.
- 5. Graduate Option in Biomedical Engineering - Dr. L. A. Padis Dr. Padis, Assistant Dean for Academic Affairs for the College of Engineering, presented a proposal to change the designation of certain courses currently listed as Engineering Science and Mechanics to be listed now as Biomedical Engineering courses. This request was approved.
