The following actions were taken:

Approval of Agenda and Minutes

1. The agenda was approved as distributed.
2. The minutes of the February 11, 1982 meeting were approved as written.

3. Dr. Sullivan announced that the Student Budget Board has approved small grants funding for the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), Alpha Epsilon Delta, and Omicron Delta Kappa.
4. Dr. Sullivan announced that the approved and registered events from February 25, 1982 to April 1, 1982 were included with the Commission agenda.

New Business

5. The minutes of the January 21, 1982 meeting of the Student Constitutional Affairs Board were approved as distributed. Mr. Lineen, Chairperson of the Student Constitutional Affairs Board, stated that this action included a change in the membership of the Student Budget Board to include a graduate student member appointed by the Chair of CSA.
6. Dr. Sullivan introduced to the Commission Mr. Larry Shepler, a representative from Sigma Chi Fraternity. Mr. Shepler reported on the history and purpose of the Sigma Chi "Derby Day" Program. The Sigma Chi "Derby Day" Program to be held on May 15, 1982 was approved by the Commission.

Old Business

7. Dr. Sullivan turned the floor over to General Lane to present the report from the Ad Hoc Committee on Student Grievances. The Commission approved the report as written. Dr. Sullivan announced that the report would be forwarded to the Manager of Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity.

8. The revised draft of University Policies for Student Life 1982-83 was approved with the deletion of Items 1, 2, and 3 on page 3 of the document. Dr. Sullivan announced that the document will be forwarded to University Council for action and to the University Legal Counsel for review.
9. The Commission agreed to establish the term of office for student members on the Commission from June to September with the present member having the prerogative to transfer the seat to the newly-elected officer of that representative organization.
