PROPOSED POLICY CHANGE:

Title: By Hour Fees for Graduate Students

Require a minimum registration of three hours for graduate students and by hour fees for any registration between three and nine hours. (Resolution, Attachment #3.)

PROPOSED NEW POLICY:

Title: Graduate Cooperative Education Programs

The Undergraduate CO-OP Program will serve as a communication link with the departments in developing opportunities for graduate students in cooperative education. Approval for student participation and amount of credit for such participation is assigned to the academic department, the Student Advisory Committee and the Graduate School. (See Attachment #2.)

Dean Roselle called the meeting to order at 4:00 P.M. He announced that the next meeting would be held January 14, 1981.

1. Approval of Minutes

The Minutes of the Meeting of November 12, 1980, were approved.

2. Course Criteria Committee Report--Dr. Klaus Hinkelmann, Chairman

Dean Roselle informed the Commission that the Mathematics Department had tentatively requested cross listing of the following four courses: AOE/ESM 5011, 5012, 5013 and AOE/ESM 5030. Subject to the exception of these courses, the Course Criteria Committee Report of December 4, 1980, was then approved. (See Attachment #1).

3. Approval of Textbook

Use of the textbook Systems Engineering and Analysis by Benjamin J. Blanchard and Wolter J. Fabrycky in ENGR 5050 was approved.

4. Graduate Cooperative Education Programs

A proposal for a Graduate Cooperative Education Program as approved by CGSR on May 28, 1980, and the response of the Faculty Senate was distributed and discussed. (See Attachment #2). The Faculty Senate version of the proposal was endorsed with the understanding that the Undergraduate CO-OP Program should serve as a communication link with the departments in developing opportunities for graduate students in cooperative education. Approval for student participation and amount of credit for such participation is assigned to the academic department, the Student Advisory Committee and the Graduate School.

5. By Hour Fees For Graduate Students

CGSR approved a motion to require a minimum registration of three hours for graduate students and by hour fees for any registration between three and nine hours.


6. Other Business
