An Approach

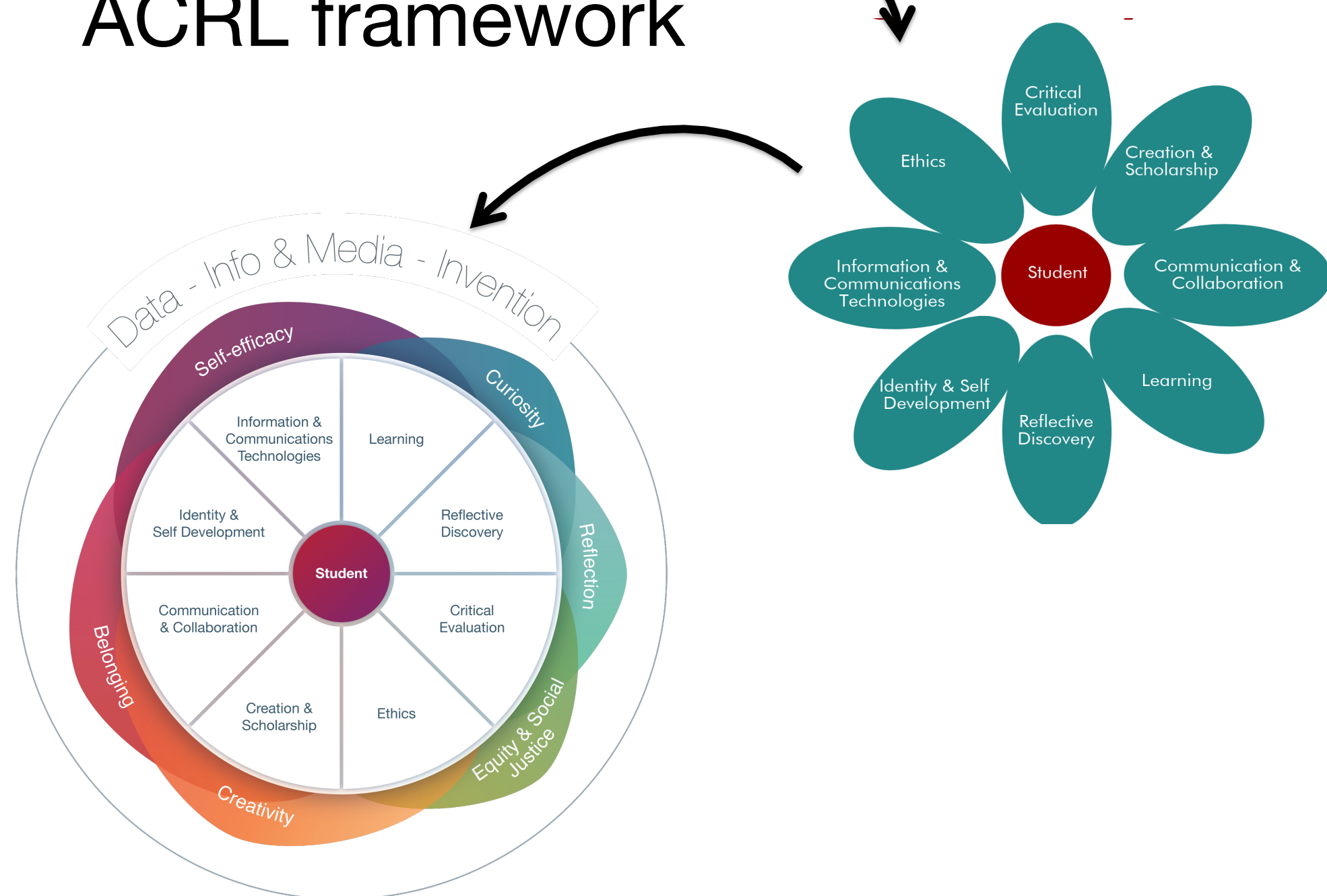
Explore vision, scope, needs, partnerships.

Jisc model & ACRL framework



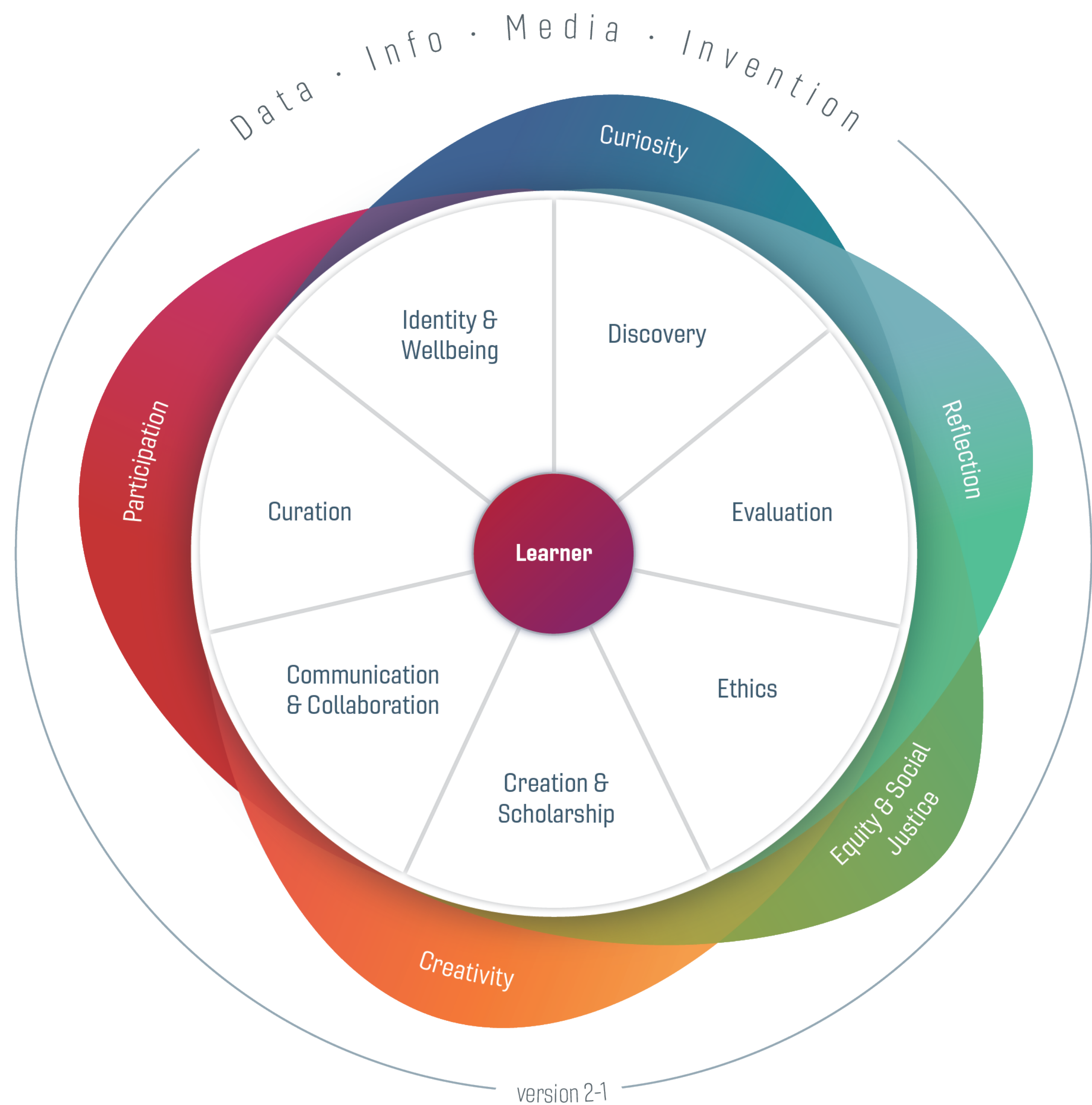
