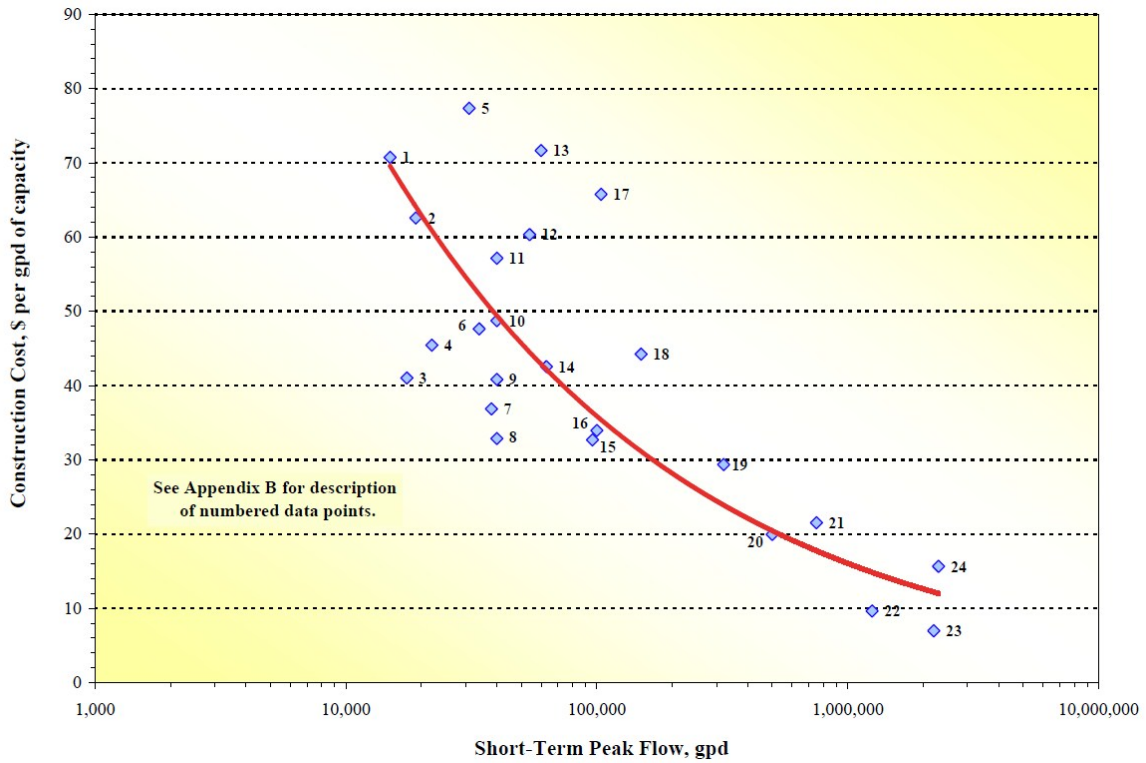


Figure S1. The total cost data from small-scale wastewater systems in southeastern Massachusetts (reproduced from a previous report ¹).
