1. Call to Order and Announcements: Dr. Perry called the meeting to order at 3:05 pm. There were no announcements.
2. The revised Agenda was distributed and approved as reissued.
3. The Minutes of the meeting of December 14, 1987 were approved as distributed.
4. Commission members were informed that CUS Resolution 1987-88A Transfer Credit/Required Medical Drop was referred back to the CUS by the University Council requesting a review of the resolution by the Health Evaluating Committee. Dr. Perry requested a review of the resolution by Dr.'s Bonham, Padis, and Ford representing the CUS and Dr.'s Cross, Cook and Desjardins representing the Health Evaluating Committee. The consensus of this group was that mixing an academic drop penalty or sanction with a medical judgement would open the University to litigation. The recommendation to rescind the resolution was discussed by CUS. A motion requesting that the University Council withdraw CUS Resolution 1987-88A received a second and was approved.
5. The report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Academic Continuance was presented by Dr. John White, Committee Chair. The report was discussed extensively by the Commission. A motion to accept Part A of the report was seconded and passed. Discussion on Part B concluded with Dr. Perry asking the committee to discuss further the changes suggested by the commission members. Dr. White will bring the report to the CUS for further discussion at its next meeting. A draft of CUS Resolution 1987-88B, Eligibility For Continued Enrollment, was distributed to the commission members for their review prior to the January 25, 1988 CUS meeting.
- ★ 6. The Course Criteria Committee Report was presented by Prof. D. E. Egger. A motion to approve ENGR 3024, Materials and Humankind was seconded and passed.
7. There were no Faculty-Authored Textbooks presented for approval.
8. The meeting adjourned at 4:15 pm.
